Notes for Gustav Adolph Krause:

For more than a century, Wolverine has been relentless in its pursuit of providing comfortable and innovative footwear, apparel and gear for consumers. Founder G.A. Krause and his sons built a shoe factory shortly after organizing the Rogue Electric Light and Power Company in Rockford, Michigan. In 1903, quality craftsmen made 300 pairs of tough, dependable work shoes each day in the shoe factory, setting the stage for what would become a standard of excellence in footwear. In 1908, Wolverine opened a tannery next to their shoe factory, supplying the factory with durable leathers. In 1914, the Wolverine brand name was created from the type of tough, durable Wolverine horsehide leather used for its popular "1,000 mile boot." In 2008, Wolverine will celebrate its 125th anniversary in many ways.

- 1883 Gustav Adolph Krause owner & president Hirth, Krause & Co with Fred & Edgar T. Hirth & Adolph, Samuel & Otto Krause wholesale shoes 16 S. He is believed to have said, "There is some opportunity here."
- 1901 First, G.A. organized the Rogue River Electric Light and Power Company and brought electricity to Rockford, Michigan from 5:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. daily.
- 1903 Then G.A. and his sons built a shoe factory in Rockford, Michigan. It made 300 pairs of shoes each day.
- 1908 Next, G.A. and his sons built the Wolverine tannery and began supplying their shoe factory with tough, durable horsehide.
- 1914 The Wolverine brand name was selected for shoes made of Wolverine horsehide leather. They were called "1000 Mile Shoes."
- 1919 Wolverine began national advertising: Wolverine work shoes were sold by one of the earliest national sales forces, and became very popular.
- 1921 Flush with success, the Hirth-Krause Company changed its name to Wolverine Shoe and Tanning Corporation and began to grow ever more quickly.
- 1928 Wolverine began selling shares of the company to its own employees a part of one of the nation's first profit sharing plans.
- 1931 The Great Depression came, and although sales were down factory lines were kept running and shoes were warehoused for better times.
- 1941 During World War II the Wolverine Shoe & Tanning Company went to work for the U.S. Navy, developing pigskin gloves.
- 1946 By the end of the war, Wolverine engineers had created a new leather: pigskin suede, and built a factory to produce it.
- 1952 With horses disappearing from the American landscape Wolverine searched for new ways to use pigskin suede. G.A. Krause's son, Victor led the race.
- 1957 A breakthrough came; the creation of soft, suede casual shoes. America would not be the same. Hush Puppies was born.
- 1958 Hush Puppies shoes got their name from a treat Southerners used to quiet their barking dogs.
- 1959 Wolverine launched the Hush Puppies brand with a heavy marketing and advertising campaign. V. Krause is believed to have said, "There is some promise here."
- 1959 Hush Puppies signed its first licensee: Greb Shoes, Ltd. of Canada. Plans for international expansion were under way.
- 1963 Sales of Hush Puppies shoes went through the roof. One in ten American adults now owned a pair of "Hush Puppies".
- 1964 The company chose a more fitting name, and Wolverine Shoe & Tanning Company became Wolverine World Wide, Inc.
- 1965 Wolverine stock went up on the "Big Board" and was traded on the New York Stock Exchange for the first time.
- 1976 Wolverine World Wide began laying the foundations of its brand family and leading technologies.

The Late 19th and Early 20th Centuries

Wolverine was established in 1883 by G.A. Krause and his uncle, Fred Hirth, and named the Hirth-Krause Company. The son of Prussian immigrants, Krause brought a two-century heritage of leather tanning to the enterprise. The company originally sold leather, buttonhooks, lacing, and soles at wholesale, and purchased finished shoes for retail sale.

Krause began to consolidate vertically after the turn of the century, placing his sons in independent, but related, shoemaking and leather tanning businesses. In 1903, he established a shoe manufacturing business in Rockford, Michigan. His eldest son, Otto, who had a degree in engineering from the University of Michigan, operated this arm of the family enterprise, which supplied finished footwear to the Hirth-Krause retail outlets. Five years later, G.A. and younger son Victor created the Wolverine Tanning Company, also based in Rockford, to supply leather to the shoemaking business.

Victor, whose postsecondary education had included apprenticeships in tanning, would be a driving force behind Wolverine's establishment as a premiere American shoe company. In 1909, he traveled to Milwaukee, Wisconsin, to study a chrome tanning and retanning process developed by master tanner John Pfingsten. By 1914, Victor's own experiments had resulted in a tanning process for "shell horsehide," a cheap, durable, but heretofore unworkably stiff section of hide taken from the horse's rear. The company soon stopped using cowhide in favor of their unique new material.

Promoted as "1,000 mile shoes," sales of the heavy-duty Wolverine boots helped increase corporate earnings almost 700 percent from 1916 to 1923. A centennial company history noted that "Wolverine boots and shoes became one of rural and small-town America's most popular brands."

In 1921, Hirth-Krause and the Rockford shoe factory--which had previously merged under the name Michigan Shoe Makers--were united with Wolverine to form Wolverine Shoe and Tanning Corporation. The company acquired a glove making business that same year and began manufacturing horsehide work gloves. Over the course of the decade, Wolverine built its first warehouse, created an employee profit-sharing plan, launched a nationwide advertising campaign, and erected its first consolidated headquarters.

Carl F. Braun, assistant cashier of the Ann Arbor Savings Bank, was born January 26, 1873, in Ann Arbor Township, this county. His grandfather, John Braun, was a native of Wurtemberg, Germany, and came to Washtenaw County, Michigan, in early life. In his family were eight children: Michael, a farmer residing on the Whitmore Lake Road; Charles, who is farming in the same locality; Henry, who carries on agricultural pursuits on the Dixboro Road; Christian, deceased; Mrs. Christine Kirn, of Ann Arbor; Mrs. Caddie Stein, who is living in Ann Arbor Township; Simon, deceased; and Frederick B., the father of our subject. Frederick B. Braun was a native of Washtenaw county, born in October, 1840, and spent his

entire life here. His father purchased the Vogel farm west of Ann Arbor when he was twelve years of age, and on selling that property bought a farm on the Whitmore Lake road. In 1869 Frederick B. Braun bought the farm on the Dixboro Road, which was his home up to the time of his death. He became recognized as one of the influential and leading business men of the county and was president of the Washtenaw Mutual Fire Insurance Company at the time of his death, which occurred in December, 1902. His success was marked and attributable entirely to his well directed efforts. He was a man of unassailable integrity in his business affairs, was highly respected in all of life's relations, and by his courtesy and kindliness he won hosts of friends who hold his memory sacred. He was a republican in his political views, very prominent in the ranks of the party, and held almost every township office. He belonged to the Zion Lutheran church and was a man of upright life and of marked influence, leaving the impress of his individuality for good upon many public movements.

Friedrich Benjamin married Regina Kirn, also a native of Michigan, and to them were born three children: Carl F.; Benjamin N., who is senior engineer in the University of Michigan; and Caddie M., who died in 1887. Reared in the county of his nativity and educated in the public schools, Carl F. Braun is a graduate of the Ann Arbor high school of the class of 1892. He continued to assist his father in carrying on general agricultural pursuits until January, 1894, when he entered the Ann Arbor Savings Bank in the position of collector. He has been successively promoted to bookkeeper, teller and assistant cashier, filling the latter position at the present writing. This bank stands first in Michigan in point of surplus to capital, with total resources of over two million dollars. Mr. Braun has become interested in other business enterprises, being now a director in the Crescent works, where corsets, waists and skirts are extensively manufactured. He and his brother still retain the ownership of the homestead property, which is a fine dairy farm, comprising one hundred sixty-three and a half acres of land.

In October, 1899, Mr. Braun was united in, marriage to Miss Marie C. Knapp, of Chicago, and they have one son, Roger K., who is five years of age. Mr. Braun is an independent republican in his political views. For about ten years he has been one of the directors of the Alumni Association and has also been treasurer during that entire time. He is a young man of excellent business ability, who is steadily working his way upward, realizing that capability and close application constitute the basis of all success.

Principal Research Interests - Ubiquitination and Degradation

The entire population of proteins in an organism, known as the proteome, is dynamic and rich in diversity. It is estimated that the human proteome consists of >200,000-2,000,000 distinct protein forms despite only 20,000 proteins encoded by the genome. Giving rise to this complexity are the myriad covalent modifications that occur on the side chains of amino acid residues embedded within proteins. The ensemble of alterations is termed posttranslational modifications (PTMs), reflecting the timing within the context of the central dogma in biology. PTMs consist of the covalent attachment of both small molecules (phosphate, methyl, glycosyl, or acetyl) and proteins, e.g., ubiquitin and ubiquitin-like molecules (UBLs). Many PTMs are entwined with one another resulting in dramatic physiological changes if a single node within the cellular network is malfunctioning.

Take for example, the two most abundant mechanisms for regulating protein function, phosphorylation and ubiquitination. Their codependence during the cell cycle and immune response relates miscues to aberrant cellular events on a global scale ultimately leading to the development of immune disorders and cancer. Against this backdrop, our laboratory is interested in the molecular details associated with the tethering of ubiquitin and UBLs to proteins. An intricate network of enzymes are responsible for carrying out the coupling and uncoupling of ubiquitin/UBLs to and from target proteins. Specifically, three types of enzyme — E1, E2, and E3 — attach ubiquitin/UBLs, and in most cases, assemble polymeric chains of ubiquitin molecules tethered to substrates. E1s activate ubiquitin/UBLs. E2s transfer ubiquitin/UBLs from E1 and couple them to an e-amino group of a lysine residue in the target, while E3s sequester specific substrates catalyzing the ligation to targets. The outcome of

these steps can be reversed through the action of deubiquitylating enzymes (DUBs). Although a great deal is known about the overall ubiquitin cascade, it is unclear how the communication between E2-E3 controls ubiquitination; which substrates a given E3 is responsible for modifying; and how E3-catalyzed polyubiquitin chain formation occurs on a molecular level. Answers to these questions are not only critical for the development of new therapeutics but also for the functional interpretation of mutant forms of enzymes that lead to human disease. To address these questions we use ideas and methods from organic chemistry, biochemistry, molecular biology and cell biology.

An Air Force captain, the son of a Temperance minister, was killed Wednesday when his A-10 jet aircraft crashed shortly after takeoff from Eielson Air Force Base, 23 miles south of Fairbanks, Alaska. Capt. Jonathan Scheer, 31, the son of the Rev. Ronald and Carol-Lynn Scheer, crashed three miles from the base after beginning what was supposed to be a nighttime training exercise involving a four-plane squadron. Captain Scheer flew the first plane out about 8:30 p.m. Fairbanks time and was to be the training exercise leader. Captain Scheer, an Air Force instructor pilot, was a 1990 graduate of Oscoda (Mich.) High School and a 1995 graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs. He had two tours of duty in Korea, each a year apiece, and had spent some time in Kosovo, his father said.

The Air Force provided few details of the crash pending the outcome of an investigation. The A-10, nicknamed the Warthog, is the first Air Force aircraft specially designed for close air support of ground forces. The A-10 is a twin-engine aircraft that can be used against all ground targets, including tanks and other armored vehicles, according to the Air Force. Mr. Scheer, pastor of Christ the King Lutheran Church in Bedford Township, said yesterday that Lent is a time during which he reminds himself how God gave the world his only son. But even as a minister, Mr. Scheer said he didn t fully appreciate the sacrifice and the heartache until he learned that his only son had been killed. "Yes, it's devastating," he said, unable to hold back tears.

He said his son had a passion for aviation since growing up in Oscoda and watching the number of townsfolk in that small northern Michigan city affiliated with nearby Wurtsmith Air Force Base when it was open. It closed several years ago. "Flying was his thing," he said. Mr. Scheer said his son was within 30 days of being assigned to the Middle East and was looking forward to his upcoming assignment, which the family presumed would be in Iraq or Afghanistan. They intentionally were kept in the dark about it, he said. "It's like the Super Bowl. Everybody [in the Air Force] wants to go. They have that passion to fly and to serve their country," he said.

In high school, the younger Mr. Scheer was a clean-cut student who kept track of school cameras, the basketball team s statistics, and its supplies as the team manager. He had a reputation as a wholesome young man with an even-keeled personality. He was never seen putting down another student, said Doug Ehle, a former Oscoda High basketball coach and longtime family friend. "A lot of kids looked up to him for his intelligence and caring attitude," he said. The crash "has really taken a lot of us aback. You just want to think it's a bad dream."

Surviving are his parents, Ronald and Carol-Lynn Scheer; sister, Pamela Bailey, and grandparents, Clarence and Geraldine Rafeld.

A memorial service at the Air Force base in Alaska will be at 2 p.m. tomorrow. Additional services are pending at the Bedford Funeral Chapel, Temperance. Mr. Scheer said he too is planning one at his church. Burial will be at the Air Force Academy Cemetery.

Eielson Air Force Base, Alaska - The morning of Feb. 26, 2004 brought sad news of a heart-breaking incident from the night prior--an aircraft crash at Eielson Air Force Base. Details would be sketchy at work later that day; except for one fact--the Iceman family had lost one of its own. Later, it would become clear what had happened. Maj. Jonathan Scheer, flying A-10 78-700, had been leading a four-ship night vision goggle upgrade mission the night of Feb. 25 in preparation for Operation ENDURING FREEDOM.

Just after leaving Eielson, at 8:31 p.m., Major Jonathan "Cosmo" Scheer gave his last full measure before his aircraft would impact the earth rendering him fatally wounded. Our Iceman family had lost a greatly respected and admired teacher, friend. Airman, and warrior who had immeasurably touched our family.

Major Scheer entered the Air Force in 1995 after graduating from the United States Air Force Academy with an Aeronautical Engineering degree. He later graduated from EURO-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training at Sheppard AFB, Texas, with orders in hand to fly the A-10 THUNDERBOLT II. Major Scheer's relentless and first-class performance earned his selection as one of only three A-10 pilots in the world to attend the Air Force Weapons Instructor Course. Upon graduating pilot training in 1996 from Sheppard AFB, Major Scheer was assigned to the 25th Fighter Squadron at Osan AB, Korea, where he served as an "Assam Draggin."

In 1998, he was reassigned to the 75th Fighter Squadron at Pope AFB, North Carolina, as a "Tiger Shark" A-10 instructor pilot. In 2001, Major Scheer was reassigned back to Osan AB, Korea, this time as the 25th Fighter Squadron's Weapons Officer. In February of 2003, he was assigned as an "Arctic Hawg" weapons officer with the 355th Fighter Squadron at Eielson AFB, and in 2004, he joined the 354th Operations Support Squadron as the Wing Weapons Officer. Major Scheer was a senior pilot with 1,882 flying hours in the A-10; having flown 23 combat and 18 combat support sorties during Operations ALLIED FORCE and SOUTHERN WATCH.

He earned and received recognition as the 355th Fighter Squadron's Flight Commander of the Quarter, 354th Operations Group's Instructor Pilot of the Quarter, 354th Operations Group's Flight Commander of the Year, and was the Squadron Officer School's Ritchey Leadership Excellence Award recipient. Major Scheer's decorations include the Air Medal with one oak leaf cluster, the Air Force Commendation Medal with two oak leaf clusters, the Aerial Achievement Medal with four oak leaf clusters, the Joint Service Achievement Medal, and the Air Force Achievement Medal.

On April 23, 2007, Maj. Jonathan P. Scheer's parents will be part of a memorialization ceremony fitting for our Iceman family's aviator. The idea for naming the 354th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron's conference room in

honor of Major Scheer was born within the mind of then-354th Aircraft Maintenance Squadron commander, Maj. Timothy Kirk, close friend to Major Scheer and later built upon by the current commander, Lt. Col. Rick Petito.

A specially framed photo of Major Scheer was originally placed in the squadron's conference room along with an above-the-door sign unofficially designating it as the Scheer Conference Room. From there, the idea has grown into an official Air Force Memorialization of the room. After the ceremony, the room will additionally adorn a hand-painted canvas of Major Scheer's jet and a 3-D model of his A-10 to accompany his photo, along with specially arranged fixed lighting to brighten the wall 24/7/365. Outside of the doorway to the conference room will be a specially-cast bronze plaque.
