He was very conservative and he made sure money wasn't squandered."

Satterthwaite said that Weber was instrumental in making sure the village's electrical utility was not sold off to Consumers Power Co. in the 1970's, and that stands as perhaps the wisest decision the village has ever made.

Weber's colleagues and friends almost invariably use the word "dedicated" to describe him. They say he was dedicated to his family, the village, and softball. Three of his four daughters played softball for Chelsea High School and Weber spent many afternoons watching them play. In addition, he was the driving force behind the establishment of Dana Park, where area softball teams play virtually every night of the week. A Fritz Weber Memorial Softball Award has been set up at Chelsea High school. One of Weber's closest friends, Johnson's How-To Store owner Sam Johnson, said being village manager was more than just a job to Weber. "He was personally interested," Johnson said. "I think that's why he used to get so upset when the village was criticized. It wasn't just a job to him and I think he had a hard time separating his personal feelings about the village. Personally, I'd like to see him honored by having one of the fields at Dana Park named Weber Field."

As part of his job, Weber was also instrumental in forming the Michigan Public Power Agency, which has helped the village purchase electricity at reduced rates. That, in turn, has translated into a reserve of more than \$2 million, which the village borrows against to finance major repairs and other projects. Weber served as MPPA commissioner in 1978, as secretary-treasurer from 1983-85, and vice-chairman from 1985-88. He was also elected to the board of directors of the Michigan Municipal Electric Association in 1978 and served as its president in 1980-81. Weber was also a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and Knights of Columbus Council 3092. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict.

He is survived by his widow, Sandra, and four daughters, Joan, Michelle, Anne, and Karen, all of Chelsea. Other survivors are his brother, William, of Chelsea, and brother, Robert, of Owosso, and two sisters, Mary K. and Phyllis Weber, also of Chelsea.

Frederick A. "Fritz" Weber, 175 Orchard St., Chelsea, age 58, died Friday morning, May 26, 1989 at his home following a lingering illness. He was born in Chelsea on Feb. 15, 1931, the son of William J. and Mary Magdalen (Eisele) Weber. On Nov. 11, 1961, he married Sandra K. Buehler and she survives.

Fritz was a life-long resident of Chelsea and was the first Chelsea Village Manager, serving in the position from April 1, 1969 until his death. Fritz served on the village council from May 1964 until he was elected president in 1969. He was instrumental in forming the Michigan Public Power Agency and served as a commissioner in 1978, secretary-treasurer in 1983-85 and vice-chairman from 1985-88. He was elected to the board of directors of the Michigan Municipal Electric Association in 1978 and served as its president in 1980-81. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus Council 3092 and a veteran of the U. S. Army during the Korean Conflict.

Surviving, in addition to his wife, are his four daughters, Joan, Michelle, Anne, and Karen, all of Chelsea; two brothers, William C. Weber of Chelsea, Robert L. Weber of Owosso; and two sisters, Mary K. Weber and Phyllis Weber both of Chelsea; and several nieces and nephews.

Mass of the resurrection was held Monday, May 29, at 12 noon from St. Mary's Catholic Church with the Rev. Fr. Philip Dupuis officiating. The Rosary was recited Sunday evening from the Staffan-Mitchell Funeral Home. Burial followed in Mt. Olivet Cemetery, Chelsea.
