Ann Arbor and Washtenaw County frequently acknowledge their indebtedness to the Teutonic race for the development and progress which have transformed the small and unimproved village to an intellectual and commercial center. A large portion of the citizens here are either of German birth or parentage and have brought from the fatherland the strong and sterling characteristics that have enabled the sons of Germany to adapt themselves to the conditions of the new world and utilize opportunities that have proven resultant factors in the acquirement of desired success. Mr. Ottmer, born in Ebhausen, Wurtemberg, Germany, on the 14th of August, 1865, is a son of John Martin and Anna Mary (Brenner) Ottmer, likewise natives of the fatherland.
