She has also employed private detectives, without hearing any word from the trio. In the meantime, Mrs. Staebler had supported herself by sewing. According to her story she and her husband were married October 21, 1915. Mrs. Delight Staebler came to live with them at once, though Mrs. Bertha Staebler claims that her mother-in-law had money of her own and was not dependent on her son. At the time he was working in an automobile factory for \$6.80 a day. Mrs. Staebler says he insisted they must look out was obliged to do the cooking on a neighbor's stove, take in sewing, and scrub the floors of their three-room apartment.

He husband began to buy unimproved property, out Jefferson Avenue and in the Fairfield subdivision. Mrs. Stabler says her mother-in-law found fault with everything, that she had never liked her son's wife. Eventually, after Lamont was born. Mrs. Stabler claims her husband became jealous of the baby's love for her, in preference to its father or grandmother. "Why wouldn't the baby love the person who cared for him all the time?" said Mrs. Staebler, Friday "I loved him to much. It was only for his sake that I stayed with Ray at all, after his mother had made trouble. Now my only hope is in finding my baby. But sometimes it seems as if I wouldn't go on living without him. In issuing the court order, Judge Hunt decreed that Mrs. Staebler should be given custody of Lamont, if he is found, and that the two pieces of property at Windmill Pointe and in the Fairfield sub-division, should be deeded to her. Staebler had previously deeded this property to his mother, it was learned after his disappearance. Mrs. Staebler is now living with her mother, Mrs. Christine Roller, 8081 Manila Avenue.
