The family came to America in 1883 and made their Mr. Eisele was married April 29, 1897, in St. Mary's Church, to Wilhelmina Koch. Entrepreneurial Heritage - Riemenschneider roots go deep in community

When local businessman Bob Riemenschneider founded Riemco Homes in the late 1980s, he continued a family tradition of craftsmanship and attention to detail that dates more than 500 years. One of his ancestors, Tilman Riemenschneider, was one of Germany's finest wood sculptors and carvers in the late 15th and early 16th centuries. Tilman would no doubt be amazed at what his descendants have achieved in the Chelsea area.

"My ancestors were honest, hard working and successful people. They left a legacy that has been always in my consciousness and has greatly influenced my life," Bob Riemenschneider says. Riemenschneider's great-grandfather John emigrated from Germany to America in the mid 1800s, fleeing civil unrest and war between European nations. "My great-grandfather was determined that his sons were not going to be cannon fodder for the German army and therefore made arrangements to move his family to the United States," Riemenschneider says.

"We don't know why Michigan was chosen as the chosen settling place. It can only be assumed that because this area had a large German settlement that my great-grandfather knew of other German families that had emigrated to this area, or possibly just knew that there would be like kind families that would provide a welcoming and encouraging environment within which to raise his family." Family lore has it – as told by Riemenschneider's grandfather to cousin Arlene Boyce Howe, a lifelong local resident — that passage was booked on a brand new ship making its maiden voyage.

Unfortunately, the family arrived late for boarding, to find their reservations had been sold to another family and there was no more room. The only ship offering passage was very old and in very poor repair. "There was great concern that if they booked passage, that they might not make it," Riemenschneider says. "It was decided by my great-grandparents that they were better off taking their chances on this ship than going back. After weathering severe storms and facing terrible conditions, they did make it to the United States. "What they did learn, however, was that the ship that they were originally booked on did not make it and was lost at sea, with no survivors."

After arriving in Michigan with his three sons and two daughters, John Riemenschneider acquired land and began farming in western Sylvan Township. Here Bob Riemenschneider's grandfather Charles was born,

On John's death, Charles and his brother Philip continued to operate the farms, which encompassed a good part of the land from the south side of Crooked Lake, along the west shore of Cavanaugh Lake and south to the existing I-94 expressway. "Today, my grandfather's farm is owned by Tom Stock and Dr.

Feller acquired a portion of the farm that Philip Riemenschneider owned," Riemenschneider says. Charles married Christina Kalmbach and the union produced two children, Alma and Lawrence – Riemenschneider's father – who left the family farm at the age of 15 to pursue his curiosities and inquisitiveness at college.

"My father was extremely inquisitive and had a passion to understand 'what makes the world tick' — his own words," Riemenschneider says. "He was very independent and determined that he couldn't learn enough and fast enough at college, so he left and started on a life long journey of self educating himself in the areas of mechanical and chemical engineering, bacteriology, and numerous other pursuits. This insatiable curiosity led to numerous inventions, patents and subsequent spin-off businesses."

Lawrence Riemenschneider's independent streak clearly rubbed off on his three children. Bob's older brother Karl took over their father's business and ran it until his death at the age of 45. Bob's sister Alyce, owns Riemenschneider Design, the Ann Arbor interior design firm selected for the new Chelsea District Library.

Riemenschneider began in business locally in 1972, when he opened a real estate firm in partnership with John Pierson. "I loved the real estate business and did well at it, however, I had a real itch to do something that was more tangible," he says. "A natural extension of the real estate business is the building business, which I started in the late 1980s."

His father's influence and curiosity has led Riemenschneider to explore all of the various emerging building technologies. "Subsequently, my company has been at the leading edge of using the new technologies that are available," he says. "We've incorporated many of these into the 200-plus custom homes we've built throughout Washtenaw, Livingston, Wayne, Monroe, Lenawee and Jackson counties, ranging from starter homes to those well in excess of one million dollars.

"Many of the homes we've been doing have been on the local lakes. In many cases, the old cottages have made way for a new Riemco custom designed home."

The family has continued to put down deep roots in the local area. Riemenschneider, a 1963 Chelsea High School grad who enjoyed athletics, basketball and football, serves on the board of the Chelsea Community Foundation and has been a member of Kiwanis. His wife Jeanene has been very active in the Chelsea Community Hospital Auxiliary, Faith in Action, Modern Mothers and St. Mary Catholic Church. The pair enjoys being surrounded by family – son Rob and daughter Sue, and grandchildren Meghan and Evan Grau, and Jake, Peter and Ella Riemenschneider.

And the family legacy continues — son Rob has been an integral part of the building business since its inception and currently is in charge of all daily operations, and Rob's wife, Jennifer, runs the office. Daughter Sue Grau also is a local entrepreneur, the owner of 107 Hair Design on West Middle Street in Chelsea.

Riemenschneider says it's been extremely important for him to know that his ancestors would be proud of the homes he has built and the business dealings he has had with customers. "It gives our family great pleasure in knowing that we are providing quality living environments for many people throughout the area."

Life-long Chelsea resident and former Chelsea Village Manager Frederick "Fritz" Weber died last Friday morning May 26, 1989 at his home after a long illness. He was 58. Weber, who served as village manager from 1969 until shortly before his death, was the village's first manager. Upon being elected village president in 1989 he was appointed manager and promptly resigned as president. He had worked part-time at his home for more than a year, primarily on financial matters. One of his final official acts was to create the village's current budget, as well as help new manager Robert Stalker adjust to the job. Weber had planned to retire officially June 1 and had been eagerly anticipating his daughter, Shelley's, wedding. Arrangements had been made for the Chelsea Fire Department Rescue Squad to take him to the ceremony. "I feel very bad," said village president Jerry Satterthwaite. "Other than his family, he put the village foremost in his life. I guess his major accomplishment was that he made sure the village was on solid "financial ground. He was very conservative and he made sure money wasn't squandered."

Satterthwaite said that Weber was instrumental in making sure the village's electrical utility was not

sold off to Consumers Power Co. in the 1970's, and that stands as perhaps the wisest decision the village has ever made.

Weber's colleagues and friends almost invariably use the word "dedicated" to describe him. They say he was dedicated to his family, the village, and softball. Three of his four daughters played softball for Chelsea High School and Weber spent many afternoons watching them play. In addition, he was the driving force behind the establishment of Dana Park, where area softball teams play virtually every night of the week. A Fritz Weber Memorial SoftballAward has been set up at Chelsea High school. One of Weber's closest friends, Johnson's How-To Store owner Sam Johnson, said being village manager was more than just a job to Weber. "He was personally interested," Johnson said. "I think that'swhy he used togetso upset when the village was criticized. It wasn't just a job to him and I think he had a hard time separating his personal feelings about the village. Personally, I'd like to see him honored by having one of the fields at Dana Park named Weber Field."

As part of his job, Weber was also instrumental in forming the Michigan Public Power Agency, which has helped the village purchase electricity at reduced rates. That, in turn, has translated into a reserve of more than \$2 million, which the village borrows against to finance major repairs and other projects. Weber served as MPPA commissioner in 1978, as secretary-treasurer from 1983-85, and vice-chairman from 198-88. He was also elected to the board of directors of the Michigan MunicipalElectric Association in 1978 and served as its president in 1980-81. Weber was also a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and Knights of Columbus Council 3092. He was a veteran of the U.S. Army during the Korean Conflict.

He is survived by his widow, Sandra, and four daughters, Joan, Michelle, Anne, and Karen, all of Chelsea. Other survivors are his brother, William, of Chelsea, and brother, Robert, of Owosso, and two sisters, Mary K. and Phyllis Weber, also of Chelsea.

Frederick A. "Fritz" Weber, 175 Orchard St., Chelsea, age 58, died Friday morning, May 26, 1989 at his home following a lingering illness. Fritz was a life-long resident of Chelsea and was the first Chelsea Village Manager, serving in the position form April 1, 1969 until his death. He was a member of St. Mary's Catholic Church and the Knights of Columbus Council 3092 and a veteran of the U. S. Army during the Korean Conflict.

Surviving, in addition to his wife, are his four daughters, Joan, Michelle, Anne, and Karen, all of Chelsea; two brothers, William C. Weber of Chelsea, Robert L. Weber of Owosso; and two sisters, Mary K. Weber and Phyllis Weber both of Chelsea: and several nieces and nephews.
