Portrait and Biographical Album of Huron County, Michigan. Chapman Bros., Chicago: Biographical Publishing Company 1884:

Fredrick Schilling, one of the earliest of the pioneer settlers of the township of Sebewaing, was born February 7, 1808, in Germany. His parents, Peter and Julia A. Schilling, came to the United States in 1817, and located at Baltimore, Maryland. They were wholly ignorant of the English language and of the ways and customs, and the entire family, consisting of the parents and two children, Frederick and Catherine, were sold into slavery in Maryland, where they were held for a time and were finally transferred to Williamsport, Pennsylvania. Their bondage continued about 18 months, and they escaped from Pennsylvania to Livingston Co., New York, making their way thither by stealth, begging their food and

passing three days of the time without anything to eat. They remained in the Empire State about n years, when they came to Washtenaw County, Michigan, where the parents passed the remainder of their lives.

Mr. Schilling came to Huron County in 1857, and located 400 acres of land in Sebewaing Township. His residence has been there ever since, and his present home is with his daughter Helena. He was married in 1832, in Washtenaw County, to Catherine Miller, and they, had 10 children,—Catherine, Mary, John, Christine, Lydia, Louisa, Gottfried, Ernst, Caroline and Helena.

Mr. Schilling is a Democrat. He was the first Supervisor of Sebewaing Township, and held the position altogether 14 years. He has also officiated several years as Notary Public, and a short time as Justice of the Peace. He is a member of the Lutheran Church.

Lewis Miller (deceased) was born in Scio Township, Washtenaw County, in 1844, and was a son of Godfrey Miller, a native of Wurtemberg, Germany. He married, in Scio Township, Fredericka Burkhardt, who settled in this county in 1848. Mr. Miller became a farmer of prominence in Scio Township, owning at the time of his death 235 acres of valuable land. His widow sold this property in 1880, and at present resides in Ann Arbor, where she owns valuable city property.

Michigan Argus, August 13, 1875:

A shocking tragedy occurred in Scio, six miles and half west of this city on Tuesday night. Ludwig Miller, a farmer of considerable property and of good social standing was murdered in cold blood. The deed was committed by an adopted son only fifteen years of age, who bears the name of George Luman Burkhardt. This lad entered the bed room of Mr. Miller, where he was in bed and asleep with his wife

and a young child, and deliberately shot him, causing his almost instantaneous death. The lad had made careful preparations for his deed, sometime in advance, as an extra gun loaded and cocked and standing against a brick oven in the rear of the house, seemed to indicate, he evidently intended to use this if the other failed. An old bookcase or cupboard in a room over the woodshed, in which Mr. Miller kept his powder and shot, and which was securely locked, was found to have been broken into, and a portion of the contents taken. Suspension early fastened upon him, and when threats were made in his presence he ran away. He was soon caught however and put under arrest. For a long time all efforts to get a confession from him failed, but at length he made a clear breast of the whole matter, and said that he had killed Mr. Miller because he was recently whipped him and since that time he did not like him. He said he had prepared the guns in the evening, and when all were quiet and asleep, between eleven and twelve o'clock, he approached the bed of Mr. Miller, which was plainly seen by the light of a burning lamp in an adjoining, and saw him lying on his right side and well up on the pillow. He took deliberate aim at his breast and fired. He then replaced the gun beside the other at the brick oven, and returned to his room upstairs. He was afterward on hand when the alarm was given, and ran to one of the neighbors to tell them that Mr. Miller had been struck by lightning.

Mrs. Miller does not know how she was aroused, but when awake, she smelled the burning sleeve of her husband's shirt, which had been ignited by the wad from the gun. Extinguishing this she noticed his unnatural breathing, and tried to arouse him, but failing she thought he must have been struck by lightning and immediately called a hired man from the chamber. He ran to a neighbor to convey this intelligence, but before he had returned the unfortunate man had breathed his last. Not till after this did they learn what was the true cause of his death, as but few drops of blood came from the wound.

On a post mortem examination performed by Dr. Frothingham, it was ascertained that the charge from the gun had entered the breast just below the left shoulder, passed between the second and third ribs, through the two lobes of the left lung, shattered the seventh and eighth ribs and finally lodged within the body.

The hardened youth took the matter of his arrest very coolly, and burst into laughter when the handcuffs were put upon his wrists. On coming to this city he asked of the sheriff what work he would probably have to do in State Prison, and seemed to look forward to it with some degree of pleasure. It is hardly conceivable that so unprovoked and premeditated a deed could have been wrought by the hands of this young boy, who had never wanted for anything that would make him industrious, honest and educated. Mr. Miller had always been very kind to him, using no more chastisement in his training than any father upon his son. He had endeavored to keep him at Sunday school instead of having him roaming in the fields or woods hunting on the Sabbath, and this curb on his vicious spirit had provoked to this horrible deed. The boy was always well clothed, and had plenty of spending money when he needed it; the verdict of all Mr. Miller's neighbors is that he treated him too well.

The earlier history of this boy murderer is as follows: Mrs. Miller's brother a Mr. Burkhardt, shortly before the war married a young French woman. Two sons were the fruits of this union, when the father joined the army, and not long after was killed, leaving his widow with these two children, one of them George something over two years old. Their mother being poor and not caring to be burdened, put them into the County House. One of her husband's relatives, in pity took them to this home and reared them up till George was eight years old. At this time Ludwig Miller was married and George Burkhardt was bound over to him as an adopted son. But alas! for human calculations, the efforts of an honest, hopeful man to reclaim a cast-off child have recoiled upon him, and caused the shedding of his life's blood. The annals of Crime present scarcely anything so repulsive as this horrible murder, and we can hardly feel satisfied with the leniency of justice in the punishment of its perpetrator. It is almost beyond comprehension that a youth of his age could become so hardened as to deliberately shoot his own benefactor. Even the brute creation have more feeling than this!

Mr. Miller, by his death, leaves a wife, two small children and a widowed mother. But they are not without abundant means subsistence, as a farm of 245 acres is left for their support. A large number of wealthy relatives and kind friends stand ready to offer their assistance and sympathy. Mr. Miller was a nephew of Mr. Henry Paul, of this city, and brother of J. G. Miller who died recently and quite suddenly on Detroit Street. He was thirty years of age, and was doing finely in the way of the world's possessions. His funeral will be held at his residence this morning at ten o'clock.

The crime has given the community a shock from which it will not soon recover, and will form one of the darkest chapters in the history of this county, if not the State.

Michigan Argus, September 17, 1875:

The boy murderer, Lyman Burkhardt, was brought into court at the opening of the session on Wednesday afternoon, to answer to the charge of the murder he committed. In reply to the question of "guilty or not guilty," he said promptly, "guilty." When asked further by the Court if he knew what pleading guilty meant, he replied that he understood it perfectly well. Again the judge inquired: "Do you really comprehend the enormity of the crime you have committed?" "I do," he calmly answered. His whole bearing and conversation in court were marked by the same cold indifference and heartlessness that have characterized him all along. He was ordered by the judge to be returned to prison to await his formal trial, which by the law of the State must be granted.

Michigan Argus, October 1, 1875 (from Jackson Patriot):

It is hard to think of a boy "fifteen years old and in person for life," but that is the brief history of Lyman Burkhardt, who was brought yesterday from Ann Arbor, to begin the punishment awarded him for the shooting of his foster father, Mr. Miller, in Scio, Washtenaw County, last month. The story of his crime has been told before in this columns and needs no rehearsal at length. At the prison yesterday we sought him out and had some little conversation with him. He is fifteen years old and very slight even for his age. He is dark in complexion with large grey eyes, small mouth, large, irregular teeth and full lips. His expression is far from being brutal or devilish, and in any other place and under circumstances less odious he would be regarded as a handsome boy. To sit and look at him would find it hard to persuade oneself that it is the face of a cold-blooded murderer; but at times as he became excited in telling his story his eyes would flash and there would come into them a look of fierce passion that made one shudder, and which showed that he possessed a large share of latent evil in his composition, and which was enough to inform the observer what sent him there. He told his story briefly but frankly. That he murdered the old man he at once admitted, and said that he did it because he was severely and continually maltreated by Mr. Miller, who took him from his father seven years ago to live with him, his father being very poor.

The boy's actions and demeanor since he committed the crime have been a riddle. He made no attempt to escape and did not seem to realize the probable consequence of his act; he had slaked his revenge and was satisfied. When he first arrived yesterday he manifested the same indifference, or assumption of it, for it is difficult to tell whether he is or is not playing stoic by an effort of will. If he really can realize his situation and future and experiences and emotion he does not care to have it known, for once Saturday it was seen that his eyes were filled with tears, but as soon as he saw he was observed he dashed them away, and refused to say what had moved him. In the afternoon he had evidently been doing some thinking, and was more disposed to look his future in the face. He enters on his life with a feeling of hope and asks us if we did not think he would be let out in six years if he was good. The idea that his whole life must be spent inside alls his mind did not seem able to comprehend, and he was confident that his term would be shortened by some dispensation of Providence. The opinion of nearly every one who has seen him is that his mind is not sound, and that he is mentally unable to comprehend more than vaguely what he has done and what it entails.

It is saddening to talk with or think of this boy convict, with what seems only blankness before him. It is bad enough to think of any man being sentenced to prison for life, but when a mere child, one just at the threshold of life, as it were, is called on to undergo this ordeal it is simply fearful to contemplate.
