Duane Strieter, eight-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Strieter, 5186 Austin Rd., suffered a crushed pelvis and a broken rib, when he was run over by a pickup truck being driven by his father, Wednesday August 28, 1957 at 6 p.m. The accident occurred as Mr. Strieter, who had been working in a field on the north side of the toad in back of the house, was backing the truck up to cross the road to the farm buildings. Duane, who was in the back of the pickup, fell to the ground, face down, as it started to move and was run over by the right wheel. His companion, David Burmeister, 10, son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Burmeister, 5475 Austin Rd., remained in the pickup. Duane was rushed to the St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Ann Arbor by Saline Police Officer James Levleit. Mr. Strieter is the clerk of Saline Township.

A local youth was arrested early Sunday morning Nov. 12, 1967 after a high speed chase, that ended with the crash of the pursuing police car. Duane Strieter, 18, of 5186 Austin Rd., was arraigned Tuesday in Municipal

Court in Ann Arbor, on a charge of fleeing from a police officer. The charge, stemming from legislation that is new this year, carries a maximum penalty of a \$1,000 fine or one year in jail, or both. It is a high court misdemeanor (i.e., it must be heard in Circuit Court). Damage to the police car has not been estimated, but the vehicle is "driveable". The new 1968 Dodge had been in use for only two days before the accident. No one was hurt in the crash. Police said that Officer Lawrence Tilford first noticed the Strieter car proceeding west on Michigan Avenue at a high rate of speed at about 5 a.m. Sunday. Tilford followed and signaled with his flasher for the speeding car to stop. Tilford then gave chase out W. Michigan Avenue, at speeds up to 120 miles per hour, police said. The Strieter car followed a course on Austin Road, turned onto Dell Road at alleged speed of 60 to 70 miles per hour, and then turned onto Weber Road, where the speed was estimated at 70 to 80 miles per hour. It ended when the police car went out of control on the gravel of Weber Road, left the road, and struck a fence. Strieter was also ticketed for driving 65 miles per hour in a 35 mph zone in the city. Examination on the "fleeing" charge has been set for November 22, and Strieter was released on \$50 bond.
