The Rev. Charles Goff, pastor of Court Street Methodist church, will officiate, burial will be in Forest View Abbey. Fellow members of Rockford Elks club, of which he was an honary life member, will serve as pallbearers. Active in business and social life of the city, he was one of the men who built the Elks building and in recent years he spent much of his time at the club, which he regarded as his "second home."

Mr. Henry was born March 15, 1854 in Plymouth, Massachusetts, in a house which had been set aside by the Pilgrims for Elder Brewster. His father, John Martin Henry, came from the Black Forest in Prussia and his mother, Ursula Henry from Switzerland. He was the sixth child of a family of nine children, seven boys and two girls. All of his brothers and sisters preceded him in death. On May 14, 1878 Mr. Henry married Fannie S. Skinner, member of a pioneer family. She died in 1925. Her father, James B. Skinner was inventor of the gang plow and the riding cultivator.

Mr. Henry had resided in Rockford since 1864, when he came here with his oldest sister, Caroline, in time to participate in the Union victory celebration at the close of the civil war. He watched Rockford develop from a small village to a manufacturing and business center and had an active part in progress in the city. His first job was with the Leonard and Minzinger confectionary store near the present site of the Third National bank. He later was placed in charge of a confectionary at State and Main streets, where he later operated a clothing store for many years.

In 1877 he became a partner with W.H. Allen in the crockery business but the partnership was dissolved 13 months later when Mr. Henry and Henry Stern opened the Blue Front Clothing store at West State and Wyman streets. Three years later they moved the store to the northeast corner of State and Main streets and changed the firm name to Golden Eagle Clothing store. Mr. Henry bought his partners interest in 1902 and named the firm the C.F. Henry Clothing company. He continued business at the same location until he retired in 1917.

He was identified with a number of Rockford business enterprises. He and W.H. Woodruff built the old Trust or Rockford National bank building shortly after the turn of the century and Mr. Henry served as president of the Trust building a number of years. Mr. Woodruff was vice president. Mr. Henry was also vice president of the Rockford National bank and was president of the Rockford Mausoleum company which operates Forest View Abbey. Mr. Henry was a member of the Winnebago board of supervisors when the section of the courthouse which houses the county jail was built. He was a 32nd degree Mason and a member of Tebala Shrine. During his active years he took a leading part in Elks club affairs.

Mr. Henry would have been 88 years old Sunday. Immediate cause of death was gall bladder suffered Monday afternoon. He had been a patient at the hospital since last October. Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Charlotte Aileen Sheets, wife of Raymond Sheets of Rockford. The only other child, Rupert James Henry, died in 1938. There are four grandchildren, Roger, Brice and Jerome Sheets of Rockford and James Henry of Medford, Oregon, a member of naval aviation reserve, and three great

grandchildren.

Al. E. Henry, prominent, jeweler, and a leading businessman of Rockford, died suddenly in his store, 118 West State Street, last night. The end came without warning, although he was under the care of physicians several weeks for treatment for ulceration of the stomach, and death was due to a stroke of apoplexy. The condition which resulted in his death was brought on by the excessive heat of the day. Two clerks were in the store with Mr. Henry when preparations were being made to close the business for the night. Mr. Henry had previously complained for a severe pain in his stomach, an ailment which he was combatting with medical skill, but with no appreciable improvement. He was going to the toilet and just as he reached the door he fell forward. Leslie Basey, a clerk was at hand and applied cold water, and H.W. DeMoure, another clerk, was in the front of the store. Mr. DeMoure heard the deep breathing of Mr. Henry and surmising that it was a critical case he hastened for a physician. Mr. Henry was dead when he returned with Dr. L.A. Shulz.

Dr. E.W. Goembel was next to arrive, and shortly afterward Dr. S.C. Andrus arrived at the store. Mr. Henry was under treatment of Dr. Andrus and the physician was surprised to learn of the sudden death. It was not due to the ulceration of the stomach the doctor said, but that death was undoubtedly due to apoplexy was an opinion that was joined in by the three physicians. Mr. Henry was at Dr. Andrus' office at 3 o'clock yesterday afternoon for medicine. He had been without it for two days and suffered a great deal of stomach pain the night previous. His first call on Dr. Andrus was several weeks ago and a course of diet was prescribed. A thorough examination of Mr. Henry was made at that time and Dr. Andrus reported he found him a remarkably well-preserved man for one of his physique. Mr. Henry was a large man physically and was of a build that quickly responds to apoplexy. He faithfully followed Dr. Andrus' directions, as attested by the clerks and by others, even to giving up smoking in which he took great comfort.

It was a frequent saying of Mr. Henry, previous to his recent indisposition, that he was never ill a day in his life. He did not know what a headache was. When the ulceration became annoying he was advised by his brother, C.F. Henry, to go to the Mayo brothers at Rochester, Minnesota, as C.F. Henry was leaving at that time with W.F. Woodruff. Mr. Henry thought lightly of the need of attending the Minnesota hospital, as he wanted to be among friends in Rockford. C.F. Henry was informed of the death of his brother and hastened to the store. He later went to the home of his brother to break the sad news to Mr. Henry, who was wholly unprepared for the shock. Mr. Henry had been home only an hour or two before and then there was no indication the end was so near. At supper time he remarked to the clerks he guessed he would run up home, not that he wanted anything to eat, but just to go.

It was difficult for friends of Mr. Henry to believe last night that he was dead and they hastened to the store to have the story confirmed. Mr. Henry had lived in Rockford so long and was so prominent that he was widely known and there were expressions of profound sorrow that he has passed away. Mr. Henry lived in Rockford forty-eight years and was identified with the jewelry business since early manhood. He was an expert jeweler and those who are acquainted with the details of the business unite in saying there was none better than Al Henry. He mastered the intricacies of the business under Beale Bros., with whom he was identified seven years and for thirty-two years he has been in business for himself. His first

location was three doors west of the State Street bridge, on the south side of the street, where he continued until nine years ago. He purchased the property at 118 West State Street and equipped a modern jewelry store, one of the finest in the state.

Al Henry took great pride in his business and its upbuilding and prided himself on the weight of his name carried with the trade. He aimed to treat the trade honestly and his efforts in this direction were not without results as his business grew steadily, old patrons being retained and new ones being added. Mr. Henry planned several years ago to retire from business and expected to dispose of the stock in the spring. A deal pending at that time was all but carried through, but circumstances prevented the transfer, and he was "kept" in the harness. He was thorough-going as a business man and brought the prestige of his personality in acquiring a trade that extended to distant cities. With it came the accumulation of wealth and he was regarded as one of the well-to-do men of Rockford. One of his recent purchases was the Price building in South Wyman Street, formerly used as a glove factory, and now occupied by the Rockford Electric company. It was a transaction which required a large investment but which promises to yield good financial returns. Mr. Henry loved outdoor life and his diversions were automobiling and attending baseball games. He was also a crack shot. As a member of the old Rockford Gun club he carried off many trophies and was the possessor of a diamond badge which he won three consecutive times in a competition with renowned marksman. He was posted on baseball affairs, eagerly following the fortunes of the Rockford team, and was no less interested in the games of the major leagues.

Mr. Henry was born July 19, 1858, at Plymouth, Massachusetts, a son of John Martin Henry and wife. He came to Rockford forty-eight years ago, this being a year after C.F. Henry and sister, Mrs. Carrie Schmauss, arrived here. With Al Henry were his parents and a younger brother. He was married about twenty-five years ago to Miss Anna Kauffman, who is a survivor, and there is one son, Russell Sage Henry, a lad of nine years. The Henry home after his marriage was at 418 Peach Street a number of years. He acquired the property at 1037 Franklin place several years ago and moved there. There are four brothers and one sister—C.F. Henry, Mrs. Carrie Schmauss and John Henry of Jefferson, Wisconsin, and Phillip Henry of Albert Lea, Minnesota.

Mr. Henry was a member of Rockford lodge of Elks. He formerly belonged to the Knights of Pythias. His religious affiliation was with the Church of the Christian Union. M.H. McAllister, county coroner, was called to the store immediately after the death of Mr. Henry, but an inquest was deemed unnecessary. Mr. Henry having been under the care of a physician and as Dr. Andrus was there to make a statement and it was supplemented by Dr. Goembel and Dr. Shulz, the law does not contemplate that an inquest shall be held. Al Henry was popular and he was enterprising. He was friend to all. He had a wide acquaintance and his contact with a great number of people made him a man of broad views. He respected the opinions of others and held to himself his own convictions, and now that he has gone there is widespread sorrow and many sad hearts will bow at his bier.

Deceased was born in this city Dec. 13, 1862, and her marriage to Mr. Henry took place about thirty years ago. Mr. Henry, prominent jeweler here for many years, predeceased her five years ago.

Mrs. Henry is survived by a son, Russell, 14 years old, a student at Northwestern Military and Naval academy at Lake Geneva, Wisconsin. Mrs. Henry was a member of Rockford Country club.
