Past and Present of Washtenaw County, Michigan by Samuel W. Beakes, Chicago: The S.J. Clarke Publishing Co., 1906:

Louis Rohde, representing the business interests of Ann Arbor as a dealer in coal, wood, lime and building materials, and possessing an enterprising and determined spirit that classes him with the representative citizens here, was born in Ageln, Madgeburg, Prussia, Germany, on the 19th of January, 1843, and is a son of Louis and Sophie Rohde, both of whom were natives of that country, and are now living in Ann Arbor, Michigan. Louis Rohde spent the days of his boyhood and youth in the land of his birth and acquired his education in its public schools, but in early manhood he was attracted to America by its excellent opportunities and advantages, and in 1862 he crossed the Atlantic to the new world, making his way direct to Ann Arbor. In his native country he had learned the trade of manufacturing fur. He is entirely a self-made man, deserving all the praise that that term implies, for he came to this country in very limited financial circumstances and has steadily worked his way upward. He began, as a peddler of tinware and other commodities, going through the county in order to sell the goods. In the early years of his residence in Ann Arbor he also worked in a tannery and was engaged in the manufacture of mittens and furs. Later he turned his attention to the fur business, and in 1877 he embarked in the lime, coal and wood business on his own account. From the beginning the new enterprise prospered and he is now the owner of two large yards and an uptown office in Ann Arbor. Here he deals in coal, wood, lime and building materials, the yards being located on West Huron street and on Madison Street, while the city office is at No. 220 East Huron street. He has secured the support of many patrons, so that his trade is constantly increasing and has long since reached a volume that makes it a very profitable industry.

In 1872 Mr. Rohde was united in marriage to Miss Magdalena Spathelf, of Freedom, Washtenaw County, and unto them have been born seven children, all of whom are yet living. William, the eldest, pursued his education in the schools of Ann Arbor, and when nineteen years of age entered business with his father, this association having since been continued. In 1899 he married Charlotte Reichenecker. He is a member of the city council of Ann Arbor and otherwise prominent in public affairs, being recognized as the champion of all progressive movements. He is serving as a trustee in the Bethlehem

Evangelical church, in which he holds membership, and he belongs to the Ancient Order of United Workmen, in which he has filled all of the offices. August is in the employ of the United States government in the mail service. Albert, engaged in teaming, is in charge of the streets of Ann Arbor. Gustav is a veterinary surgeon, practicing in this city. Mrs. Clara Atwell is living in Ann Arbor and her husband is United States surveyor. Paulina is the wife of Otto Andrews, of Ann Arbor. Charlotte completes the family, and resides with her parents in a beautiful home at No. 600 West Huron street. For forty-three years Mr. Rohde has been a resident of this city, and his business career has been marked by consecutive advancement, by the utilization of opportunity and by successful accomplishment. His prosperity has been well merited and his history cannot fail to prove of interest showing, as it does, that force of character, that unfaltering determination may constitute the basis of a desirable and honorable success.

Past and Present of Washtenaw County, Michigan by Samuel W. Beakes, Chicago: The S.J. Clarke Publishing Co., 1906:

Louis Rohde. A dealer in staple commodities which are absolutely necessary in the city life, our subject finds a large trade for ail the coal, wood, lime and cement that he can supply his customers. Now a resident of Ann Arbor, wherein is his business, Mr. Rohde was born in Germany, January 19, 1843, his native place being the village of Egeln. He is the second in order of birth of seven children, which his parents' family comprise, they being Louis and Sophia (Hertz) Rohde. His father was a dealer in hides, furs and pelts and for a number of years carried on an extensive business; he was by trade a slater. He died in the old country in 1870, his wife following him in 1873.

Louis Rohde was educated in the common schools of his native land and received thorough instruction in the practical branches that formed the foundation for a thorough education. He left school at the age of fifteen years and was then apprenticed to learn the trade of a hatter and furrier which he followed for several years. A life in America promising many more opportunities than in his native land, he emigrated to the United States in 1862, and after landing in New York came directly to Ann Arbor and here learned the match-making business, although he afterward worked in a tannery. He then started out on the road as a peddler of notions and tinware, giving several years to this kind of life.

In 1876 our subject started in the lime and cement business, opening an office near the track of the Toledo & Ann Arbor Railroad. In 1890 he added to his business that of the trade in wood and coal, dealing quite extensively in both hard and soft coal. He also does quite a business in the junk line owning several fine wagons which he uses in his business. Our subject was married in February, 1872 to Miss Magdaline Spathalf of Fredonia Township, this county. Mrs. Rohde is a daughter of George Spathalf, who came to this country from Germany.

Mr. and Mrs. Rohde have the following children: William, August, Clara, Charlotte, Albert and Augusta. They are members of the Bethlehem Lutheran Church of which the father is one of the Trustees. In politics he is a Democrat, believing thoroughly in the sovereign rights of the State. In 1871 he made a trip back to Germany, spending six months in a delightful visit to his old home. There he renewed old acquaintances, but was perfectly content to come back to his adopted land and here passed the remainder of his days. Our subject has a pleasant home on Liberty Street, the walls of the house echoing frequently with the merriment of the children that are at once the joy and care of their fond parents.

Elard, Jr. married Anna Marie Spathelf (my mother). He mother passed away when he was about 6 weeks old, and a family by the name of Reyer, who was some relation, brought him up. I don't know much about him until his marriage to my mother February 11, 1875. I understand he left home when he was 21, then stayed at my Aunt August Layer's and did some work for them and also worked around by the day. After his marriage they first lived in a small brick house on a lane off from Bethel Church Road, a few miles east of Bethel Church. They then lived in a little log house on Bethel Church Road a half mile or so west of Bethel Church where they raised thoroughbred chickens, etc. Father also later worked my Uncle Jacob Layer's farm, and in 1897 they moved to Eusades Road in Sharon Township, about a half mile north of Sharon Hollow, where they bought a farm and lived there for the remainder of their lives. All their 12 children were born in Freedom Township except Herman who was born in 1898. Their home was about 5 miles from Manchester.
