That same year, he moved to Ann Arbor to begin work at the State Savings Bank. In 1943, he became an Assistant Bank Examiner for the State of Michigan and traveled extensively throughout the state. In 1947, he became Assistant Cashier at Ypsilanti Savings Bank and in 1952, he came to Brighton State Bank as Cashier. In 1960, he became Executive Vice President, and in 1976, President and CEO. The Brighton State Bank was eventually merged with the Pacesetter Bank, and he continued to serve on their Board of Directors. Pacesetter bank then merged with Old Kent Bank which eventually merged with the Fifth Third Bank group. Whitney was also instrumental in the creation and development of the Mt. Brighton Ski Area.

Whitney guided the bank through the construction of a new main branch on W. North Street and the opening of several branches throughout Livingston County. He also helped to establish the bank's "correspondent" banking relationship with National Bank of Detroit. His reputation as a progressive banker was written about by Judd Arnett, a popular columnist for the Detroit Free Press, who gave heavy credit to Whitney for the growth and expansion of what had once been a "sleepy country town", because of his openness in lending practices. Judd also mentioned that he could not, however, win a dime off Whitney at golf (1979).
