Past and Present of Washtenaw County, Michigan by Samuel W. Beakes, Chicago: The S.J. Clarke Publishing Co., 1906:

John Keppler is the owner of a fine and well improved farm in Ann Arbor Township. He was born in Germany in 1834 and his parents, George Adam and Mary (Staeb) Keppler, were also natives of that country. The father, following the occupation of farming throughout his entire life, died in Germany in 1837. The subject of this review spent his first twenty years in his native land, acquiring a fair education in the public schools and in 1854 he crossed the Atlantic to America, making his way at once to Michigan. He settled in Scio Township, Washtenaw County, where he was employed for some time as a farm hand, being thus engaged until 1861, when he was united in marriage to Miss Marie Steffey, a daughter of Abraham Steffey, a native of Pennsylvania, in which state Mrs. Keppler was also born. Following his marriage Mr. Keppler began the operation of a farm in Northfield Township on the shares and thus spent four years. In 1865 he removed to the Tower farm, which he rented for three years but remained thereon for only a year, when he rented the place to another party and bought fifty acres of land on section 9, Ann Arbor Township. There he began farming on his own account, making that place his home until 1902. About 1878 he bought forty acres on section 16 of the same township. For a long period he carried on general agricultural pursuits and also raised sheep and cattle and fed cattle for the market. At one time he operated a threshing machine, using horse power. His farm is now largely devoted to the raising of oats, wheat and potatoes and he annually harvests good crops, which find a ready sale on the market. In 1870 he built a good residence upon his farm and he has built two barns, one thirty-two by forty-six feet and the other twenty by forty feet. He also built a granary sixteen by twenty-four feet. In 1902 he erected a residence on his forty-acre tract of land on section 16, Ann Arbor Township, where he is now living with his wife. He continued the active operation of the farm until 1902, when he turned it over to the care of his son, while he is now practically living retired. Unto Mr. and Mrs. Keppler were born five children: John Milton; George Adam, who is operating the old home farm; Lewis J., who is living in Ann Arbor Township; Emory A., who resides in the city of Ann Arbor; and William C., who lives in Tower City, North Dakota.

In his political views Mr. Keppler is a stalwart republican, having firm faith in the principles of the party and doing all in his power to promote its growth and insure its success. He has been township treasurer for three terms, has also served on the school board for a number of years and was moderator for one term. He belongs to Zion church and is deeply interested in the material, intellectual and moral progress of the community in which he has so long made his home. As a farmer he was active and industrious, systematizing his work and carrying on the labors of the fields in harmony with the advanced ideas of modern agriculture and now he is enjoying a well earned rest, his labors being crowned with the fruits of former toil.

April 17, 1930 - Levi Keppler, 24, Ann Arbor; Willard Clawson, 60, Ypsilanti, and Harry Walters, 28, Ypsilanti, were electrocuted Sunday afternoon when an airplane became entangled in the high tension wires while attempting to make a landing at the Ypsilanti Airport. Leon Hanselmann, 24, of Ann Arbor, pilot, was slightly hurt and taken to Beyer hospital In Ypsilanti for treatment. Hanselmann, who has been an air enthusiast for some time, rents a hangar at the Ypsilanti airport and took his friend Keppler for a ride Sunday and was preparing to land when the accident occurred. Keppler was not injured in the fall but remained imprisoned in his seat in a tangle of high tension wires while rescuers struggled to release him. He died when he rose from his seat to jump, the change in position bringing him into contact with the high voltage.

Walters was killed when he attempted to release Keppler. Clawson, a bystander, was killed when he sought to draw Walter's body away from the wires. It is said that Hanselmann's plane approached the airport from the west, flying low with the motor apparently dead. The ship side-slipped and nearly went out of control before it got to the port. The plane's tail hooked on a high tension wire at the side of the field and burst into flames. The nose fell forward dragging the wires and throwing the pilot to the ground. Keppler, the passenger, remained imprisoned in the ship. Attendants attempted to extinguish the flames but they had gained too great a headway. Most of this was witnessed by Keppler's mother who had to be restrained from rushing into the tangle of highly charged wires.

Louis H. Boes, well known in the educational and musical circles of Ann Arbor, is now a teacher in the Zion Lutheran parochial school, an organist in the church and director of the choir. A native son of Indiana, he was born in Richmond, September 26, 1871, and is of German parentage. His father, Adam Boes, is a native of Hanover, Germany, and is a carpenter by trade, yet connected with building operations in Richmond, Indiana. His wife, who bore the maiden name of Catherine Cutter, was also a native of Germany. They became the parents of five children, of whom four are living: Louis H.; Minnie, a resident of Richmond, Indiana; Mrs. Flora Beck, who is living in Youngstown, Ohio; Eleanora, also of Richmond; and Frederick, who died at the age of two years.

The high points in the life, the death, and funeral services of Reinhold E. Boes, Michigan Alpha, are recounted in the following account from the Detroit press:

"Funeral services for Reinhold E. Boes, '32, prominent advertising man, who died Saturday morning following an attack of acute appendicitis, were to be held at 1:00 P.M. today in his residence, 570 Cadieux Road, Grosse Pointe. "He was born in Ann Arbor, January 6, 1899, son of Mr. and Mrs. Louis H. Boes. He attended Ann Arbor High School and the University of Michigan, receiving a literary degree in February, 1921. He came to Detroit immediately after graduation and joined the sales department of the Burroughs Adding Machine Company. He then was successively a member of the staffs of the Campbell-Ewald, McDonald, Ramsdell & Wood, George

Harrison Phelps, Incorporated, and Advertisers, Incorporated, advertising agencies. Although but 32 years of age he was considered an authority on media and research.

"Boes is survived by his father, Louis H. Boes of Ann Arbor, a sister, Mrs. Francis M. Smith of Scarsdale, New York, and a brother, Luther Boes, also of Scarsdale. He was a member of the Sigma Phi Epsilon Fraternity and the Detroit Boat Club.

The cake was cut by Mrs. Lutz, and coffee was poured by Mrs. George Petersen.
