John George Gall, Parents: John Leo & Mary (Zeeb) Gall (Death Cert. Clinton Co; Michigan. Bk 3, P. 223 (Jul 1907); List his parents as John Leo & Mary (Jeet) Gall. Age at marriage 24 yrs; fathered 8 children, 7 living at the time of his death.) Believed to be buried in the Gunnisonville Cemetery in an unmarked grave.

Clinton County Paper, July 1907: Stated "that he loaded a shot gun with slugs, putting the muzzle in his mouth, and the balls went through the top of his head into the ceiling. On his shirt was a letter written in German, in which he stated that he had worked hard and saved a comfortable amount for his family; that he had given it away and had been thinking of killing himself for several months. He also left a letter sealed and directed to the Judge of Probate in which he asked him to see that his daughter, Louise, was cared for. He had upon his person and in boxes about the home \$1015.00 in gold and \$401.00 in currency. Slips were attached to or in boxes with some of the money, and various amounts were marked "Lydia, Minnie, Sophia, Maria, Louise". He also had Two certificates in the Lansing State Savings Bank, one for \$156.00 and one for \$113.00. In May, 1906, he gave a deed of the 80 acre homestead to his son, John G. Gaul, (Clinton County Paper spelling was Gaul, but Court papers have it spelled as Gall.) providing that he and his daughters Louise and Caroline should have a home there during their lifetime. His son and wife were out during the evening, and the death of the father was not discovered until morning. "

John and Mary was born and it appears they were married in Germany. Then came to America and settled in Dewitt Twp, Clinton County, Michigan between 1850 & 1860. They may have came from Affalterbach District of Marbach, Germany.

When he was five years of age his parents moved on a farm south of the village of Dewitt where he had since resided. His education was from the village schools. He married

Sophia Hornung of Dewitt Township. In his parents later years he took over the family farm and with his wife cared for his parents the remainder of their lives.

George had had a severe illness which left him with a weak heart. Being unable to do any hard work, he attended to the light work on the farm. On Sunday morning to do the chores. Later his wife going to the farm to assist him with the chores, found him dead just inside the barn. Doctors pronounced it apoplexy. He fell as soon as he opened the barn door.

Besides his widow he is survived by two daughters, Mrs. Charles Gilbert of Detroit, Doris at home, two sisters, Louisa at home and Mrs. Sophia Vigés of Rew. His funeral was held from his late home Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. Rev. Hrdt of the Evangelical Lutheran church of Lansing of which he was a member officiated. Burial was made in the Dewitt cemetery.

Otto Creek, Minnie Bohnett: One of the saddest deaths which has ever occurred in this neighborhood, was that of Mrs. Minnie Bohnett, who died last Friday morning of Pneumonia, she had been sick for about ten days, but the end cause somewhat unexpected. She left six boys who were much in need of a mother's care. The funeral was held at the house Sunday afternoon, those attending from away were, Mr. and George Vigés, Jay Keck and wife, Gotleib Rutter and wife, Mrs. Mary Smith, Mrs. Mary Irish and Mrs. Lydia Balduff all from Lansing and Dewitt.

Katherine Wilhemina Gall was born at DeWitt, Clinton County, Michigan, Aug. 31st, 1865, and died at there house in Springport Township, Feb. 10th, 1911, being 45 years, five months and ten days old. Her girlhood days were spent on the farm home of her parents in Clinton County. On March 8th, 1887, she was married to Ulrick Bohnett, and to them were born seven children. Most of their married life was spent on the farm near Lansing, until the spring of 1900, when they purchased this farm which has since been the home of the deceased.

Mr. Bohnett died in July 1902, and since his death Mrs. Bohnett has been a faithful mother to her six boys. Her death has removed from among, us a kind neighbor and friend, who by her heroic life of sacrifice for her children has won the esteem of all who know her.

Besides her immediate family, she leaves to mourn their loss, one brother and five sisters, who all reside in the vicinity of Lansing and DeWitt. The funeral was held from the home Sunday, Rev. Fitch officiating. Burial in the Griffith cemetery."

Ezra Herman Bohnett, was a very quit and hard working person. He never talked about his past and never said a bad word about anybody. He was a small man, Height about 5'4", weight about 150 #. He served in the US Marine Corps in 1921 and he never married. Ezra finally started working for the Eaton Rapids Hospital and after 43 years of service, he retired in 1977. He also served many years on board of the First Baptist Church of Eaton

Rapids. Edward B. McRee, President of Ingham Medical Center (Lansing, Michigan), sums up Ezra's life and as a person, in the article he wrote for the Eaton Rapids Hospital newsletter.

He made a Difference: Ezra Bohnett, (abt. 1984) "He bends over a bit as he walks, and yet every day he plods the length of Main Street. While his head is bent and he seldom looks up or down, if you meet him, he will greet you in the strong and vigorous voice which gives you some idea of the hearty soul that's within. He's seen by scores of eyes daily and most likely is thought to be just another workman, and few probably give much thought beyond a mere glance. But he deserves much more than the quick look and passing afterthought, for he is a grand contributor to this community. He's much more than just the name, Ezra Bohnett, who spent his life caring for the looking after the physical plant which has sheltered the birthing and the dying of a large segment of this population, as well as the healing and mending of even greater numbers. He represents a way of life, a way of thinking, which benefits all of us, and over many, many years has contributed immeasurably to the wellbeing of this city.

For me, he was a splendid example of dedication, as he rose in the wee hours of every day to begin the careful polishing of the hospital corridors in order to have them immaculate and shining when morning activity began. He cared about everything that concerned the hospital, and it was from him that I learned a spark of patience, and a bit of endurance as he placidly carried out the myriad tasks, which were required to ensure that all would function well in this building, which protected so many.

Because he cared, nothing was too hard or too burdensome for him to undertake. The hours were long and arduous, the demands frequently exasperating. Some of the tasks were endlessly repetitive, and certainly uninteresting. But there was a toughness about him that demanded his all, and to this day his walks down Main Street are stridently laced with this vigor which I'm confident will never disappear.

How grandly he persevered. Today in retirement, he lives in quiet obscurity. But how encouraged I am for having known him! "

Orion Bohnett's father died when he was less then a year old and his mother died when he was 9 years old. He was then sent to Dewitt Twp. in Clinton County, Michigan to live with his Aunt and Uncle Jacob Keck. He never talked much about his younger days. He did tell a story while living on the farm in Jackson County of the boys building a tractor from old parts that they found and was driving it around their farm. All the Bohnett boys were all very mechanical minded. He also told the story about when his mother used to go to Eaton Rapids to shop, that they would get on the old horse and ride Springport and get they their supply of smoking and chewing tobacco. If she went to Springport, they would go the Eaton Rapids.

His working days started at a very young age. He quit school after the eighth grade. At age 15, he had his own team of horses and doing a full days work. In 1923 he got his inheritance from his parents estate. A appears a car was first on his list. In about 1930 he went into partnership on a peppermint crop. His partner was taking more then his share of the peppermint, so before the next year peppermint crop, he rented the farm on Woodbury Road, Woodhull twp. and started farming on that farm. That was in the 1931.

Orion spent most of his life in farming, which he loved. He raise crops including tobacco, sheep and dairy cattle. He worked the farm at the corner of Woodbury and Britten Roads for 21 years, from 1931 to 1952. The first year, he raised tobacco, 350 plants. The farm had 230 acre, of land, about 80 acres of tillable land. After he had a heart attack in 1952, they sold the farm and moved into the City of Laingsburg. After recovering from his heart attack, he started doing custodial work and driving school bus for the Laingsburg School District. He retired after 14 years of services and received a nice plack from the High School student body.

He lived an honest upstanding life. His word was as good as any written agreement. If he said he was going to do something, it was done. He died in 29 Jun 1972. His death certificate has the cause of death as Bacteremia due as the consequence of pneumonia with coronary heart disease contributing to his death. He died Twenty days after the death of his daughter.
