Notes for Conrad Boettner:

Conrad Boettner, pioneer of Bridgewater and Saline, died Friday noon June 12, 1942 at the home of his nephews, Lawrence and Elmer Boettner, in Bridgewater, where he had lived since the death of his wife, Delia, a year ago. He was 87 years old. Mr. Boettner was born in Bridgewater Township, Feb 24, 1855, and with his brother, George, purchased livestock and shipped the same to Detroit and Buffalo markets, in addition to farming. More than 30 years ago he and Mrs. Boettner came to Saline, purchasing the old Parsons homestead on Russell Street. He built the two-story building occupied by Miss Feuerbacher and Lambarth Brothers and also the one-story cement block building that covers three or four business lots just west of the Federated Church.

He is survived by two brothers, John, Saline township, and Fred; Bridgewater Township, and several nieces and nephews. Funeral services were held at 3 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Lockwood funeral home, Rev. W. F. Baumann officiating, and burial was in Oakwood Cemetery.

Mrs. Delia Boettner died Monday morning May 16, 1941 at the home of her nephews, Lawrence and Elmer Boettner, of Bridgewater. Mrs. Boettner was born in Scio Township July 10, 1862.
