Matthew Stoll, 89, three times mayor of Niles, died at 8:10 a.m. today at his home at 312 North Fourth Street after an illness of three years. Born October 12, 1861 at Ann Arbor, he was the son of David and Flora Weidman Stoll. He was married in 1888 to Harriet Leitelt, who died December 9, 1931. Stoll, a retired furniture manufacturer, came here from Buchanan 56 years ago. He was elected mayor here in 1905 after being alderman of the fourth ward and was re-elected in 1906 and 1908. Stoll was a member of the Knights of Pythias.

Surviving are a son, Arthur F., (two lines illegible) Martha Snaubel, of Ann Arbor. Another son, Charles, died in 1943. The Rev. T. M. Greenhoe will conduct funeral services at the Kigel funeral home at 2 p.m. Monday. Burial will be in Silverbrook Cemetery. Friends may call at the funeral home.

# From "A 20th Century History of Berrien County"

Matthew Stoll is one of Michigan's native sons, having been born in Ann Arbor in 1861. His father, David Stoll, was a native of Hamburg, Germany, and came to America in 1847, settling in Ann Arbor, Michigan.... Matthew Stoll was the second son, and is now the only one living in Berrien County. He pursued his education in the public schools of Ann Arbor, and at an early age began to earn his own living by working in a furniture factory in the city, where he learned the trade of furniture finisher. When seventeen years of age (1878), he went on to Grand Rapids, Michigan, where he followed his trade in different furniture factories, spending 8 years in that city. There he gradually worked his way upward, promotion coming to him in recognition of his faithful service and capable workmanship, and during the later time he was the manager of a factory. .. Mr. Stoll was married in 1888, in Grand Rapids to Miss Hattie Leitelt, and unto them have been born two children, Charles D. and Arthur F., both born in Buchanan.

Matt ended up in Niles, organized a company with a man named Kompass, and Kompass and Stoll to make kitchen cabinets, and eventually made them for Sears and Roebuck in Chicago. According to an elderly druggist who knew the family in Niles, they made a killing in their contract with Sears. He was mayor for years, they lived in a beautiful house. His wife's name was Hattie. Because it was a railroad town, presidential politicians would come through, and he would greet them at the train station. He had two sons named Art and Charles who didn't have children.

Mrs. Hattie Stoll, 67, wife of former Mayor Matthew Stoll, died at 9:15 last evening in their home, 312 N. Fourth Street. Mrs. Stoll had been in ill health for three years. For the past six months, her death had not been unexpected. Mrs. Stoll's maiden name was Leitelt. She was born in Austria on October 17, 1864. When she was two years old her parents left Austria with their family and came to the United States. Their first home was in Grand Rapids.

She was married to Mr. Stoll in Grand Rapids on May 30, 1886. For a time after their marriage, Mr. and Mrs. Stoll lived in Buchanan but moved to Niles from Buchanan in 1895 when the Kompass & Stoll factory was established in Niles with Mr. Stoll as a member of the firm, until he retired two years ago. Of the 37 years in which they lived in Niles, Mr. and Mrs. Stoll lived for 28 years in the home in which she died.

The two children born to Mr. and Mrs. Stoll, Charles D. Stoll and Arthur Stoll, both of Niles, survive their mother. Besides the husband and sons, Mrs. Stoll is survived by two sisters, Mrs. Andrew Batt of Grand Rapids and Mrs. Julia Buechner of Kalamazoo, who are now the only members of a family of fourteen children.

Mrs. Stoll was a member of St. Mary's guild and of the Rosary society of St. Mary's church. She was also a life member of the Woman's Progressive league. Mrs. Stoll was highly esteemed as a neighbor and in the church and social groups in which she moved. She was deeply interested in the affairs of the city of Niles through contact with civic matters during the four terms her husband served as mayor and previously as alderman of the first ward.

The funeral services will be held on Saturday morning at 9 o'clock in St. Mary's Catholic Church. The committal will be in the mausoleum in Silverbrook Cemetery.

Art was more informal and business oriented. Charlie had started out as his partner, but was no business man. Before WW II Norm worked for a company on the Westside who made aircraft wings. When an inspector over there found out that he was a Stoll, he told Norm that Art and a friend were ardent gamblers who would go to Chicago, to do cockfights, to bet on horse races. Also from the old fellow who was the druggist, who he met at church and who also said that Art was known as a gambler, who made a lot of money and also gambled a lot. When Norm went to see Art after his wife died, when he was living in a bungalow, Art told him how a barn filled with heavy gamblers was held up by four guys with masks. At one time he owned about a hundred acres outside Niles where he was raising Angus cattle.

Jun 11, 2012 - Susan Wade held without bond after being charged with stabbing death of elderly father

Susan Wade referred to Ronald Mason as "Daddy" several times during her arraignment Monday afternoon. She told court officials her adoptive father was in charge of paying her rent, keeping track of her savings account and keeping tabs on the amount of money she received as social assistance from the government. Wade - described by family as severely mentally ill - is accused of stabbing that same man between 25 and 30 times while he slept early Saturday morning in his Ann Arbor home.

Wade was officially charged with one count of open murder Monday afternoon during an arraignment at the Washtenaw County Jail. Washtenaw County Assistant Prosecutor Dianna Collins told Magistrate Thomas Truesdell that Wade waited until Mason was asleep in his bed and then stabbed the 86-year-old Ann Arbor man repeatedly, leaving him to bleed to death. "She turned the fan on, found the longest kitchen knife she could find, entered after midnight and stabbed him 25 to 30 times," Collins said. Collins said Wade returned to the bedroom later on that morning and thought she saw Mason moving. That prompted her to resume the attack, Collins said. Given the information from Collins, Truesdell ruled Wade, 48, would be held without bond in the Washtenaw County Jail while her case progresses.

Kristine Crossman, Wade's daughter, told AnnArbor.com on Sunday that Wade is schizophrenic and has a history of drug abuse. Crossman said Wade had been staying with Mason for a few days before the alleged murder. Crossman visited the home on Saturday, and learned that her grandfather - who had raised her - was dead inside. Crossman also said Wade was in the home when she arrived, and that Wade had barricaded all the doors and windows to the home in the 1700 block of Covington Drive before she allowed Crossman inside and led her to Mason.

It's the first reported homicide in the city of Ann Arbor since Kwame Burrell strangled his girlfriend to death in January 2009. Burrell was sentenced to 26 to 50 years in prison in that case. Truesdell appointed the Washtenaw County Public Defender's Office to represent Wade. She's scheduled to be back in court at 8:30 a.m. June 21 for a preliminary exam.

Jun 18, 2013 - Woman sentenced to 20-40 years for murdering father: 'I wish I could have the death penalty'

In an emotionally wrenching sentencing hearing Tuesday, Susan Wade said she heard voices in her head telling her to kill her father — a crime that will send her to prison for the next 20 to 40 years. Wade, 49, pleaded guilty but mentally ill in May to second-degree murder for stabbing 86-year-old Ronald Mason to death on June 9, 2012. On Tuesday, Washtenaw County Trial Court Judge Donald Shelton sentenced her to 20 to 40 years in prison.

Kristine Crossman, Wade's daughter, was the person who called 911 last year when she came to Mason's home in the 1700 block of Covington Drive in Ann Arbor and discovered him dead. She detailed her emotional torment since discovering Wade killed the same man who raised Crossman. Through tears and sobs, Crossman told Wade she'd never be able to forgive her for what she did to Mason and the rest of her family. "You deserve to rot by yourself, alone and away from everyone you know," Crossman said. "Then, you'll know how my dad felt when he died."

Wade is a paranoid schizophrenic who was off her medication for at least one week before she killed Mason, according to court statements. She had lived with Mason for about a week before the incident. During her remarks to Shelton, Wade broke down, at one point putting her head in her hands on the lectern in the courtroom. She moaned and sobbed, at times barely able to form words. She admitted to attempting suicide after stabbing Mason between 20 and 30 times and said she wished Michigan had the death penalty. "I just wanted to die with him," Wade said.

Wade began to sob when she remembered hearing voices in her head, telling her to murder Mason. She said the voices would say, "I love you so much, Daddy, I want to kill you." A report from Dr. Phillip Margolis, professor emeritus of psychiatry at the University of Michigan, submitted to the court before Wade pleaded that said Wade was goaded into the murder by voices in her head. Members of Wade's family cried through much of the hearing. Crossman said her daughter continues to ask when she's going to see Mason again, even though she's been made aware of how he died.

Shelton told Wade he had trouble understanding how she could put this much pain on her family. The fact that Crossman was the one who discovered the murder baffled Shelton. "What you did to your father was, and is, unforgiveable," Shelton said. "What you did to your own daughter is almost beyond comprehension." Because she pleaded guilty but mentally ill, Wade will either be treated by the Michigan Department of Corrections or the Michigan Department of Community Health, depending on a doctor's recommendation.

Washtenaw County Assistant Prosecutor Blaine Longsworth said Wade snuck up on Mason as he was in bed and "ambushed him." She stabbed him repeatedly and "she didn't do anything to try and render aid or help him in any way," he said. Wade apologized repeatedly for what she did and said she's going to be treated for her mental illness for the rest of her life. "I am very sorry ... these feelings of killing are all gone and they're never coming back," she said. However, Crossman will have trouble ever forgiving Wade. Crossman said Wade killed Mason because she couldn't control him anymore. Wade was enraged by Mason's refusal to let her travel to Alaska, Crossman said.

Wade gave Crossman up to Mason, who was her adopted father, and Mason raised Crossman from the time she was a child. Crossman said Mason will never get to see her graduate from college, one of his dreams, and won't be there to watch her daughter grow up. Crossman wasn't buying Wade's apologies. "You may fool a lot of people into thinking you're sorry, but you can't fool me," Crossman said. She added later, "You're nothing but selfish and heartless."

Susan Wade pleaded guilty but mentally ill to second-degree murder for killing her father, Ronald Mason, on June 9, 2012. Wade, who said she wasn't taking her medication at the time of the incident, is serving at least 20 years in prison.
