Notes for George Ernest Schroen:

It has pleased the Heavenly Father in His divine providence to call from this life of sorrow George Schroen. The deceased was the youngest son of John and Anna Schroen, nee Sifel, and was born February 28, 1843 in Mengshausen, Germany. When he was 19 years old he decided to come to America and on the fifth day of August 1862, together with his brother, Adam, left the land of his birth and came to York Township, arriving there in the month of October of the above year. In 1867 he was married to Miss Christina Luckhardt. To this union seven children were born, four sons and three daughters, three sons dying in earliest infancy. Mr. Schroen spent 58 years of his life in Saline and the immediate vicinity, and by his rugged honesty and self-sacrificing character made for himself a host of friends, of which the large concourse at his burial gave mute testimony. In his passing away, St. Paul's church has lost one of her most faithful members and the village a respected citizen. He passed peacefully away last Saturday afternoon, June 5, 1920, at the home of his daughter. Mrs. George W. Seeger.

The funeral services were held from St. Paul's church Tuesday afternoon at 2; 30. Relatives and friends from Billings, Montana, Ann Arbor, Manchester, Dexter, Hillsdale, and Freedom were present to pay their last tribute of respect. His, son, Henry Schroen, his nephews, Charles and John Schroen, his son-in-law, George W. Seeger and Aaron and Fred Luckhardt acted as pallbearers.

He leaves to mourn for him one son, three daughters, three sons-in-law, four grandchildren, one great-grandchild, besides other relatives and friends. The time of his earthly pilgrimage was 77 years, three months and eight days. Mrs. Elizabeth Schroen- The departed was born on the 10th day of January, 1847, in Mengshausen, Kreis Hershfeld, Kurshessen, Germany, the daughter of George and Elizabeth Ickler. As a child of Christian and God-fearing parents, she was consecrated to God in infancy, and at the age of 14 years, after careful instructions in the fundamental doctrines of our holy religion, she was confirmed in the Evangelical Church in the land of her birth. At the age of 15 years her sister and herself came to America, going first to her relatives in Canada, with whom she spent four years, after which she came to Freedom Township, Washtenaw County. It was here that she met her future husband, the late Adam Schroen. They were married on the 21st of February, 1870.

This union was blessed with four sons and six daughters, two of whom passed away in infancy. In recent years two sons, John and Adam, Jr., and two daughters, Melvina and Olga, passed to their reward. After 46 years of wedded life, on July 19, 1916, death severed this marriage, when her husband passed away.

After the death of her husband, Mother Schroen made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Jacob Kaiser, of East Lansing. It was there that she passed away quite suddenly on length on Wednesday, July 18, 1934, at about 1 o'clock in the afternoon. She had always retained her membership in St. Paul's Church here and the Ladies' Aid Society.

She is survived by two sons, Charles and Eckhardt Schroen, of Ann Arbor; two daughters, Mrs. Jacob Kaiser of East Lansing and Mrs. George Gartung of Chicago, Illinois; five sisters, one residing in Chicago and four still living in Germany; 11 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren, besides other near relatives and many friends. Milan Man Killed In Motor Accident - Wilson W. Schroen Dies As Car Hits Culvert

YPSILANTI--Wilson W. Schroen 26 years old, Milan, was instantly killed and Chester Rutkowski, 20, of near Belleville, was injured at 8 o'clock last night when the car driven by Schroen, on Hannan Rd., east of here, hit the end of a concrete culvert and rolled over and over for 200 feet along the road. The car was almost completely demolished, the doors on both sides being torn off and both men hurled out onto the road. Schroen was dead when other motorists reached him, and Rutkowski is in the Wayne General hospital with head, back and hip injuries.

Schroen, a former employee of the United Stove Co. here, and Rutkowski were members of a dance orchestra employed at Frank's Inn, on the Ann Arbor Trail at Merriman Rd., and were inroute to that place to fill their nightly engagement when the accident occurred.

Rutkowski told Trooper Jess Ralph of the state police that Schroen was blinded by the lights of an approaching car which crowded him toward the edge of the road just as he was approaching the culvert, which spans a ditch some six feet deep. An iron railing is at the top of the concrete of the culvert. Parts of the car were scattered along the road, and the machine came to rest with the front end down in a three-foot ditch along the east side of the road.

Schroen, who was born in York Township, is the son of Mr. and Mrs. William Schroen and lived with his parents on their farm at 14039 Darling Rd., near Milan.

He is survived by his parents and a sister, Mrs. Maud Yaeger, of Saline Township. Funeral arrangements have not been completed.

Charles Henry Guthard, conducting a general hardware, stove and implement business in Saline Township, was born on the 6th of May, 1868, in Saline township, but like many of Washtenaw county's citizens is of German lineage. His father, Henry Guthard, was a native of Kassel, Germany, and came to Washtenaw County, in 1845, after seventy-seven days spent on the voyage between Germany and America. Here he became the owner of a farm of eighty acres. He found Washtenaw county an almost unbroken wilderness with only here and there a settlement to tell that the seeds of civilization had been planted which in due time were to bear rich fruit. The farmers in those early days drove ox teams to Detroit, where they secured their supplies. In connection with the other early settlers Mr. Guthard aided in transforming the county into a rich agricultural district and he continued a valued resident here up to the time of his death, which occurred September 16, 1903. His wife, who bore the maiden name of Katherina Bieber, was also a native of Kassel, Germany, and her death occurred on the 19th of September, 1904. The members of the family were as follows: John, who is living on the old homestead farm in Saline Township; Emma, who became the wife of Carl Bickel, of Cleveland, Ohio, and died in May, 1905; Mary, the wife of Herman Weihe, of Milwaukee, Wisconsin; Kate, the wife of John Heininger, of Saline Township; Clara, the wife of Rev. His faithful service of 34 years as Sentinel of the Saline Chapter of the O.E.S. was recognized in the East. Mr. Seeger is also a Past Master of the Saline Lodge of the A.F.&M. On Saturday evening his daughter, Mrs. Lucille Seeger, entertained at a surprise party at their Home, the diversion being euchre.

This week a lifetime of civic service ended, when funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at that same church for George W.
