Christoph Kusterer.—Each individual is called upon to work out his destiny according to his own ideas. Some make a success of their life efforts, while others fail; but it is usually found that the men who attain the most are those who concentrate along a given line of endeavor and direct all their energies toward its successful prosecution. In the case of the late Christoph Kusterer, his record shows that he was a man who thoroughly understood his business and was never afraid of the hard work connected with it. As a result, he built up one of Grand Rapids' large industries and left his family not only wealth, but the heritage of a good name and the memory of a kind husband and father. For years he was one of the substantial men of Grand Rapids and the city benefitted by his connection with it, for he was a practical business man who believed in action rather than words. Mr. Kusterer was born May 24, 1824, in Wurttemburg, Germany, where his father owned a large estate in the Black Forest, and his education was secured in the nearby town of Freudenstadt, where he also learned the art of brewing.

At the age of twenty-two years, having been exempted from military duty, he came to the United States and immediately settled at Ann Arbor, Michigan, where he engaged in the tanning business. There he was married, April 12, 1847, to Maria Dorothea Dauble, and in the following September disposed of his interests in the tannery and came to Grand Rapids. Here he bought a one-half interest in the Pannel Brewery, which was located on what is now known as the corner of Lyon Street and Bond Avenue, and he subsequently bought out Mr. Pannel's interest. In 1850 he built the City Brewery, at the corner of Bridge and Ionia streets, the site where the Grand Rapids Brewing Company is now located, and this was conducted until 1881, when the Kusterer Brewing Company was formed, with Charles F. Kusterer as president and manager. In 1892 this was consolidated with other plants and the Grand Rapids Brewing Company was formed, the other companies being the Tusch Brothers Brewery, the Veit & Rathman Brewery, the Union Brewery of George W. Brandt & Company and the Adolph Goetz Brewery, the brewery of Frey Brothers being subsequently purchased at the administrator's sale. The officers were Charles F. Kusterer, president; Jacob Veit, vice-president; F. A. Tusch, secretary, and C. E. Kusterer, treasurer, and the capital at incorporation was \$500,000, which was later increased to \$1,000,000. In 1895 a new plant was erected on the same property. The present officials of the company are: G. A. Kusterer, president; F. A. Veit, vice-president and superintendent, and J. F. Cramer, secretary and treasurer.

Mr. Kusterer lost his life on the ill-fated "Alpena," while making a business trip to Chicago, and at his death left a widow and eight children. Mr. Kusterer, in all his associations, with friends, business associates and competitors, and the public at large, impressed through a pleasing personality, and was widely respected and esteemed. He was interested in all that pertained to substantial progress in his adopted city, in all the cultural activities and material advancement that have made notable recent years, and, as far as lay within his power, exerted his influence in these directions. The family home for over fifty years was situated at the corner of Ionia avenue and Michigan street, where the present fine Armory is now located.

## Page 184:

The Hydraulic Company's charter was drawn by Solomon L. Withey, who became a member of the company, and its first meeting was held, June 20, 1849, at which time its organization was completed by the election of officers. Canton Smith was its first president, and its stock books were opened for subscription, June 22, 1849. Having reached the limit of its supply, while the demand was steadily increasing, the company began to look about for more water. This they obtained from springs a little south of Wealthy Street and east of Jefferson, laying logs from that locality to Fulton Street, and thence toward the river. They then had a fairly adequate supply for the residents along their lines, and that portion of the then business part of the town west of Division and south of Pearl Street. But the city continued to grow, while the springs did not, and more water must be had. The company went still further south and gathered the outflow from several springs on what was then called the "Penney eighty." About 1854 Christopher Kusterer and John Mangold began the use of a large spring between Michigan and Hastings, a little east of Ottawa street, as a source of water supply for domestic use. Previously, at a very early day, a portion of the stream from that spring had been carried down Michigan Street to a watering trough in front of the old Bridge Street House, and this for years made an excellent watering place for horses. In the summer of 1855 the council gave permission to the proprietors of the Bridge Street House and Western Hotel to lay pipes from the spring mentioned for their own use. Kusterer and Mangold, under a franchise obtained in 1859 from the council, after having constructed a reservoir in which they collected the waters from this and other contiguous springs, laid pump logs down Michigan street and through Kent alley to Lyon street; also to and along by the buildings on the west side of old Canal street, as far south as Huron, and down old Canal street to near Pearl, giving to the residents thus reached a fair supply of excellent water for domestic use. Neither they nor the Hydraulic Company had sufficient pressure to carry water much above the second floors of buildings even on the lower levels. Only wooden pipes or logs were used until 1857, when upon the first paving of Monroe Street, the Hydraulic Company laid a small iron main down that thoroughfare.

In 1864, Amos Roberts, Warren P. Mills, James Lyman and Joseph Penney became stockholders in the Grand Rapids Hydraulic Company. The total stock subscription, Oct. 29 of that year, was \$24,800. In 1870 the water rights of the Kusterer & Mangold Company were by mutual arrangement merged in those of the Hydraulic Company. In 1872 the company undertook the construction of a deep reservoir upon ground purchased of Mr. Penney toward the southeastern part of the city, in the hope of greatly increasing its supply. This was a large brick curb with a cast-iron shoe at the bottom, sunk to a depth of about thirty feet.

#### History:

The first brewer in Grand Rapids, Michigan was an Englishman, John Pannell, who came to town in 1836 and built a small brewery over a stream at the bottom of Prospect Hill on the east side of Kent Street. His modest output - "a barrel or two at a brewing" - of English hop beer gradually increased, and by 1844, thanks to rising demand, his brewery was doing quite well. That same year, Christoph Kusterer, a brewer trained in Germany, established a brewery on the west side of the river and shortly thereafter went into partnership with Pannell.

Christoph Kusterer was a prominent figure in the local German-American community. A founding member of the German Evangelical Lutheran Church of Immanuel in 1857, he was the captain of the Grand Rapids Rifles, a German-American militia unit. He also served as a parade marshal for the "Grand German Jollificiation," an event which celebrated Prussia's victory over France in 1871. Kusterer's life came to a tragic end in October 1880 when he, along with all others on board, went down with the steamer 'Alpena' in a violent Lake Michigan storm. His brewing business, however, was carried

on by his sons and grandsons, and the Kusterer name remained linked to the brewing of larger beer in Grand Rapids well into the twentieth century.

The Kusterer's and other German-American brewers stressed the health-fullness of their product and advertised it as a "family drink," especially when compared with whiskey. Their claims may have had some merit, as early Grand Rapids historian Albert Baxter pointed out: "And just here is a coincidence. Ague and fever - the old-fashioned, bone shaking kind - prevailed very largely when t hose German beer makers came. In 1847 chills and shaking ague were terrors of malarially afflicted people, and sallow faces and feeble frames were familiar sights. In the eight years following came two experiences - a great growth in the habit of drinking lager beer, and the almost complete dying out of the shaking ague. It is not the province of the historian to moralize upon these facts, not to attempt an explanation, but only to chronicle the coincidence."

The Kusterer-Pennall partnership lasted until about 1849, when Christoph Kusterer bought out his associate and set about building a brewery on the southeast corner of East Bridge (now Michigan) and Ionia. The Kusterer family brewed lager beer at that site form 1850 until 1917. The Michigan Brewing Company took over the facility in 1935, for five years then sold to Peter Fox Brewing Company.

With the buyout of Pannell in 1849, Christoph Kusterer was the only brewer in Grand Rapids, but competition wasn't long in coming. First to challenge Kusterer's exclusive position were the Christ brothers - Gottlieb, Gustav, & Christian - German immigrants who arrived in Grand Rapids by 1849. While Gustav & Christian found work in Kusterer's brewery, Gottlieb became the proprietor of the Bridge Street House tavern. In June 1850, just a month after the citizens of Grand Rapids voted to approve the charter that would turn their village into a city, the Common Council granted Gottlieb the City of Grand Rapids' first tavern-keeper's license.

Sometime later, the Christ brothers built a large brewery on Ottawa between Bridge and Hastings. They were a leader among the beer making houses until the business was wiped out by the disastrous "Great Fire' of July 13, 1873. The Kusterer and Christ breweries found a ready market for their German-style lager beer among the German immigrants who settled on the west side of Grand Rapids immediately north and south of Bridge Street before the Civil War. Other brewers likewise appeared on the scene to try their hands at satisfying local thirsts, with varying degrees of success. In 1856, German immigrant Peter Weirich built the Michigan Brewery at Bridge and Indiana on the city's west side. Three years later, one J. H. Roberts launched a short-lived brewery operation at the corner of Fountain and Ransom.

In 1862, during the Civil War, George Brandt, who had been a brew master for Christoph Kusterer since 1856, decided to strike out on his own. Joining forces with Christopher Killinger and Fred Mayer, he established the Union Brewery at 87 (formerly 192 before 1874) South Division. By 1865 neither Killinger or Mayer remained in the business. George Brandt stayed on, increasing the value of the brewery's total annual output to about \$60,000 by 1887.

The Frey brothers - Charles, Christian and Frederick - established the Coldbrook Brewery on 72 Coldbrook Street in 1874. The following year John Adrion and Andrew Greil set up the Valley City Brewery on Page between Tile and Plainfield; a short time later the city directory listed the owners of the establishment as John Adrion and Peter Kautenberger. On January 1, 1876, Jacob Veit and Paul Rathman founded the Eagle Brewery on the city's west side at the corner of First and Stocking.

A year later, Adolph Goetz, former brew master at the Kusterer brewery, and Kossuth W. Tusch built the Cincinnati Brewery at 208 Grandville Avenue and began advertising their lager beer as "equal to Cincinnati beer!" which according to claims made by the Cincinnati Chamber of Commerce, enjoyed a national reputation for high quality. In January of 1879 Goetz sold his interest in the Cincinnati Brewery to Kossuth's brother Frederick and left for Colorado where he hoped to setup his own brewing business. His stay out west was brief, however, and he returned to Grand Rapids to become Kusterer's brew master once again.

All of the German brewers concentrated their efforts on the production of lager beer, a light, dry carbonated beverage with a distinct taste of hops that is aged in storage from six weeks to six months before use. Lager beer was the favorite brew of German, Austrian and Dutch consumers. English and Irish beer drinkers, on the other hand, preferred ale and porter, malt beverages that are darker, heavier and usually more bitter then lager beer.

Seeking a way to counter the threat of outside competition and needing additional capital for expansion, the individual Grand Rapids brewers, like other industrialists of the time, ultimately came to

recognize the advantages of joining forces. In December 1892, six Grand Rapids breweries - the Kusterer Brewing Company, Tusch Brothers, George W. Brandt and Company, Veit and Rathman, Adolph Goetz, and the Frey Brothers - consolidated their individual operations to form the Grand Rapids Brewing Company. January 1, 1893 they merged into 'The Grand Rapids Brewing Company' w/ Charles F. Kusterer president, Jacob Viet vice-president, Frederick A. Tusch secretary, CE Kusterer treasurer & Adolph Goetz brew master at SE corner of E. Bridge & Ionia Street; Grand Rapids, Kent Co, Michigan.

History of Kent County, Michigan, Chicago - Charles C. Chapman & Company, 1881. Page 934:

The Kusterer Brewing Company.—This business was founded in 1847, by Christopher Kusterer, with a capital of \$800, when he brewed the small amount of four barrels at a time, doing his own brewing and delivering, since when the business has increased to its present large proportions. Mr. Kusterer operated the business until the fall of 1880, when he took passage on the "Alpine", which was lost with all on board. The business was then purchased by the present company, whose officers are as follows: Philip Kusterer, President; Adolph Lietelt, Vice-President; Charles Kusterer, Secretary and Treasurer. The brewery at the present time consists of a substantial main building, three stories in height, 50x100 feet in size, in connection with which are two icehouses, one 60x60 and the other 25x100, capable of storing over 1,500 tons. The cellars are the largest in the city, and have a storage capacity of 3,500 barrels. The product of this brewery will average 10,000 barrels annually. The company has lately put in a large mash tub, made by Kattentidt, of Chicago, Illinois, with a capacity of 125 barrels. The firm gives employment to 25 men, and the water used in making the beer is obtained from pure springs.

History of Kent County, Michigan, Chicago - Charles C. Chapman & Company, 1881. Page 1062: Christopher Kusterer (deceased) was a son of Jacob Kusterer, of Gumpelscheuer, Wurtemberg, Germany. He spent his boyhood in his native place, attending the public schools. After having been confirmed in the Lutheran faith, in which he was baptized and brought up, he was apprenticed to a brewer of Freudenstadt (a town 18 miles from his home), in his fourteenth year, to learn the brewer's trade. He spent seven years at that place, and when 21 years of age returned home, in obedience to the laws of his country, to run the risk of being chosen as a soldier. Not being drafted, however, he resolved to come to America, and arrived at New York in 1845. He first located at Ann Arbor, Michigan, and was employed in Mr. Kern's brewery for two years. He then removed to Grand Rapids, and became established in the brewing business. A few years later he purchased property on the corner of Ionia and East Bridge streets, and erected a large and substantial brewery. In the fall of 1880 he took passage at Grand Haven on the ill-fated "Alpena," and with the entire crew and passengers found a watery grave in the deep of Lake Michigan. After Mr. Kusterer's death a stock company was formed under the name of the "Kusterer Brewing Co..." which purchased the stock and trade of Mrs. Kusterer, and now operate the business. Mr. Kusterer was a man of the strictest business principles and firm integrity. He was Democratic in politics, and owned a large interest in the Star Flour Mills. He married Mary D. Dauble, of Ann Arbor. Mr. Kusterer was a faithful and loving husband, a kind father, and a man whose loss was mourned by all.

August 14, 1879 - A fire in Kusterer's brewery at Grand Rapids, Michigan, on the 6th inst., destroyed a large stock of grain and liquors. Loss \$120,000.

Dec. 18, 1880 - Christopher Kusterer, of Grand Rapids, who was one of the victims of the Alpena disaster, held an accident insurance policy for \$5,000, and that sum has been paid in full to his widow.

Grand Rapids, November 4, 1881 - At about 2:30 o'clock this morning fire broke out in the brewery of M. D. Kusterer, the largest of the several lager beer manufacturing institutions of this city. The fire was not subdued until nearly morning, and the better part of the brewery was gutted. The loss is estimated at nearly \$15,000, with an insurance of \$12,000. There are some in the city, superstitiously inclined, who connect the present casualty with the drowning of the founder of the concern, Christopher Kusterer, on the Alpena, something over a year since, and think there is something a little out of the ordinary line in it. These, people, however, are the same who see the supernatural cropping out in every mishap that occurs. The fire was one of the most exciting that the city has seen for some time.

Grand Rapids, Michigan, July 21, 1891 - Gustave Kusterer is missing and numerous creditors mourn. He was a son of the late Cristopher Kusterer, who went down on the steamer Alpena, and by his father's death fell heir to \$35,000 and an interest in the big Kusterer brewery here. He struck a fast gait and he not only run through all his own money, but is deep in debt. He started a bottling works as a side issue to the brewery, and the bottling works have been seized on attachments amounting to \$7,000, among the creditors being the Kusterer Brewing Company, \$3,921, and the Pabst Brewing Company, Milwaukee, \$4,961.

July 23, 1891 - Gustave A. Kusterer, of Grand Rapids was left \$40,000 by the death of his father. It would have been all the same had his father left-him 40cents. He spent all he had and is now missing while there are no end of attachments on the property.

In automobile accident with George W. Brandt and William N. Veit December 9, 1914. He was the only survivor.

Grand Rapids - Gustave A. Kusterer, 75 years old, former president of the Grand Rapids Brewing Co., died Saturday Dec. 11, 1943 as a result of a fall at his residence three months ago. He served as president of the firm until it was liquidated at the onset of prohibition. He also was president in 1915 of the Brewers Association of Michigan.
