Mrs. John Wahl died last Monday March 1956 at her home at 738 South Main St., Chelsea, where she had been in failing health for some time. Mrs. Wahl was a member of St. Paul's Evangelical and Reformed church and the Women's Guild and Mission Club of the Church. Born in Hochdorf, Wuerttemberg, Germany, September 23, 1872, she was the former Caroline (Carrie) Katz, daughter of Gottlieb and Katherine Katz. She came to the United States when she was 11 years old and lived in Bridgewater Township. She was confirmed in the Bridgewater church and was married to Mr. Wahl in Bridgewater, May 12, 1892. They celebrated their 50th wedding anniversary in 1942. Mr. Wahl died Feb. 24, 1946. They had lived near Waterloo for 48 years before moving to Chelsea.

March 3, 1994 - Scott Hinderer is a nine-year-old third grader, in Sharon Hodgson's class at South school. Other than the wispy, baby hair on his head, Scott looks and acts like any other energetic grade school boy. He plays video games, shows-pigs and lambs at the Chelsea Community Fair, plays soccer and baseball, and is good in science at school.

But Scott is different. A routine visit to a doctor's office in 1989 revealed an enlarged spleen and eventually every parent's nightmare. Scott has leukemia. Since that diagnosis. Scott has taken aggressive treatment for the disease and his mother, Linda Murdock says he has faced his cancer "head on." Scott began his treatment at the University of Michigan Medical Center in the fall of 1989 with radiation therapy. He was on chemotherapy until January of 1993.

From January until August, he was disease-free and off chemotherapy. However, on Aug. 17 his leukemia relapsed and "our hearts were broken again," Murdock said. Scott's physician has informed his parents that Scott's only hope is a bone marrow transplant, an extremely expensive proposition because screening for donors is not covered by health insurance.

April 5, 1995 - Scott Hinderer touched the Chelsea community with his courage and zest for life. But yesterday, Hinderer lost his life to the disease he and his family tried so hard to fend off. Hinderer, 10, died yesterday at his home in Chelsea after a six year battle with Leukemia and unsuccessful bone marrow transplant. His funeral will be held 1 p.m. Friday at Zion Cemetery in Freedom Township. Hinderer was diagnosed with the fatal blood disease in 1989 during a routine visit to a doctor's office. The doctor found the young boy had an enlarged spleen. Since that time, Hinderer has undergone aggressive treatment of Leukemia. He began chemotherapy from the fall of 1989 through January 1993 at the University of Michigan Medical Center. From January 1993 to August 1993 he was disease-free and off chemotherapy. However, on Aug. 17, his mother, Linda Murdock, and father, Ted Hinderer, learned their son's Leukemia had relapsed. That is when they were told his only hope was a bone marrow transplant, an expensive procedure because screening for donors is not covered by health insurance.

When the information on Hinderer's blood was placed in the nationally linked computer, 166 potential matches were found for him. Finally, last year a donor was found, a 47 year-old Frenchman. The transplant took place at Harper Hospital in Detroit and required several weeks of hospitalization for Hinderer. He spent the following months convalescing at home. The treatment took quite a toll on his Immune system. To cover his medical expenses, funds were raised within the community through organized dinners, dances and other locally sponsored fund drives. Hinderer, a fourth grade student, at South Elementary School, enjoyed athletics, fishing, drawing and painting. He particularly enjoyed baseball, and also played soccer, football and basketball on teams, organized through the Chelsea Recreation Department. He played video games, exhibited piss and lambs, at Chelsea Community Fair and enjoyed science. He likely will be remembered for his ability to make friends, love of school and church and hard-fought battle.

Scott Christian Hinderer, 10, of Chelsea died April 4, 1995 at his home after long and courageous battle with Leukemia. He was a fourth grade student at South Elementary school and a lifelong member of Zion Lutheran Church. He was an avid fisherman and euchre player, active in many sports, especially baseball. Scott Hinderer's many talents included drawing and painting. Scott Hinderer was born Jan, 20, 1985 in Ann Arbor.
