A 71-year-old Pittsfield Township woman was killed, and her husband was critically hurt in a two-car accident Thursday night August 22, 1957 in Lodi Township. Mrs. Emma C. Herrst of 2593 S. State Rd., was pronounced dead on arrival at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital at 7:45 p.m. Her husband, John W. Herrst, 76, was reported in critical condition at St. Joseph Hospital Friday noon. He had chest injuries, it was learned. Joel Sinkule, 18, of 4201 Saline-Ann Arbor Rd., Lodi Township, was released from the hospital Thursday night after treatment for cuts and chest bruises. Sheriff's deputies said Sinkule told them she was driving north on Wagner Rd. south of Scio Church Rd. at the time of the accident. The youth said he came over a hill to see the Herrst car crosswise in the middle of the road, apparently in the process of turning off the highway. Sinkule said he attempted to stop hut slammed broadside into the right side of the elderly couple's car. Deputies said Herrst, with his wife as a passenger in the car, was apparently headed south on Wagner Rd. seconds before the accident. Officers said it appeared the Pittsfield township man was turning his car off Wagner Rd. into a lane which leads to an apple orchard when the Sinkule car appeared over the rise of the hill. Assistant Prosecutor William F. Delhey took a statement concerning the accident from Sinkule at the hospital Thursday night. The youth was not held. Mrs. Herrst was the 15th person to die in traffic accidents in 1957 on county highways. At this time last year a total of 35 traffic fatalities had been recorded.
