Peter Andress, a lifelong resident of this county, was born in Lodi Township, June 4, 1842, and on March 30, 1867 was married to Miss Fredericka Stollsteimer, and to them were born two daughters, Mrs. Edward Stierle and Mrs. William Clough. Since the death of his wife, Mr. Andress, had lived alone on his farm west of town. He had of late been in usual health and was in town Friday but later in the day was stricken with an acute attack of pneumonia and died at eleven o'clock the next day November 19, 1910. The funeral was held at the Trinity Lutheran Church Tuesday.
