Angola, Indiana - Four Bryan, Ohio, men were drowned Thursday night August 30, 1945 in Snow

Lake, near Angola, when their motorboat capsized during a wind storm, state police reported today. The body of only one of the victims, Dr. Court Schwartzbek, 54, had been recovered this morning. State troopers and Steuben County authorities were continuing the search for the three other bodies. State police said the other victims were Harry Huffman, Arthur Stangler and Ross Stine, all of Bryan.

The men were on a fishing trip when the storm struck. Campers who witnessed the accident said the small boat was tossed about by the wind, then turned over, hurling the men into the water.

Sept. 3, 1945 - Report was made at Angola Friday afternoon that the bodies of four prominent Bryan, Ohio, men who were drowned in Snow lake Thursday evening were all recovered. Victims of the tragedy were Dr. Court Schwartzbek, 54, a dentist; Harry Huffman, an oil dealer; Ross Stine, lumberman and banker, and Arthur Spangler, president of the Spangler Candy Co. The bodies were taken to the Weicht funeral, home at Angola pending removal to Bryan.

The men made a trip together from Bryan to Lake James Thursday and played golf during the afternoon. After supper they rented a metal rowboat equipped with a motor at Bledsoe's landing at Lake James and then proceeded to Snow lake, which is the third basin north of Lake James. A severe storm came up quickly and capsized the boat. People on the shore saw the boat sink.

Sheriff Paul Duguid and State Policeman Russell Huffman led rescue parties. Schwartzbek's body, was soon recovered, as it was floating on the surface of the lake. However, the other bodies were not in view. Several boats equipped with grappling hooks were used and the bodies were located on the bottom of the lake late in the forenoon Friday. The water was 40 to 50 feet in depth. The boat also was recovered.

Dr. Schwartzbek is survived by his wife and one daughter. Mr. Spangler was 66 years old and leaves the widow, one son and one daughter. Mr. Stine was 56 and is survived by his widow and two sons. Mr. Huffman, aged 62, leaves his widow, a son and a daughter.

Angola, Indiana, Sept. 7, 1945 – Four prominent Bryan, Ohio, business men were drowned in Snow lake last Thursday evening August 30, 1945, as a sudden squall capsized their fishing boat, shortly aft 7:00. Victims of the tragedy were Dr. C. C. Schwartzbek, 54, dentist; Arthur G. Spangler, 66, head of Spangler Candy Co.; Ross O. Stine, 56, owner of the Stine Lumber Co.; and Harry Huffman, 62, distributor for the Gulf Refining Co.

A windstorm of unusual velocity and a heavy rain came up without warning shortly after 7:00 o'clock, and Don Abrams and family, of Lima, Ohio, vacationing at the lake, witnessed the capsizing of the other boat, having themselves just been driven ashore by the severity of the storm. Due to the heavy rain, the Abrams family were unable to determine the number of persons in the boat. Mr. Abrams and another man went back out on the lake immediately and found the body of Dr. Schwartzbek floating in the water. Artificial respiration was administered by them but efforts to resuscitate him were unavailing, The identification of Dr. Schwartzbek was made through his fishing license, which he carried in his billfold.

State Patrolman Russell Huffman and Sheriff Paul Duguid began an investigation, and following a telephone call to Sheriff Norman Raines, of Bryan. there; was much uncertainty for several hours, as it was not definitely at first how many had been in the fishing party, and whether or not they were in one boat or in two boats. A party of Bryan men came over shortly before midnight on Thursday evening to aid in the investigation. It was learned that the four men left Bryan early in the afternoon in the Huffman car, and following a custom of years, had played golf at the Lake James Golf Club earlier in the afternoon, then had driven to Bledsoe's Beach where they rented a boat from the Meyer Boat Livery. Dr. Schwartzbek had taken a motor along, and the four men were seen later proceeding north towards Snow Lake. Dr. Schwartzbek was very familiar with this lake, having fished there many times. There are only a few cottages on the shore of the section near where the men were fishing. Had it not been for the Abrams family witnessing the boat's capsizing, it might have been a matter of sometime before knowledge of the tragedy would have become known, as the boat sank to the bottom and was recovered later in fifty feet of water.

The state police, and sheriff's office continued investigation of the tragedy during the night, and Friday morning, began dragging operations on the lake to recover the bodies of the other three victims. No trace was found of the men for some time, although at various times during the morning a hat belonging to one of the men, a boat oar, and later a rack from the boat, were recovered. William Brownell, of Bryan, one of the volunteers assisting in the dragging, found first trace of each of the three

bodies. The body of Harry Huffman was recovered at 11:15; and at 11:55, the body of Mr. Stine was recovered a short distance away. It was not until 1:15 that the body of Mr. Spangler was found. All were found in 50 feet of water. The bodies of all four of the men were taken first to the Weicht Funeral Home, from where they were later taken to the Krill Funeral Home at Bryan, where services for Dr. Schwartzbeck were held on Sunday, for Mr. Huffman and Mr. Stine on Monday, and for Mr. Spangler on Tuesday, all services being held at the Presbyterian church. Prominence of the drowning victims, and the extent of the tragedy made a deep impressionon the city of Bryan, where the men were all members of the Rotary Club, and interested in all civic and community enterprises.

Dr. Schwartzbek graduated from the dental school of the University of Michigan, and began his practice in Bryan, where he has been located for many years. He was a native of Ney, Ohio. He has served on the Bryan board of education for 12 years, and for some time had been chairman of the Bryan Chapter of the American lied Cross. He was a charter member of the Bryan Rotary Club and a member of the board of the Presbyterian church.

He is survived by his wife, Lela, a daughter, Mrs. Eugenia Williams, in Louisiana with her husband in army service; and a brother, Dr. Theodore Schwartzbek, of Detroit.

Mr. Spangler was born at Edgerton and moved to Bryan at an early age. He attended Bryan and later attended Harvard University. Returning to Bryan, he organized the Spangler Candy Company, in which his two brothers had been associated with him. Mr. Spangler is survived by his wife, Helen, a daughter, Mrs. Neal Levinson of Bryan, and a son Ted who has been on Okinawa; and two brothers, Truman of Montpelier, and Ernest of Toledo.

Mr. Stine was born at Bluffton, and moved to Bryan at an early age. He attended Olivet College, and later graduated from the University of Wisconsin. He was a director of the Citizens National Bank of Bryan, and a member of the Presbyterian Church, and had formerly served on the Bryan board of public affairs. He was owner of the Stine Lumber Co., operating yards at Bryan, Edon, West Unity, and Sherwood. He is survived by his wife, Frances, and two sons, William and John, both of whom are in the army air corps.

Mr. Huffman had been prominent in the affairs of Bryan for many years, and was a former president of the Bryan Rotary Club. He was distributor for the Gulf Refining Co., and had formerly been in the garage business. He attended school in Stryker, and was a keen sportsman, having traveled considerably, hunting in New Mexico and fishing in Florida. He is survived by his wife, Minnie, two children, Robert of Camp Atterbury, and Mrs. Helen, Sommer of Youngstown, Ohio, his; mother, Mrs. John Huffman, and a sister, Mrs. Mary Beucler, both of Bryan.

A large force of state patrolmen, including William Hunter, Patton, David Melbourne, John Gardaand others from the Ligonier barracks, were assisted the dragging of the lake by volunteers from Angola and from Bryan, Ohio, as well as by Sheriff Paul Duguid and Deputy Dawson Gorrell.

Donald Alexander Campbell was a tenacious man who prosecuted air polluter for Wayne County but faced his most daunting challenge when at 47, he suffered a stroke in 1980. Unable to continue his career, Mr. Campbell nonetheless labored with his wife, Wayne County Probate Judge Patricia Campbell, in raising the couple's eight children. Mr. Campbell, 67, died of a heart ailment Thursday Sept. 2000 at his Detroit home, said his daughter, Diane Salter. Long time friend Gary LaBrett, Wayne County assistant prosecutor, recalled Mr. Campbell as "a nice guy with a dry sense of humor."

Mr. Campbell was born Jan. 21, 1938, in Detroit, where he lived all his life except for his time in the Army, said Salter. He graduated in 1951 from Detroit Redford High School. He attended the University of Detroit, and in 1960 he received his law degree from the Detroit College of Law. Campbell met his wife, the former Patricia Biskupic, in Germany in the late 1950s. They were married July 5, 1958. Mr. Campbell had worked for the Wayne County Road Commission before he received his law degree. He later worked in the 1960s until 1980 he was an assistant in the Wayne County Prosecutor' Office assigned to enforce air pollution laws.

Retired Plymouth 35th District Judge James Garber, who became friends with Mr. Campbell when they were second-graders in Detroit, said that "he jumped at it and was very, very good. In those days, it was breaking new ground we're talking 30 years ago." After his stroke, Mr. Campbell retired from Wayne County but remained interested in county and Detroit politics, aid alter. He never drove after the stroke and also suffered heart problems, but he traveled with his wife and also developed an interest in the Internet, said Salter and Garber.
