July 2, 1941 - Chief of Police Norman Edward Cook died suddenly from a heart attack at 5 o'clock this morning at a cottage at Base Lake where he was vacationing with his family. He was 42 years old and had held the position of police chief for two years. The chief had apparently been in good health and came to Ann Arbor yesterday, mowed the lawn at his home at 400 N. First Street in the morning and visited his office in the afternoon.

With him at the time of his death were his wife, three children, Norma, 17; Charles 13; and Eileen, 12; and a niece, Betty Hintz, 20, who has made her home with the Cook family. The family left Sunday, June 22, to spend two weeks at a friend's cottage at the lake. Chief Cook was the third successive Ann Arbor police chief to die in July. Chief Lewis W. Fohey died July 20, 1939, and Chief Thomas O'Brien died July 1, 1933.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 Saturday morning at Bethlehem Evangelical church, with Rev. Theodore Schmale officiating. Burial will be in Forest Hill cemetery. The body will lie in state at the Muehlig funeral chapel until Friday night and at the church Saturday morning.

Chief Cook joined the police department July 23, 1923, and after a short period as a beat patrolman,

he became a motorcycle officer. In May, 1926, he was promoted to the rank of Sergeant, and when Chief Fohey was granted a leave of absence, he was made acting chief on May 31, 1939. He was appointed chief on July 27, 1939. Last year Chief Cook attended the National Police Academy in Washington, D.C., a training school sponsored by the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and graduated from it June 29. From Sept. 30 to Oct. 5, he attended the academy again for special training in national defense subjects.

A number of improvements have been made in the police department under Chief Cook's administration. One of the first changes he made was to establish a new and comprehensive record system, set up with assistance from the FBI. He was largely responsible for an increase in the department's motor equipment and expansion of the police radio to a county-wide system.

He emphasized courteous conduct among his men, and did much to further good will for his department through contacts between officers and the public. He also instituted a juvenile program, based on the premise that crime can be prevented if children and police officers become friends. Chief Cook believed in modern scientific police work, and this year a training school for all men in the department was conducted for 10 weeks under his direction. He was strongly opposed to "fixing" traffic tickets, and had paid some himself. Under his administration, the operation of the department's traffic bureau was tied more closely to the record bureau and improved in efficiency.

Chief Cook believed that police officers should be good marksmen, and was instrumental in securing a police commission ruling that every officer must make a score of 60 out of a possible 100 with a service pistol in order to remain on the force. He was proud of the new police pistol range on Huron River Dr. and sincere in his praise of the men in his department who built it. Perhaps the most enjoyable of his official duties was attending the annual department dinner, where marksmanship medals and trophies are presented to police officers.

Chief Cook was born in Saline on Feb. 16, 1899, the son of Fred and Bernice Biddle Cook. He married Nellie M. Hintz of Ann Arbor June 24, 1922. Besides Mrs. Cook and the children and Miss Hintz, Chief Cook is survived by his mother, Mrs. Bernice Grams, and step-father, Edward Grams, Saline; two brothers, Ronald Cook and Robert Grams, both of Ann Arbor; two sisters, Mrs. Lovell Grams of Detroit and Mrs. William Shirley of New York City; and several nephews and nieces.

Chief Cook was a member of Bethlehem church, Fraternity lodge F. & A. M., the Loyal Order of Moose, the Kiwanis Club, the Michigan Police Chiefs' Association, the Southern Michigan Chiefs of Police Association and the University club.

In April, Laubengayer began work on the model 1918 de Havilland DH4 air mail plane. A hip replacement set him back a little, but Laubengayer finished the plane last week. Overall, it took Laubengayer, who worked from design plans of the actual plane, about three months to complete. Schragg paid for the materials while Laubengayer donated his labor. The plane was hung from the museum's ceiling just in time for the 1996 Marshall Home Tour, the only time the museum is open to the public. (Other times, ifs by appointment) The bright yellow model, which has two sets of wings and an open cockpit, is one-fourth the size of the actual plane. Its wingspan is 10.5 feet and the plane's body is 8 feet long. It weighs about 25 pounds, and could be flown by remote if Schragg wanted. It won't be, though, for fear of harming it, he said. The U.S. Postal Service bought the DH-4 planes after they were used in World War I. It marked the beginning of U.S. air-mail service. The planes, 4,800 of which were built, were flown up until the 1930s, Schragg said.

Laubengayer said building the plane was special for him because he worked for the Postal Service in Ann Arbor, spending five years as a mail carrier while attending Eastern University The retired chemist said it that was his favorite job. "I love the post office. I should have stayed with the post office instead of going to these other jobs. They are never as satisfying as the post office."
