JOHN J. EITELBUSS. The accounts of the freedom to be found in America and the wonderful resources of this country have drawn hither many a native of foreign lands, and throughout our broad land they are to be found working their way from poverty to competence and proving their attachment to the land of their adoption by their interest in her progress and various institutions. This class is represented in Montcalm County as elsewhere throughout the State, and it is our purpose to give a brief outline of the life of one who has been a resident of Home Township for several years past. Mr. Eitelbuss has four hundred and seven acres of land on sections 30 and 31, two hundred and twenty of which are under the plow.

The ancestors of our subject lived in Wurtemburg, Germany, and his grandfather, Johanes Eitelbuss, owned a farm near Herrenberg. He was a farmer and teamster and followed the latter calling during the War of 1815. His son J.George was reared on the farm and was eighteen years old when he was drafted into the army for the war before mentioned. He received a sabre cut across the face. He died in his native, land in 1839 cheered by the consolation of the Lutheran faith. His wife was Anna Marie Remp, daughter of a Wurtemburg farmer—Stephen Remp. She was the mother of thirteen children, seven of

whom were reared to maturity. After the death of her husband she carried on the farm and reared the family, doing much manual labor in the fields. She came to this country in 1854 and died at Palo, this State, in 1876, at the ripe age of seventy-six years.

The subject of this biographical sketch was born in Herrenberg, Wurtemburg, Germany, January 5, 1833. In accordance with the custom of his native land he attended school until he was fourteen years old and during the last two years ranked as first scholar. He was then confirmed, and laying aside his books entered upon his work as a farmer, laboring on the homestead until he was seventeen years old. He then hired out for two years as a farm hand, after which he did teaming from Tuebingen to Stuttgart, hauling merchandise with three spans of horses. He was an expert driver and earned a reputation that extended far and wide. Being liable to military service and wishing to escape the obligation he determined to come to America, where being a soldier was not compulsory.

Mr. Eitelbuss left Havre, France, May 10, 1853, on the sailer "William Tell,' and thirty-four days later landed in New York City. He made his way to Ann Arbor, Mich., and on his arrival had three shillings left to keep him over night. He sought employment and hired out for \$10 per month in haying. Three months later he entered the employ of the Michigan Central Railroad at seven shillings a day. He soon resumed farm work and when his mother crossed the ocean he rented two hundred acres in Washtenaw County, making a home in which she was his housekeeper. He operated the place three years, then in April, 1858, moved to Ann Arbor and engaged in teaming and soon added contracting to his job work. He furnished material for the stone foundation of churches, did grading on the University grounds, built the tunnel and underground engine house, the gas tank, and furnished scaffold poles for various buildings.

Mr. Eitelbuss also built seven miles of the Toledo & Ann Arbor Railroad, and when the contract was finished established himself at Six Lakes, where he used eight teams in lumbering until the spring of 1881. Going to Detroit he helped build and grade eleven side tracks, then those between the depots. There he used seven teams, as he had done in other places, and when he came to Montcalm County to make a permanent location he brought them here and used them in lumbering. He did a big business in lumbering near Wyman, and after buying his present estate cleared quite a large acreage. He first bought one hundred and sixty acres on section 30, then one hundred and sixty-seven on section 31, and still later eighty on section 30. He has made the improvements which include a substantial barn and windmill. His dwelling is a log house but large and comfortable. He has one hundred and forty acres of hay land and puts up one hundred and seventy-five tons per year, besides what he uses for his own well-graded stock, He harvests good crops of grain and raises and feeds more cattle than any other man in the vicinity. He keeps graded Short-horns and horses of well-known breeds.

In February, 1858, Mr. Eitelbuss was married to Miss Louisa Bauer, who came to America in 1857 and made her home in Ann Arbor. She was born in the same province as her husband February 25, 1838, and was reared by an uncle, her parents, Conrad and Barbara (Walz) Bauer, having died when she was quite small. They were farmers near Reudlingen. Mr. and Mrs. Eitelbuss have seven children, those who are still at home being William F., Lizzie, Annie L. and Carrie. John J., Jr., the eldest, is a blacksmith in Edmore; Frank, the second child, is teaming in the north woods; Mary is the wife of William Simpson and lives in Day Township.

Mr. Eitelbuss has served as Commissioner of Highways three years and has shown excellent judgment regarding public improvements. He belongs to the Royal Templars of Temperance at Ann Arbor and is connected with the Patrons of Industry, in which organization he has been Vice-President. He is a firm believer in the principles of the Republican Party and never fails to deposit his vote in behalf of that in which he has faith.

Mrs. Sarah J. Eitelbuss, one of the pioneer residents of Bushnell, was tenderly laid to rest in the Palo Cemetery Wednesday afternoon. She was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Olmstead and was born at Salem, Michigan April 29, 1845 daughter of Clauncey W. and Jane (Stevens) Olmsted. Here she lived but a short time, moving with her parents in early infancy to Bushnell, where she has ever since made her home. July 29, 1866 she was married to George Eitelbuss, who has preceded her to their future home.

They were the parents of five children, Jennie, now deceased, Julia, now Mrs. Thomas Haysmer, of Sheridan, Frank also deceased, Norman, of Bushnell, and Jessie, now Mrs. Harry Lee, of Ionia.

At the early age of 13 years Mrs. Eitelbuss decided for Christ, uniting with the M. E. church of which she was always a faithful member. In the W.R.C. of Palo, she was also an earnest worker, being one of its organizers and charter members. She died in peace at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Harry Lee, on Monday April 15, 1906, at the age of 60 years, 11 months, 17 days. Besides the children mentioned, she also leaves a sister, Mrs. Ida Parker of Chadwick, brother, Edger Olmstead, of Orleans, and a large circle of relatives and friends.

Jcob J. Hatinger is one of the most active business men of Montcalm County. He is a manufacturer of shingles and lumber, having a fine mill located on section 2, Belvidere Township, although he makes his home in Day Township, where he has a fine farm of two hundred and eighty acres on section 2. His father, John, was a farmer in Wurtemburg, Germany, whence he emigrated soon after his marriage to Catherine Eitelbuss, a sister of J. J. Eitelbuss in whose biographical sketch her ancestry will be found. When in about 1853 Mr. John Hatinger first came to America he located in Northfield Township, Washtenaw County, this State, on a farm and remained there until his death at the age of forty-five years.

The subject of this sketch was the second child of his parents and was born December 27, 1855, at Northfield, Washtenaw County. Here he grew up on a farm and after his father's death, at eight years of age was greatly depended upon by his mother in the management of the farm. When fourteen years old

he came to Montcalm County, he engaged in lumbering in the winter and worked on the farm in summer until he was twenty-one years of age, and his time and wages during this time went for the benefit of the family and he finally drifted into the manufacture of shingles in Ferris and Day Townships. He successfully ran a mill on Fish Creek, Ferris Township, then in Evergreen Township. In January, 1890, he started the present mill in Belvidere Township with a capacity of forty-five thousand shingles per day. Here he is doing a fine business. His farm is in a splendidly-cultivated condition and his handsome residence, large and commodious outbuildings and the general appearance of the farm are creditable in the extreme. He engages in general farming and stock raising and feeds for market about one carload of cattle each year. He makes a specialty of graded Short-Horn cattle, and keeps excellent stock in hogs and sheep. His greatest interest upon the farm however, is in raising fine horses. He owns the fastest pacer in the State of Michigan, "Benson H." sired by Lewis Napoleon, record 2:254,. He has paced the one quarter mile in thirty-one seconds which is at the rate of 2:04 gait. He also owns "Nettie H.," sired by "Sweepstakes." She has a record of 2:40 as a trotter.

Mr. Hatinger began in 1878 with an eventful celebration, that of his marriage to Agnes, daughter of Thomas Morse. This lady was born in Ann Arbor of one of the early families in that county. Her father was a farmer from New York and her mother, whose maiden name was Catherine Sabin, was born in Germany. In 1855 the Morse family located in Portland Township, Ionia County, this State, where they cleared and improved a farm and resided until the death of Mr. Morse. His wife, who survives him, resides at the old place. Mrs. Hatinger is one of six surviving children. Much of her childhood and school days were spent in Ionia County, although her older girlhood she passed in Ann Arbor. She is the mother of four children, one of whom, Jesse, died in infancy. The surviving children arc Ernest, Earl and Leon. Mr. Hatinger is a prominent Republican and votes the straight ticket on all occasions.

Washington Ave., threatened two men with a tire pump and then fled from the building, carrying \$37 in cash which he had stolen from one of the offices. Police were called to the Hatinger Auto Sales, 1833 S. Washington Ave., late Saturday night March 25, 1950 on reports that thief was trapped in a building. When they arrived, they learned that the burglar had escaped after threatening Robert Hatinger, 726 Dunlap St., owner of the firm, and his friend, Karl Sterzick. Hatinger said he and Sterzick went to the used car building about 11 p.m. Saturday night and were sitting in the dark in a front office watching a television set, when they heard a noise. The men turned on the lights and about that time, they said, a man came out from the rear office carrying a tire pump which he waved in a menacing manner at Hatinger and his friend. Hatinger and Sterzick ran out the front door. Sterzick went next door to call police while Hatinger stayed in front of the building. Det. Lt. Elton Roebuck and Oris Montgomery said investigation revealed the burglar had entered the building through a bathroom window and left by the same way after being surprised by the other two men

The rear office had been ransacked and \$37 In currency and change was missing from a cash box. The pump carried by the thief was left in the building. Officers said he apparently made his escape along the New York Central railroad tracks after leaving the building. The detectives said another break-in was discovered at 2:45 a.m. at the Gulf gas station in the 1800 block of W. Saginaw St., where a few bottles of pop were stolen. Entrance was made through a window.

Oct. 22, 1955 - Robert W. Hatinger, 39, of 3918 Devonshire Ave., discovered Saturday morning that target practice can be both dangerous and costly. Hatinger, operator of a filling station at 720 N. Larch St., turned his station into a rifle range about 5 a.m. Neighbors complained after several bullets hit one of their homes. Police investigated and found Hatinger shooting at soft drink bottles he had lined up near the overhead door of his station. He was using a 22 rifle and the bullets had gone through the wooden door and out into the neighborhood. Officers said they found nine bullet holes in one house and suspected there were others in other buildings. Earlier in the evening, a motorist had reported to police that his car had been struck by a bullet in the neighborhood. Hatinger said that he was whiling away his time by shooting at the bottle while waiting for a friend to pick him up at the station. The gun was confiscated and Hatinger paid \$54.30 in fine and costs after pleading guilty in municipal court to a charge of careless use of firearms.

Chattanooga, Tennessee - Clarke Eitelbuss, 19, said to be of Flint, Michigan, was shot to death here Monday June 10, 1929, by Eugene Dodson and P. Y Blackwell, Southern railroad detectives. The shooting took place in the railroad yards. Officers were looking for Eitelbuss and his brother, Ted, said to be wanted on robbery charges. While waiting, the detectives saw a man approaching and when they turned a flashlight on him Eitelbuss answered with a shot from his revolver, the officers returning the fire. Dodson received a wound in the thigh. Ted Eitelbuss later was arrested. with attempting to rob a store here.

lonia, June 17, 1929 - The body Clarke Eitelbuss, United States marine of Paris Island station, North Carolina, who was implicated in the shooting of a railroad detective at Chattanooga, Tennessee, June 10, was brought here Sunday with full military honors. Eitelbuss has been exonerated of all blame for the shooting by Colonel H. B. Snyder, who states that the marine's record was excellent and that he was merely the victim of circumstances

According to Private Elvis Stamper who accompanied the body to Ionia, Eitelbuss had been given a leave of absence, and had met Theodore Jones, now be held as shooter, at Savannah, Georgia, and together they sent to Chattanooga, Tennessee.

At 3 o'clock Monday morning, wishing to return to Savannah, they were waiting in a railroad shed for a chance to ride when there were apprised by detectives Eugene Dodson and T. Y. Blackwell, who were on the outlook for two young men wanted for the robbery at Somerset, Kentucky.

At the detectives' approach the boys started to move away, and when Dodson called to them to halt Jones whipped out a revolver and fired, hitting Dodson, according to Stamper. Dodson returned the fire, fatally wounding Eitelbuss. Jones Escaped but was caught four hours later and is now being held for trial.

Eitelbuss is survived by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Ward Eitelbuss, Bushnell Township, and four brothers and a sister. The funeral will be held at the Eitelbuss home at 2:30o'clock Monday afternoon. The body will be buried in Sunny Hill cemetery, near Palo.

Ted Eitelbuss passed peacefully on Thursday Aug. 16, 2018 at 7:21 a.m. at the age of 77. He was preceded by Elinore and Edward, his mother and father, and his sons Ira and Dutch. He is survived by his loving wife Jenny, his sons Joe, Ted Jr, Luke, and Tate, and his daughters Saartje and Mary, and grandchildren Jakob, Raymond, Cassandra, Jasmine, and Nazanin. Ted was an icon of the Sausalito houseboat community and loving husband, father, grandfather, and friend to many on the waterfront. In the late 1950s, Ted left his roots on a rural farm in Michigan to study art at the Kendall School of Design. Unsatisfied with the Michigan school, Ted headed to Greenwich Village in New York to pursue a career in art and explore a radically changing world of beatnik poets and celebrity artists.

Some of the details are unclear as only Ted knows most of them, but he made his way to North Beach in San Francisco in 1962, attended the SF Art Institute and eventually became one of the early anchor-outs in Richardson Bay. Throughout the sixties, Ted stayed on the forefront of the counterculture movement, spending

time among the communes outside of Taos, New Mexico, where his easygoing personality and passion for hard work fit in well. It was there he learned the craft of building geodesic domes—this was to become his primary art form. On the commune, he built a dome purely out of recycled car roofs which was famously featured in Rolling Stone magazine and visited by Allen Ginsberg. The structure was massive in size and had a bedroom-loft hanging from its ceiling. Ted's first boat on Richardson Bay in 1966 was remarkable, sporting two radiant, glass geodesic domes, one on each end of the platform.

In the mid-1960s, he spent a year in Cuernavaca, Morelos, Mexico where he stayed with painter Rudolf Ray, and worked on wood, plaster, and steel sculpture. In 1971, Ted notably built a diesel-powered blast furnace from scratch, using it to create works in bronze and aluminum castings, which can still be found in houses around Richardson Bay. He traveled to Amsterdam in 1972 where he built and sold houseboats on the Amstel Canal. During his time in Europe, Ted made several trips to Israel and the Middle East seeking his spiritual truth.

Ted eventually settled in Richardson Bay in the mid-1970s, where he took part with T.J. Nelsen in constructing the various docks at Waldo Point, often behind lines of state troopers shielding the workers from protestors. His second boat still sits with its iconic blue geodesic dome facing the bay, attracting attention and discussion from boaters and paddlers-by. Throughout his life, Ted fearlessly pursued personal freedom with his infectious smile and a burly stature that created an indelible image in most minds. He was a seeker and cared little about the status quo, living his life free of the confines of societal norms and choosing instead to focus on his art. He found a niche in servicing the various idiosyncratic needs of houseboats and pioneered better ways to tie ropes, extend the life of cement hulls, wood pylons and more. Ted was never afraid of hard work and was someone that all the people of the dock could depend on both professionally and as a friend.
