Mrs. May Schmitt accuses John Keck, Lodi highway overseer, of slander (defamed character)

brings suit for \$5,000. The remarks imputed to Keck was in German, and are alleged to reflect upon the character of Mrs. Schmitt. The suit is an outgrowth of the trouble that arose between Schmitt and Keck in the spring over the grading of the road in front of Schmitt's farm. Keck and a gang of men were driving through the country with a scraper, and Schmitt tried to prevent their removing a certain bank in front of his house. A quarrel ensued and as a result Schmitt was arrested and later bound over to the circuit court on the charge of assault upon Keck with intent to do great bodily harm less than the crime of murder.

In his plea Keck states that Schmitt's attorney, Frank Stivers, came to him and stated that if he would drop the assault case he would give a bond to keep the peace, but that if the case was continued suit would be brought against him for slander.

A motion has been filed by Keck's attorneys, Arthur Brown and Philip Blum, for security for costs from the plaintiff, on the grounds that the suit was brought merely to case Keck annoyance and that the Schmitt's are financially irresponsible.

Today, Jeremy is the youngest of the two current generations that operate the farm, at 5096 Farr Road. They are part of a family team consisting of Jeremy's dad Ken and Uncle Joe. While Ken manages the farm's 1,175 acres of cropland, it falls to Jeremy to manage the herd of 670 dairy cows. "We all overlap a little bit. Ken and Jeremy both do the planting in the spring," Jody Sharrard said.

Last year, Jeremy and Jody Sharrard were named Outstanding Young Dairy Cooperators for 2011 by the Michigan Milk Producers Association. The Peck couple was honored in March at the MMPA's 2012 Annual Meeting in Lansing. They also were honored by the Southern Sanilac Local in January. As the state winning cooperators, Jeremy and Jody will represent MMPA at various industry and Association activities throughout the year.

The MMPA has been a memberowned and operated cooperative for 96 years. It includes more than 2,100 dairy farmers in Michigan, Wisconsin, Ohio and Indiana. The Sharrards were selected by other dairy farmers in their district based on their farming operation, farm-related and community activities and their demonstrated leadership abilities. Jeremy serves as vice president of the MMPA's Southern Sanilac Local. They are also active in Sanilac 4-H. While this would keep them busy enough, they are Little League coaches as well.

They have three growing boys: Will, 12, Ethan, 9, and Dan, 8, who attend Peck schools. Last summer Will exhibited hogs, dairy cattle and market steers at the county fair. "I'm looking forward to working with our sixth generation," Jeremy Sharrard said. "The boys all show quite a bit of interest." The Sharrards are part of a proud family tradition of farming that began with Jeremy's great-great-grandfather James Houston Sharrard in 1908. The operation began with 15 cows and 80 acres of cropland. The operation continued with Jeremy's great-grandfather Carl and his grandfather Ray.

Jeremy's wife Jody, who also grew up on a dairy farm in Buel Township, started working for the Sharrards while attending Michigan State University, where she was pursuing a degree in animal science. Today, she is in charge of all the breeding of their Holstein cows. "All our expansion has been internal," she said. She also is communications committee chair for the Sanilac Farm Bureau and is involved with Project RED, the Farm Bureau program where fourth-graders throughout the county can learn about agriculture, everything from orchards and beekeeping to goats, sheep, cows and crops. "It's a way of exposing children to agriculture in a very positive manner," Jody said.

The couple runs a modern dairy operation. They are developing a Certified Nutrient Management Plan, replacing their daily haul routine with two lagoons – one for wastewater from the milk house and one for manure. They have eliminated cow pastures to prevent runoff into a nearby creek. To increase cow comfort, they installed large fans with thermostats to keep the barns cooler in summer. Their 15 employees have attended MMPA Milker Training School or on farm training.

Sept. 6, 2011 - Jeremy and Jody Sharrard of Peck, Michigan, were selected as the state winning 2011 Outstanding Young Dairy Cooperators (OYDC). They represented Michigan Milk Producers Association's (MMPA) District 8 and the Southern Sanilac Local in the annual OYDC conference held Aug. 17-18. Chris and Michele Daniels of Whittemore, Michigan, were named runners-up. They represented MMPA's District 10 and the Sunrise Local. The Sharrards and Daniels's were selected to participate in the program earlier this year by fellow dairy farmers in their district.

Jeremy and Jody farm in an LLC with Jeremy's dad and uncle. Jeremy and Jody manage the herd of 670 cows while his dad manages the farm's 1,175 acres of cropland. Jeremy serves as local vice president of the MMPA Southern Sanilac Local. They are also active in the county 4-H and as a Little League coaches. As the state winning cooperators, Jeremy and Jody represent MMPA at various industry and Association activities.
