He then engaged in the threshing and driving-well business. In May 1880, he rented the Goodyear House, which he ran until February 1881. During residence in Scio township, himself and Mr. Staebler built a steam saw-mill, and later he sold his interest to Mr. Staebler. His is now interested in a patent hay elevator. Mr. Brenner is a member of the I.O.O.F., at Ann Arbor; also of Co. A, Michigan State Militia, at the same city. William Hoffmeyer was born on Feb. 8, 1930 and died March 29, 2004 in Holland, Michigan. Some people achieve greatness by some notable act, something that is recognized in the newspapers or mentioned on the radio. Others, like William Richard Hoffmeyer, are quiet heroes, whose great deeds were softly given to the people fortunate enough to have them in their lives. Times were hard in the United States in 1930. Unemployment rates were high and spirits were low as many American families tried to stretch their dollars in order to survive the Great Depression. Despite challenges, however, the American spirit was not jilted and with the discovery of a ninth planet "Pluto", there was a feeling that anything was possible. For Kenneth Orin and Reta (Gilbert) Hoffmeyer of Lansing, Michigan, they were having a celebration of their own with the birth of their first child, William Richard. Born on February 8, 1930, Bill would later become big brother to Nan, J.G. "Bud", and Shirley. Bill's father worked at Fisher Body Division in Lansing where he was also active in the Union. Although Reta was a practicing nurse before marrying Kenneth, she put this profession aside to be a consummate stay-athome mom to her four children.

Young Bill grew up and lived his life on the east side of Lansing. It was obvious from a young age that Bill was a very bright boy – bright enough to skip a grade in school. He excelled in the classroom, especially in his favorite studies, which included math, social studies and geography, and held his own when it came to English. When he wasn't busy with school, Bill, like most boys his age, enjoyed sports. Though he never played on the school teams, he enjoyed being a manager and remained an avid fan throughout his life. Bill also worked at a local gas station while still in high school and later in life he boasted about his 32 cents an hour salary. In 1947, Bill graduated from Eastern High School in Lansing and received a full scholarship to the University of Michigan. His mother wanted to ensure that Bill would complete his education without graduating in debt, so she took a job in order to pay for the added expenses. She was truly proud to be able to help her son get the best education possible and have a bright future ahead of him. In college, Bill once again proved his outstanding ability in math and on Saturday, June 16, 1951, he received his B.S. degree in Engineering from the University of Michigan. Years later, his ever sharp methodical mind could recount for you the exact time and day of the event and who spoke to the graduating class without blinking an eye.

Another of Bill's quirky traits was his obsession with organization. For example, Bill made a detailed map of his family's freezer. Everything in the freezer was labeled with numbers, and the map depicted where each number was located in the freezer along with a description of its contents. Ultimately, this map would cut down on the time the freezer stood open therefore conserving energy costs.

One of the greatest joys of Bill's childhood was the couple of summers he spent at his grandparents' farm in central Michigan. He happily learned about farm life, lending a hand wherever he could with the daily chores. As a young boy, Bill had trouble saying his grandmother's first name, Gertrude, so she adoringly became known as "Goo." Grandma Goo also dubbed her young grandson with the nickname "Bol" because he screamed like a Bolshevik as an infant. These pet names are affectionately used today.

After graduating from U of M, Bill was accepted into the General Electric training program in Erie, Pennsylvania. The program took him to Schenectady, New York where he found himself working for \$68.00 a week. On his second Sunday in New York, Bill attended service at the 1st Methodist Church, and he was invited to the Young Peoples' Group that night. It was on this fateful night that he met a fascinating young lady named Virginia "Ginny" Ziegler and her friend also named Ginny. It just so happened that Ginny was a secretary at GE where she did payroll. With her interest peaked after meeting Bill, Ginny returned to work on Monday and took a peek at his personnel records, which was against the rules at that time. The personnel records confirmed what she had already suspected; he was a great guy. Their first date was to see the movie "Singing in the Rain" with Gene Kelly. Bill believed in being upfront with Ginny and told her that he didn't want to stay in New York and that if a job was available elsewhere, he would move. This did not change Ginny's feelings and the young couple continued to foster their newfound love. On the week of Memorial Day, Bill's parents and sister Shirley traveled to New York to visit Bill. While they were out sightseeing, Bill asked Ginny to be his wife to which she emphatically said "yes." On October 4, 1952, in the Scotia Methodist Church, the young couple was happily married.

It was also during this time that Bill accepted a job at the GE plant in Fort Wayne, which he was to start in July 1952. The newlyweds began their life together in a little upstairs apartment. On July 11, 1955, after three years in Fort Wayne, Bill enlisted with the U.S. Army. He was transferred to Virginia where he served as a private in the Army Signal Corp., and he was involved in the testing of missile defense systems. Eventually he assumed full technical responsibilities for developing some of the first computers to interpret manually sent Morse Code massages. After being discharged in 1957, Bill and Ginny moved to Holland where Bill once again resumed his work with GE in the Hermetic Motor Research and Development Department.

Bill and Ginny welcomed their first child, daughter Ellen, into their hearts and home in 1959, to be followed by daughter Ann and son Steven. Bill loved being a father and would do anything for his children. He spent many hours with his children, from helping them with math homework, to which he became an overflowing fount of

information that was beyond their understanding. Making it a point to always be home for dinner, Bill was active in every phase of their lives. Bill also took the family on a variety of vacations. One week a year was dedicated to visiting museums and historical sights, and a second week was spent in Traverse City, Michigan, simply relaxing. Taking a vacation without the children was not an option for Bill. He simply had too much fun teaching them how to snow ski and water ski. This gifted and talented man used his abilities to make a wonderful life for his family.

After many years with GE, Bill decided to take a job with Marathon Electric in 1975 and moved the family to Schofield, Wisconsin. They stayed in Wisconsin until 1980, and then relocated to Fort Wayne, Indiana, where Bill returned to working for GE. Soon a new opportunity was presented to Bill as vice president of a new and growing company called Synektron Inc. located in Portland, Oregon. Bill was only in this new venture for a brief time before he was diagnosed with Parkinson's disease in May 1984. Because of this unfortunate setback, Bill relinquished his position for a less stressful job in Racine, Wisconsin for Gettys. Due to his failing health, Bill took early retirement in 1990.

Bill belonged to many organizations, and volunteered countless hours throughout his life. He wore many hats, board president, treasurer, or counting the Sunday church offering with his children. Some of the organizations were, Treasurer Holland Jaycees, President Greater Holland United Way, elder and deacon First Presbyterian Church of Holland. Bill was not someone consumed by material gains in life, but by the personal satisfaction of doing the best job that he could in whatever he was doing. He continued this life of service until the challenges of his Parkinson disease became insurmountable. After retiring, Bill and Ginny returned to the Holland area in 1992, where they settled in a condo on Clarewood Court. By July 2003, Bill required more extensive care for his deteriorating health and they moved into Oakcrest Manor, an assisted living center in Holland. Throughout his life, his spare time was put to wonderful use. Bill was a fan of golf, a game he played until he couldn't anymore. He enjoyed various spectator sports, especially University of Michigan football. You could ask Bill any stat or question about college sports and he could tell you "who played, where, when and how." Though nothing could compare to U of M football stats. Consequently, his daughters were advised against bringing home or worse yet marrying an Ohio State graduate.

Besides sports, Bill was also a well-read man who enjoyed reading biographies, history and geography books. He kept current on world events by watching CNN Headline News throughout the day, reading the Wall Street Journal, as well as enjoying Time and Sports Illustrated magazines. His physical well-being was also important to him and like the old adage - he ate an apple a day, and exercised regularly. Although he was tone deaf, Bill could often times be heard singing a cute little ditty while tinkering around the house. With his analytical mind, Bill tried to rationalize Parkinson's disease by writing a paper called "Falling, Fighting and Freezing an Engineer's Perspective", which he presented to the local support group. A humble man, Bill was reserved about his faith, yet was a servant of his church serving in many different capacities. While his children were growing up, he made sure they attended Sunday School, but once they were in high school, he let them decide for themselves what they believed in. He had laid the foundation properly in Christ Jesus. Bill accepted everyone for their own unique and individual qualities and beliefs, even if they were different from his own.

William Richard Hoffmeyer died on Monday, March 29, 2004, at Holland Community Hospital. He is survived by his wife of 51 years, Virginia Hoffmeyer of Holland, Michigan; his children: Ellen (David) Hovey of Santa Clara, California, Ann (James) Merlino of Holland, Michigan, Steven (Jennifer) Hoffmeyer of Mundelein, Illinois; 8 grandchildren; sister, Shirley Maybee of Lansing, Michigan; brother, J.G. "Bud" (Penny) Hoffmeyer of Lansing, Michigan; in-laws, Robert (Theresa) Ziegler of Niskayuna, New York; and several nephews, nieces and cousins.

A memorial service will be held at 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, April 1, at The First Presbyterian Church of Holland with The Rev. Rick Campbell officiating.
