May 1985 - Already planning to rebuild their fire-damaged farmhouse, the John Feldkamp's are grateful today that there's anything left to restore. A blaze that began Monday morning, in the large barn a short distance upwind from the Feldkamp farmhouse, came close to destroying the family homestead that dates back more than a century.

The fire was jetting through the barn roof when discovered by Glenn Mann, spraying a nearby field. John Feldkamp and his wife had already left for work—he in Manchester and she in Ann Arbor. Their daughter Tammy was alone in the house. Mann raced to the house, gave her the alarm, and the Saline Area Fire Department was called.

The crew responded quickly, but the entire barn was ablaze when they arrived. The Saline volunteers—plus crews from Pittsfield, Milan, Clinton, Manchester and Dexter, 38 units of equipment altogether—put most of their effort into saving the Feldkamp home. The flames, whipped by a breeze that aimed straight for the house, destroyed several outbuildings around the barn, and the flying sparks and

intense heat finally set the upper level of the house afire. But a nearby building that reportedly contained ammunition and explosives was saved. If it had gone, the house would have gone too, and possibly some of the firemen who braved the heat and smoke and danger to keep both buildings well-soaked with water.

The roof of the house was mostly destroyed, and the interior was water-damaged. But the structure was saved, and the Feldkamp's quickly decided to restore it. Friends reported Tuesday that the rebuilding will begin as soon as possible. Loss estimates vary from \$50,000 to twice as much. Firemen agreed that the blaze was their worst in a long time. Heat from the barn fire set truck and tractor tires ablaze halfway across the yard. Welding chemicals and propane tanks exploded sporadically. Saline's Engine No. 5 Was threatened for a time when heat and flying sparks ignited a protective tarp and some hose, and also set the engine's carburetor ablaze. But alert crewmen quickly doused the flare-ups. An ambulance stood by during much of Thursday. But Craig Hoeft of Saline was apparently the only one who needed; it. He was treated at Saline Hospital for smoke inhalation, and released. Also on hand was the SAFD canteen, ready with sandwiches, coffee, soft drinks. The volunteer crews fought the fire for seven hot, exhausting hours, and the food and drink helped. Also helpful were the Allie Finkbeiner's, whose gravel pit nearby on Michigan Avenue supplied the water needed to keep the tankers in business. A longer run, to a city hydrant, would possibly have whipped the firemen's efforts. To keep the tankers moving, David Finkbeiner directed traffic, clearing the path onto the highway from their drive.

The firemen were still on hand when the Feldkamp's and friends began the immense cleanup job. Tammy—who plans to marry in August—arid Karl, who is slated to graduate from Saline High in early June—are part of the cleanup team, and the near-disaster at their home won't change their big dates. John Feldkamp's collection of old guns is reportedly saved. The family is staying temporarily with neighbors and friends—the Dennis Perkins, Daniel Hoeft's, and the Cornelius family—and there's a possibility that they'll use a camper for their home during the rebuilding. Help from friends and neighbors, from the Red Cross and the Church of Jesus Christ, Latter Day Saints, was offered even before the heat of the fire died down. And by sundown Monday, friends and neighbors had completely cleaned the interior of the house. "We're so very grateful," Mrs. Feldkamp said.
