Notes for Immanuel Gottlob (Emanuel) Wildt:

One of the pioneer residents of this city has passed away, gone to "that bourne from which no traveler returns." Emanuel G. Wildt died at his residence on Chubb Street Monday morning, about twenty minutes after one o'clock, of general debility. Mr. Wildt was in his eighty-third year, having been born in Stuttgart, Germany, in July 1808. It is just about sixty years since he, with six companions, landed in New York. The only survivor of these half dozen friends who accompanied him to this country is John Koch, another old resident of the city. Mr. Wildt came to Ann Arbor in 1831, and like most other early settlers who did not engage in farming, tried his hand in various channels of industry, and, through various means succeed in acquiring a comfortable competency, which he has enjoyed among us for many years in a very quiet way. He went to California in 1850, one year after the gold fever set in, but returned in a short time. In 1852 he went again, but came back the same year, and has made Ann Arbor his permanent home since that time.

Mrs. Wildt died in 1878. They had five children, all of who survive him except one son, Frederick, who was killed in the war at the battle of Fredericksburg. They are Mrs. W. A. Clark and Mrs. N. H. Drake, of this city, and Mrs. C. L. Kemp and Mr. Emanuel F. Wildt, of Detroit, all of whom attended his funeral on Tuesday afternoon, from the residence of N. H. Drake on East Huron Street.

Mr. Wildt was a very quiet, unassuming man, understanding thoroughly and attending to his own business, and in that respect was a shining example, and was correspondingly esteemed. He was a cousin of Christian E. Eberbach, the veteran druggist of this city. He will be especially missed by our surviving old residents.

Past and Present of Washtenaw County, Michigan by Samuel W. Beakes, Chicago: The S.J. Clarke Publishing Co., 1906:

James R. Bach, whose judgment and enterprise have proven important factors in the successful conduct of leading business interests in Ann Arbor, was born in this city, September 7, 1859. His father, Philip Bach, a native of Baden, Germany, came to the new world in 1833, and remained for about a year a resident of Pennsylvania, whence in 1834 he removed to Ann Arbor. He was one of the pioneer merchants of the city, establishing and conducting a store in days when the inhabitants here were few and when business development had made little progress. He married Miss Hanna J. Polhemus and they became the parents of one daughter, Hanna J., now the wife of James D. Warner, of Cincinnati, Ohio. For his second wife Philip Bach chose Nancy L. Royce, of this city, and unto them were born four children: Mary B., who is now living in Canada; James R.; Philip, a resident of Bakersfield, California; and Rudolph, deceased.

Reared under the parental roof James R. Bach acquired his education in successive grades of the Ann Arbor primary, grammar and high schools, wherein he continued his studies until 1878 and then, putting aside his text-books, he entered business life, where he has won a creditable name and position. He is now the secretary and treasurer of the City Ice Company of Ann Arbor and to other fields of activity has extended his efforts, being likewise secretary of the Rettich Building Association. He is also well known as an extensive real-estate dealer, handling both improved and unimproved property, and he represents a number of old and reliable insurance companies, having an extensive clientage in both the real-estate and insurance business. He has studied the needs and possibilities of his city in relation to its material improvement and his efforts in the field of real-estate operations have proven of benefit to Ann Arbor as well as the source of gratifying income to himself. Success in any walk of life is an indication of earnest endeavor and persevering effort-characteristics that Mr. Bach possesses in an eminent degree.

In 1880 Mr. Bach was married to Miss Blanche E. Tremain and they had one daughter, Lois, who is now living in Seattle, Washington. In 1891 Mr. Bach married his present wife, whose maiden name was Martha M.

Drake. In Masonic circles he has attained the Knight Templar degree and is a past commander of Ann Arbor commandery. He is likewise a past exalted ruler of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks and his religious faith is indicated by his membership in the Episcopal Church. A Democrat in his political affiliation, he was elected on that ticket the first city clerk of Ann Arbor and his interest in the public welfare has been manifest in tangible cooperation for the general good along many lines of progress and improvement. His acquaintance is wide, his circle of friends almost equally so, for his salient characteristics are such as gain high and favorable regard. In all his varied relations in business affairs and in social life he has maintained a reputation and standing that have impressed all with his sincere and manly purpose to do by others as he would have them do by him.

Portrait and Biographical Album of Washtenaw County, Michigan. Chicago: Biographical Publishing Company 1891:

James R. Bach. The popular and genial dealer in real estate and agent for various insurance companies, whose name appears above, is a resident of Ann Arbor, and socially and commercially ranks high among the best, most progressive and advanced people of the city. He is a son of Philip and Nancy (Royce) Bach, of whom a sketch may be found under the more complete history of Philip Bach in another portion of this work. Our subject was born in the city of Ann Arbor, September 7, 1859. His father, who is at the present time a prominent merchant of this city, was one of the early settlers of Washtenaw County, having come from Germany in 1829. After a few years spent in Pennsylvania he removed to Michigan in 1835, while the country was still a Territory.

The original of our sketch acquired his education in the excellent schools of Ann Arbor, finishing his course at the High School. On leaving school he went to Millington, this State, and was there engaged as manager for the firm of Peback & Co., merchants. With them he remained for six years and then removed to St. Louis, this State, where he engaged in the clothing business on his own account. He spent two years at that place thus interested, and at the expiration of that time returned to his native place and entered the store of Bach & Abel. After engaging for two years in this way in 1887 he launched into the real estate and insurance business. In the insurance business James R. Bach insures against fire, life and accident. He is agent for both local and Eastern companies and probably secures as large an amount of patronage as any man in the county. Wherever our subject has been located he has always enjoyed the confidence and respect of the townspeople and has been given evidence of the estimation in which he is held. While in Millington he was elected Village Trustee and also served as Township Clerk. In the spring of 1888 he was City Recorder for Ann Arbor and in the spring of 1889 was elected City Clerk for a term of two years.

An ardent Democrat in his political belief and affiliations, that party has honored our subject by appointing him Secretary of the Washtenaw County Democratic Committee and in this capacity he does excellent service.
