Victor Sindlinger, superintendent of public works for the village for 15 years, resigned Monday. He also resigned from this position as civil defense director for Zone 5, position with the maintenance department at the University of Michigan. As superintendent of public works, he was responsible for all maintenance worth within the village with the exception o he police and fire departments. His duties included upkeep of village streets, buildings, water and sewage systems, as well as, civil defense. He was civil dense director for 14 years.

"I just can't keep up with the work," says Sindlinger. "I don't believe I'm doing justice to the people of the village, to my family, and to my job when I have to work so many hours. Last week, for example, Sindlinger worked 61 hours. Tuesday, during the heavy snow, Sindlinger was beginning his 10th hour on the job clearing streets when he contracted The Leader office. "It's a 24-hour-a-day, seven-day-a-week job," says Sindlinger.

Sindlinger, who was born in Ann Arbor, has lived in Dexter for 31 years. He and his wife, Evelyn, have been married for 35 years and have four children and 16 grandchildren. Sindlinger is a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose, Ann Arbor, and Dexter Methodist church. He was a board member of the latter for two years.

Sindlinger's resignation takes effect Dec. 22. Th Village Council held a special committee meeting Tuesday evening to discuss plans for hiring a new superintendent. According to village clerk Harry Peters, the resignation was "sudden and came as a big surprise." The committee will meet tonight to discuss procedures for filling the full-time post that presently carries an annual salary of approximately \$10,000. Peters said the salary is subject to change and the post possibly will be combined with other duties when a replacement is hired.

Notes for Tracey Lynn Schroeder:

Ann Arbor -- A Livingston County woman is accused of embezzling between \$50,000 and \$100,000 from her former employer over a nearly three-year period. State police investigators say Tracey L. Sindlinger, 44, of Pinckney, stole money from Stein Electric Co. in Manchester between May 21, 2015 and March 23 this year, according to court records.

Sindlinger who performed accounting services for the business, is accused of writing fraudulent checks to herself, drawn from Stein Electric's bank account in various amounts ranging from \$200 to \$2,000 during the course of her employment.

She's charged with embezzlement between \$50,000 and \$100,000, punishable by up to 15 years in prison; embezzlement between \$1,000 and \$20,000, punishable by up to five years in prison; three counts of illegal possession of a financial transaction device, a felony punishable by up to four years in prison; and five counts of uttering and publishing, punishable by up to 14 years on prison. She also faces fines up to \$25,000, or three times the amount of the theft. Sindlinger, who was arraigned in July, is currently free on a personal recognizance bond and barred from writing any checks. She waived her preliminary examination and is scheduled to appear at a pretrial hearing before Washtenaw County Circuit Judge David S. Swartz in Ann Arbor on Dec. 17. MLive requested and was awaiting comment from Sindlinger's Southfield-based attorney, Jeffrey G. Schwartz, and her former employer.

# Notes for Dr. Arthur Eugene Staebler:

Arthur E. Staebler (1948-1954) became the third director of the W.K. Kellogg Bird Sanctuary as the nation was recuperating from World War II. He repaired and upgraded much of what had fallen into disarray due to the lack of funds from the war years. Much of the restoration was done to areas that saw heavy visitor traffic and needed mending, not only for the visitors' sake but to stop erosion and further damage to the habitats of the birds as well. He was also able to create a new attraction; filling the empty cages that once housed non-native exotic birds with native quail, grouse and pheasants. During his time at the Sanctuary, Staebler was able to adapt a form of wing clip for use with ducks and geese and experimented with various traps and bird tags in order to increase the number of waterfowl that were banded and advanced the research studies of those involved. His techniques assisted in the development of new restrictions for hunting and fishing in the area.

Jan. 24, 1954 - One of those big, silent-flying snowy owls that periodically invade Michigan in search of food has been sighted by Dr. Arthur Staebler, director of the Kellogg bird sanctuary at Wintergreen Lake. The large white bird has appeared in the area of the lake twice in a two-week period. Dr. Staebler said. A winter migration of snowy owls from their arctic feeding grounds has occurred every four years since 1926, except in 1938 when the interval was three years. They usually turn up when there's a shortage of the mouse-like lemming, a rodent which serve as their main diet.

Captive Bird Died - Dr. Staebler said the sanctuary-had a live specimen of the imposing bird captured during the 1949 migration, but that it died last summer. Because our summers are too hot for them they are very difficult to keep in. captivity, he explained.

The white owls have had little experience with man and are quite unafraid, often coming into cities to perch on buildings and poles while searching for rats and mice. Since they make an easy target and are unprotected in Michigan by law, many of them are shot before they can return to their northern haunts. The National Audubon Society has asked all groups interested in wildlife conservation to help publicize the migration in the hope that the killing of the spectacular birds can be reduced. And two Michigan groups the Michigan Audubon Society and the Michigan United Conservations Clubs are working jointly on a state law to take hawks and owls off the predator list.

Dangerous to Capture - According to Dr. Staebler the snowy owl hunts for its food by day, unlike most owls, so that they are seen more often than those which roost in secluded spots curing the daylight hours. "We would appreciate another live specimen," he said, but added that he did not "recommend walking up to one and grabbing it. Their talons are very sharp and they could be dangerous."

"The Foothill Advocate" Summer 2008:

In 1955 Dr. Art Staebler and his wife Helen moved to Fresno from Michigan with their three children (Bruce, Ann and Susan). Art taught ornithology and just about everything biological at Fresno State until his retirement in 1980. Two years after moving to Fresno, Art and Helen's youngest son Chad was born. The family moved onto 100 acres on the west slope of Black Mountain and that's where the children grew up. Health problems froced Art and Helen to move to a home in Covis after his retirement, but they kept 60 of their original 100 acres.

Services for Dr. Art Stabler will be held on Saturday, March 17 at 11am at the United Japanese Christian Church located at 136 N. Villa, Clovis, California 93612. Dr. Stabler, emeritus profess of biology had just celebrated his 91st Birthday.

Arthur Eugene Staebler, who joined the AOU in 1935 and became an Elective Member in 1955, died on 5 March 2007 at the age of 91, at home, in Clovis, California. The oldest of three children, art was born on 2 May 1915 in Detroit and moved to Birmingham, Michigan, at the age of four. In highschool, he learned the natural sciences by collecting insects and birds for the Cranbrook Institute of Science. He graduated high school in 1933. Art majored in Zoology (B.A., 1938) at the University of Michigan (U of M), then immediately entered the graduate program there. He spent six months with a team of scientists in Chiapas, Mexico, where he collected animal specimens, many of received an M.S. in 1940.

Art met Helen Williams, of Columbus, Ohio, while at the U of M, and they married in 940. Caught up in Art's love of nature, the day after the wedding, they traveled and honeymooned at the boys' camp, where he worked as a nature counselor. In 1943, they had twin girls, Ann and Susan. Their fourth child, Chad, was born in 1957 in Fresno, California. Helen, his wife of 67 years, outlived Art by about a month.

In November 1943, Art was commissioned as a First Lieutenant in the U.S. Public Health Service and was stationed in Miami, Florida. His assignment was tenure that alien insects that might pose public health or environmental risks would not enter the country. At the end of the war, Art was discharged and returned to U of M to pursue this Ph.D. in Ornithology. In 1949, he became director of the W.K. Kellogg Bird Sanctuary in Augusta, Michigan. Concurrently, he completed his doctorate, with a dissertation comparing the life histories ofDowny andHairy woodpeckers. IN 1955, Art became an Assistant Professor of Biology at Fresno State College (now California State University, Fresno). Until retiring in 1980, he taught courses in biology, ornithology, advanced ornithology, vertebrate natural history, vertebrate zoology, and vertebrate paleontology. He also developed and taught concentrated intersession classes in museum specimen preparation, waterfowl management, and desert ecology. Duringthe turbulent 1960s and against a resistant administration, Art championed faculty personnel decisions based on qualifications and performance. Starting in the 1970s, he began a survey of vertebrate fossils, mostly in the hills west of the San Joaquin Valley. Ten, as a emeritus professor, he expanded this interest and discovered new species of mosasaurs and plesiosaurs.

Art was a captivating instructor. Students eagerly anticipated each new topic introduced with his trademark: "Imagine, if you will . . . " Flexible and generous with his time, Art was happy to administer students' independent studies. He chaired committees for 11 graduate students, whose work covered a wide range of subjects – regional floras, estuarine fish, freshwater fist, Great Blue Herons, White-crowned Sparrows, Sierra Nevada meadow avifauna, American Dippers, and food habits of deer and range cattle. In retirement, he chaired two committees formaster's theses of paleontological subjects. Event late in life, at an assisted living facility, Art continued teaching by taking the other residents on ?eld trips and otherwise sharing his knowledge and joy for living.

Art's participation in numerous projects and organizations was extraordinary. In addition to membership in the AOU, he also held memberships in the Wilson Ornithological Society andCooper Ornithological Society. Among his many achievements inornithology, he helped to develop and design a cannon-net trapping system for waterfowl and a waterfowl banding-identi?cation system, and encouraged coordinated banding programs to address regional questions. He helped establish the Fresno JuniorMuseum (later "Te Discovery Center") and develop a bird sanctuary at Fresno's Woodward Park. Art's passion for the natural world will continue to be felt through the actions of the many educators and agency biologists he touched.

The following tribute is from Dr. Dick Haas, professor emeritus biology:

Arthur Staebler, emeritus professor of Biology died 5 March after a brief bout with pneumonia following a long battle with lymphoma. I spoke to Art a month or so ago when he called to discuss with me our views and knowledge about the nature of animal communication and how it differs from human language. I last saw him at the annual Christmas pot luck in the Biology Dept where we recalled the many times my students and I accompanied him in the field, often for many days at a time. Those days were in the 70's, to the both high and low Mojave deserts and to tree line meadows in the Sierra studying amphibians, reptiles, rodents and always any feathered creature we could observe. I learned from Art how to catch birds with "mist nets", band them, record their weights and measurements and release them with the hope of recapturing them in subsequent years. Or better yet, hearing from another bird biologist far away who had captured the same bird and noted it had been banded here in Fresno County. Later on his interests grew to include Mesozoic reptiles whose fossils were to be found in the Pinoche hills of the Valley's west side. On those field trips Art basked in his son Chad's special gift in spotting the smallest exposed bit of fossilized bone that betrayed the presence still hidden in the earth of fossils of ancient marine reptiles. The remains of such a fossil, a Mosasur, discovered by Chad and Art and excavated by a crew of students and other faculty resides now as important specimens in the Museum of Zoology at UC Berkelev.

Art's long career as ornithologist and general all round field biologist included years as director of a major bird sanctuary in his home state of Michigan and long weeks collecting and banding birds in Mexico. Art came to Fresno State College in 1955 and in the beginning of his years here he was obliged to teach in areas of biology not his first love because faulty his senior had those classes sewn up. He took being relegated to such subordination with characteristic good humor, but when finally having the opportunity, he flew with his classes in ornithology and mammology.

Art was a kind, gentle, thoughtful teacher, one of those everyone in the department respected and admired. He seemed to be incapable of harboring any thoughts critical of any youngster in class or colleague in the coffee room. In the field he was indefatigable. I especially remember him scampering up and down the Pinoche hills as if in defiance of gravity with the rest of us groaning in his wake. He was inspirational and I thought he would live forever.

Art spent his last years as a resident of an assisted living facility in Fresno. The call to me to speak of animal communication was prompted by his continuing as a teacher even in that facility. He regularly held sort of senior citizen seminars there on topics such as biology of birds, ancient reptiles of California, animal reproduction and communication and what evolution is really about. To the end he was a teacher eager to share with others his love of our quest to understand how the natural world works. It was good to have known this fine man.

While Art was completing his PhD after World War II, Helen worked in the placement office at the university. In 1955 they moved to Fresno, California where Art accepted a position as Assistant Professor of Biology at Fresno State College. Helen was active in the Faculty Wives Club and was a member of the Wolters Elementary School Board. After the family moved to Tollhouse she was president of the Sierra Elementary Mothers' Club and substitute taught classes K-12 in the Sierra Joint Unified School District. She was also active in voter registration in both Fresno and Tollhouse, and also recorded college textbooks for the blind. After Art's retirement they enjoyed trips to Germany, Austria, Alaska, Australia, New Zealand, Tahiti and Hawaii. The family is grateful for the loving care she received at Clovis Quality Care and from Saint Agnes Hospice staff. Helen was pre-deceased in March 2007, by Arthur E. Heusel, Ted Ann Arbor, MI Ted was victoriously resurrected through the promise of his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, in the early morning of April 27, 2007. Although Ted had courageously turned away cancer for the last seven years, it never personified the man he was. Called by many, "Mr. Ann Arbor", for his numerous contributions to the town he loved, Ted was also a wonderful husband, father, grandfather and friend to all who had the joy of talking with him.

Born on December 26, 1920 to Fred and Talitha, and the youngest of three brothers (Dick and Sherwood), Ted inherited the family commitment to community involvement. In his early years, Ted and

his "Dewey Gang" spent many days playing ball and learning important lessons of friendship and community that would bind them together for the rest of their lives. Ted always remembered his early days in Ann Arbor with great fondness. Whether it was sleeping on the screened porch and listening to the sounds of the Glen Miller Band fill the air from the Intramural Building, stealing cookies from the family's bakeries downtown, or impressing the girls at Ann Arbor High with his dramatic flare and baritone voice that would become a hallmark of his later professional life, Ted loved Ann Arbor and Ann Arbor grew to know and love Ted.

It was in college at Michigan Normal (EMU today), however, where Ted discovered his passion for the theater. Never tiring, Ted also found time to play varsity basketball and lead trombone in a big band. In 1948, Ted began working part-time as a radio disc jockey at WPAG while attending graduate school in Theater and Speech at The University of Michigan. After earning his Masters, and while taking courses for his Ph.D. in 1952, Ted was offered a job as a full-time radio broadcaster at WOIA. Not content to be another disc-jockey, one day Ted asked visitors to call in and express their opinions regarding a presidential poll. On that day, talk radio was born, and Ted would later refine the format and become the longest running talk show host in America - a career that would span 55 years on radio stations WOIA, WPAG and WAAM and earn him induction into the Association of Broadcasters Hall of Fame.

His guests would include some of the most colorful and notorious people of the time, including his famous prison interview with James Earl Ray. Ted, however, always tried to keep his program focused on the community's concerns by bringing local public figures into the studios for interviews and to answer questions from the listeners. As he would often point out, "this was the only place that any person of any color, nationality or creed could express their views and complaints." Ted also used his public platform to achieve much good in the community. Throughout the 1990s, Ted's annual holiday drive raised over 15,000 Teddy Bears for local children. Even after being diagnosed with cancer in 2000, Ted would continue his program through all of his treatments and surgeries right up until the last few weeks of his life. Even after his most recent battle, Ted could be heard from his hospital bed with his cherished friend Lucy Ann Lance. Ted also contributed enormously to Ann Arbor's drama community. With his wife Nancy, to whom he was married for 52 years, the couple became quite a dramatic team. Nancy, a young professional actress from Washington D.C., and Ted, a more mature director of various professional theater programs soon fell in love and shared their love of the theater together producing shows for the Saline Mill Theater, the Ann Arbor Civic Theater, Ann Arbor Drama Season, The University, St. Andrew's Players and countless other groups they lent their talents. They would continue their love of the theater throughout Ted's life.

Ted was also greatly involved in civic activities, serving on numerous commissions, committees, and boards, including serving as President of the Ann Arbor Public Schools Board of Education during the turbulent early 1970's. One of Ted's lasting legacies from his Board of Ed. days was that he insisted that Pioneer and Huron compete on the athletic field - an idea that was controversial at the time. In his honor, the annual Pioneer/Huron football game was renamed "The Ted Heusel Bowl".

Despite all of his public achievements in life, and beyond all else, Ted would always tell you that his greatest achievements were his children, Michael, who preceded him in death (Cindy), Lydia Sattler (Lynn), Jennifer (Ken), and Mark (Trish), and his grandchildren, Nisha, Sara, Ben, Giselle, David, Quinn, Thye, and Marin. Ted also had countless family members and friends that will remember him as not only "Mr. Ann Arbor", but a man who loved what he did, loved the community that afforded him such wonderful opportunities, and most of all, loved his family. Nancy Heusel of Ann Arbor, Michigan peacefully passed into eternal life through the promise of her Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, in the early evening of November 12, 2023. Known throughout her life as possessing an energetic passion for the theater, as an actress and director, Nancy shared her love of (as she described it) "play-making" with her husband Ted for over 50 years. Never allowing herself to be typecast on the stage or in life, she continuously pushed boundaries and created sympathetic ingénues, devious protagonists, revered heroes, and even an anchoress. Nancy remained on the stage well into her 80's. Her final call is best described by her favorite poet, Emily Dickinson, who wrote: "Because I could not stop for Death – He kindly stopped for me."

Born in the spring May 23, 1931 to Hilda and George Born, Nancy grew up in York, Pennsylvania with her parents, older sister (Madeline) and countless aunts and uncles, whose ancestors settled along the east coast in 1633. Nancy's talents as an actress and pianist were discovered at an early age and encouraged by her mother. The Born family relocated to Washington, D.C. after World War II broke out; a city Nancy would always love and remember as the most exciting place to be during those years. Nancy earned her Actor's Equity Card at the young age of 18 doing summer stock, and she pursued another adventure when she chose to attend the University of Michigan as a theater major. It was there that she met Ted, who had cast her in one of his professional shows, and this began a partnership on and off the stage that would span 6 decades. Nancy left for Broadway shortly after graduating from UM, but Ted was able to lure her back to Ann Arbor with the promise of an exciting opportunity in a new summer theater in Saline. They married in 1954, the same year they did their first show together for the Ann Arbor Civic Theater; a community theater group that was very important to Nancy throughout her life and where she was honored with a lifetime achievement award in 2019. Ted's and Nancy's theater careers ran in parallel and were always connected by the love they shared for their 4 children, who caught the "theater bug" early in life. Nancy's enduring legacy, however, will be remembered not for the countless roles she played, but for the fierceness in which she loved her children (Michael (Cindy), Jennifer, Lydia (Lynn) and Mark (Trish)), 10 grandchildren (Sara (Brian), Ben (Tina), David, Giselle, Quinn, Thye (Taylor), Nisha, Marin, Samuel and Lincoln), and 8 great grandchildren (Bethany, Michael, Brandt, Ruby, Sunny, Rhyelle).

In addition to her family, Nancy would have considered her greatest contributions to be her decades' long relationships with Greenhill's School, where she shared her gifts with drama students for over 40 years, and St. Andrew's Episcopal Church, where she served as the Director of Christian Education for over 45 years and introduced a theatrical ministry. Ted and Nancy began attending St. Andrew's in the early 1950's and remained lifelong members. They founded a theater program in the 1980's known as the St. Andrew's Players, where they brought in notable actors to perform liturgical dramas in the sanctuary. Nancy continued to direct and produce shows for the theater program until she was nearly 90. Nancy was always in the hunt for a performance venue, whether it was summer stock in Maine, Arts Theater, the Trueblood, Lydia Mendelson, the Power Center, the Michigan Theater, Performance Network, the Arthur Miller Theater, or the Michigan League Dinner Theater, which she organized as a fundraising opportunity to support the continuing legacy of the Michigan League, a place very close to her heart: if a stage could be erected, Nancy would create a captivating experience. And, so she was in her life, to her children and the scores of people she inspired. Nancy was preceded in death by her son, Michael and husband, Ted.
