Gleason Rossetter Cole was born February 5, 1866, at Clyde, Oakland County, Michigan. He was the son of Henry Walcott Cole (b. 7 July 1820, Sherburne, Chenango County, New York) (His father, Henry taught theoretical and instrumental music in Iberia college) and Mary Charlotte Osgood Gleason Cole. Rossetter Cole was the Director of the Musical Department at Iowa College, Grinnell, and vice-president of the National Association of Music Teachers. In 1888, he graduated from the University of Michigan with a degree of Bachelor of Philosophy.

One year after graduating, Rossetter began teaching English in the Ann Arbor High School. In 1889, he taught Latin and German in the Aurora, Illinois, High school. From 1890 to 1892, Rossetter studied music in Berlin under Masters: Heinrich van Eycken, Gustav Kogel & Wilhelm Middelschulte. Rossetter gained admission to the Royal Master School of Composition, the highest school of its kind in Germany, and a part of the Royal Academy of Arts. At the time, he was the 6th American ever admitted. 1894/Member of the New York Manuscript Society 1893/Commissioned to write 5 children's songs for the Worlds' Fair Children's Chorus of 1,200 voices.

He married Miss Fannie Louise Gwinner on August 6, 1896.

Notes for Jacob A. Gwinner:

Past and Present of Washtenaw County, Michigan by Samuel W. Beakes, Chicago: The S.J. Clarke Publishing Co., 1906:

Jacob A. Gwinner, who is now living retired in Ann Arbor, was born in this city in 1869 and is a representative of a worthy German family of Washtenaw County. His parents were William Albert and Amelia (Rupff) Gwinner. The father was born in Germany and in that country he was engaged in the cutlery business. He came of Italian ancestry, his father having removed from Italy to Germany, where he changed the spelling of his name to its present form. William A. Gwinner continued in the country of his nativity until 1857, when he crossed the Atlantic to America, going first to Ohio. There he was employed for a year, after which he came to Ann Arbor, where his people had preceded him. Here he began working for J. C. Mead as a farm hand and when Mr. Mead was elected sheriff of the county he chose Mr. Gwinner as his deputy, and the latter held the office for two years. At the time of the Civil war he espoused the cause of his adopted country and enlisted in 1861 in defense of the Union as a member of the First Michigan Military Band, serving for three months, when he was mustered out. He then went into business with his father and brothers under the firm style of Gwinner & Sons, dealers in cutlery, on Washington Street, Ann Arbor. This mercantile enterprise claimed his attention until 1867, when he rented the Hanscliff Block, which contains the opera house, and was not only manager of the opera house but also conducted a confectionery and ice cream parlor and saloon. In May, 1869, he bought property at No. 220 Detroit Street, where he handled liquors up to the time of his death, which occurred on the 3rd of June, 1901. In the family of Mr. and Mrs. William A. Gwinner were six children, of whom one died in infancy, the others being: William, Jacob, Emma, Julia and Ernest. In his political views the father was a democrat and never faltered in his allegiance to that party. Jacob A. Gwinner acquired his education in the public schools of Ann Arbor and on putting aside his text books he worked for Luick Brothers, in whose employ he remained for eight years. Following his father's death he took charge of the liquor business in connection with his brother William, and after a partnership of four years he purchased his brother's interest in 1897 and conducted the business alone until 1902, when he sold out. He later went into business at No. 109 North Main street, where he conducted the Orient until May, 1905, when he again sold out.

In 1894 Mr. Gwinner was united in marriage to Miss Matie Carr, of Ann Arbor. He votes with the democracy, but is without political aspiration. However, he is interested in all that pertains to the welfare and progress of the

city and has given active co-operation to many movements for the general good. He lives at No. 504 North Fifth avenue, where he owns a fine residence. He has a very wide and favorable acquaintance among the German-American citizens of Ann Arbor and the circle of his friends is constantly increasing.

Richard Van Akkeren Dieterle passed away after a difficult battle with cancer at his beloved Ann Arbor Township farm on February 28, 2012, surrounded by family and friends. He was born in Ann Arbor on December 24, 1941 to Jennie Van Akkeren Dieterle and Robert Richard Dieterle. Richard is survived by his wife, Karen L. Hertenstein, daughter, Elizabeth Caroline Dieterle of Phoenix, Arizona, son, Carl Jarrett Dieterle of Washington D.C., and sister, Caroline Dieterle of Iowa City, Iowa. He is also survived by three precious grandchildren, Alexander, Mila and Eva Srejic of Phoenix, as well as a cousin, Richard (Carroll) Walterhouse of Ann Arbor.

Richard spent his childhood days playing with the children of farm neighbors, hunting small game after school and riding Silver, his strawberry roan pony. He attended the one-room Foster School, which was within walking distance of his farm, until middle school, when it was closed and the students were incorporated into the Ann Arbor Public School District. Richard loved to share memories of his rural

upbringing. He met his lifelong friends Lloyd Braun and Al Honke on the junior high school bus. High school days brought more hunting, running track (hurdles) and becoming an outstanding student of German, as well as a violinist. Richard attended the University of Michigan and was a member of Sigma Chi fraternity. He graduated with a degree in Anthropology before enrolling in the University of Michigan's Medical School, from which he graduated in 1969. This was also the year he started The RFD Boys, a bluegrass band in which he was the fiddle player and emcee. Richard did his internship at Blodgett Hospital in Grand Rapids and returned to the University of Michigan for his pathology residency. He served as a Major in the United States Air Force at Wright Patterson Air Force Base in Dayton, O.H. from 1973-75.

In 1975, Richard returned to live at his childhood farm and began working in the Pathology Department at Allegiance Healthcare System (formerly Foote Hospital) in Jackson, Michigan. He became Director of Pathology in 1990 and retired in June of 2009. Richard enjoyed his physician colleagues and was forever inspired by the lab personnel he had the privilege to work with during those years. Richard was known for his on-stage comedic humor and his extraordinary sense of timing as the RFD Boys' emcee. His last, and proudest, contribution to the art form was an instrumental bluegrass CD of his own compositions, which he completed weeks before his death.
