J. George Brandt (deceased) was born in Wurtemberg, Germany, Dec. 21, 1834. His parents were John and Mary (Hurt) Brandt. Mr. Brandt resided in his native land until 18 years of age, receiving a good common-school education. In 1852 he decided to visit America, and, if pleased with the people and the manner of doing business, to make it his future home. He had learned the brewing business in the "Faderland," but upon arrival at New York, went immediately to Ann Arbor, Mich., residing on a farm near the city with an uncle, until 1855. At the latter date, he came to Grand Rapids, and soon after engaged his services to Christopher Kusterer, in the brewing trade. He remained there six years, and at the end of that time, having saved a little capital, and a vast amount of experience, decided to embark in business for himself. He established Brandt's Brewery, on South Division Street, in 1863, which he operated until his death. Mr. Brandt was considered a very healthy man, but was much troubled by a nervous sick headache for six years previous to his death. He had been unwell for 14 days, and on the morning of July 11, 1880, had a stroke of apoplexy, which resulted in his instantaneous death. Mr. Brandt was a man possessing excellent business qualifications, and his untimely death was mourned by all. In 1879 he purchased a fine residence on the southeast corner of Lagrave and Oak Streets, where his widow and family now reside. After Mr. Brandt's death, Mrs. Brandt sold a third interest in the brewing business to Julius Peterson, who now has the supervision of the business. A sketch of this business will be found in the section on manufacturing industries. Mr. Brandt was married Oct. 20, 1844, to Elizabeth B. Fluhrer, a native of Bavaria. Eight children were born to them—George W., who is learning the brewing trade; Adolph H., Carolina C., Ernest J. and Frank W. Louisa C., Mary E. and Dora B. are deceased. Mrs. Brandt is a member of the German Evangelical Lutheran Church, on whose service Mr. Brandt was a regular attendant.

Albert Praetorius, the clerk at the brewery, was born in Prussia, Nov. 19, 1843. He came to America in 1868, and since 1871 has occupied his present position, and had almost the entire management of the business.

"Funeral of Mrs. Brandt Tomorrow - Body of Woman who died abroad reaches Grand Rapids"

Funeral services over the body of Mrs. Elizabeth Brandt will be held tomorrow. Private services for members of the family will be held at the residence, 110 La Grave Avenue, and at 2 o'clock the body will be taken to the German Lutheran church, Michigan Street and Division Avenue, where public services will be held.

Mrs. Brandt died in Lucerne, Switzerland, on August 6, after a brief illness. She was touring the

continent in company with Mrs. William Kramer of this city. Mrs. Brandt's body was placed on the steamship President Lincoln of the Hamburg-American line at Poulogne, August 11, and was met in New York by George Brandt and H. B. Herpolsheimer of this city.

Mrs. Brandt's untimely passing will be mourned by a multitude of friends. She was widely known in Grand Rapids, where she had lived for many years. She was 67 years of age at the time of her death.

Mrs. Brandt is survived by four sons, George W., Adolph H., Ernest J., and Frank W., all of this city; one sister, Mrs. Caroline B. Herpolsheimer, wife of Henry Herpolsheimer of this city; two brothers, William Fluhrer of Portland, Oregon, and George Fluhrer of Chicago, and six grandchildren, Heinrich W. C. Herpolsheimer. Arthur B. Herpolsheimer, Caroline B. Herpolsheimer, Elsie Brandt, George V. Brandt, and Winifred Brandt, all of this city.

Adolph H. Brandt.—In studying the lives and characters of successful men of business, it is but natural to inquire as to the contributing sources of their success and the motives which actuated them. Success in business is not a matter of genius, but the result of experience, industry and sound judgment, in the majority of cases, and the careers of those who stand highest in position and public esteem prove that in nearly every circumstance they are those who have devoted their lives to effective study and close application to business, and have risen gradually, fighting their way against all opposition. Thorough training in the school of practical financial experience, hard and constant endeavor, and the following out of honorable policies have placed Adolph H. Brandt among the leading business men of Grand Rapids, where he is now vice-president of the Grand Rapids Savings Bank and connected prominently with a number of other institutions which contribute to the prestige of the Furniture City. He entered upon his career in a humble capacity, and the success which he has won has been attained without outside aid or adventitious circumstances.

Mr. Brandt is a native son of Grand Rapids, and was born July 8, 1870, his parents being George and Elizabeth (Florey) Brandt, natives of Germany. His father came to the United States as a lad of sixteen years, locating shortly thereafter in Grand Rapids, where he was employed for a time and later entered business on his own account. He was an industrious and capable man, but did not live to see prosperity crown his efforts, as his death occurred in 1879, when he was but forty-nine years of age. Mrs. Brandt died in Switzerland, about 1912, in the faith of the German Lutheran church, of which her husband had also been a member. They were the parents of the following children: George W., who is now deceased; Adolph H.; Ernest J. and Frank W., residents of Grand Rapids; and Caroline, who is the wife of Henry Herpolsheimer, of this city.

Adolph H. Brandt secured his early education in the parochial schools of the German Lutheran Evangelical church, later attended the public schools, and completed his preparation for his career by taking a commercial course at the Swensberg Business College. After one year in that institution he secured employment with the Grand Rapids Paper Box Company, with which concern he remained three years, then becoming associated with Mr. Rosenthale, in the Tower Clothing Company, for one year. At the end of this period Mr. Brandt became office boy under J. A. S. Verdier, in the Kent County Savings Bank, and during twenty-five years remained with that association. He was quick to learn as a youth and soon won promotion to bookkeeper, where his fidelity and industry made him a favorite with his employers and gained him further advancement. He was duly made assistant cashier, and at Mr. Verdier's death assumed the duties of cashier, which he discharged with ability until 1912, when he resigned his position to become vice-president of the Grand Rapids Savings Bank. He has been identified with a number of other important business institutions, and at present is treasurer of the Grand Rapids Trust Company, secretary and treasurer of the Investment Realty Company, secretary and treasurer of the Grand Rapids Bread Company and treasurer of the Lindquist Company. In the working out of his business destiny, Mr. Brandt has not allowed himself to become merely a business drudge, although daily active in a hotbed of industry. He enjoys the companionship of his fellow-men, and holds membership in the Peninsular and O-Wash-ta-nong clubs, and in the local lodges of the Masons and Elks, and also belongs to the Chamber of Commerce. His religious connection is with St. Mark's Protestant Episcopal Church. Public-spirited and charitable, he always finds time for studying and fostering movements which aim to improve the public weal. "Motor Upsets in Hodenpyl Parl; Two Men are Killed and One Hurt - Lives of George Brandt and William Veit Crushed Out"

"Meet Death When Their Roadster Overturms on Way Home From a Party at Martini's - Kusterer is Injured - Pinned Under Machine All Night Beside Bodies of Companions - Found By Iceman at 7 a.m. Today"

When John VanHorn, an iceman, was driving along the boulevard in the Hodenpyl woods north of Reed's Lake about 6 o'clock this morning he heard a muffled cry for help. Looking down a 10-foot embankment he saw an overturned automobile, a Kissel roadster. Under it he found Gustav Kusterer. "Get someone to help you and raise this car," Kusterer said, "I'm pinned under. George Brandt and Will Weit are under here with me. They are dead. We've been here since 11 o'clock last night." The iceman ran to the Blacklock home and told Robert Robinson and Orville Laidlaw. The three soon raised the car and liberated Kusterer.

"We were over to Herman Martini's last night," Kusterer explained, "and were on our way home. Mr. Veit was driving. I don't know how he happened to take the road through the woods. Ordinarily he took the cutoff to Robinson Road. "We were going along at just a fair rate of speed when, suddenly, I felt the rear wheels start to skid. Before I could say a word and before any of us realized what had happened, the car lurched, overturned and landed upside down at the bottom of the 10-foot embankment.

"Mr. Brandt and Mr. Veit must have been killed instantly. I did not lose consciousness and I remember that I didn't hear a sound after the car settled. My legs were caught in such a way that I couldn't move. My head was out from under the side of the car, though, and I began to yell for help. I must have called for a half hour, but no help came so I stopped, deciding that I simply had to wait until we were discovered."

"I was there all night long, knowing all the time that my two friends, crumpled under the wreckage near me, were dead. Finally I heard the crunch of wheels on the roadway. I renewed my cries then and an iceman heard me. He went away for a few moments returned with several other men and liberated me. That's about all I can say except that I cannot understand how the accident happened. It occurred on the inside of a curve in the road and it must be that Mr. Veit steered the car a little bit too close to the edge. Then we went over."

Mr. Kusterer's life probably was saved by the windshield and the fact that the bodies of Brandt and Veit were large enough to hold the overturned car about eight inches from the ground. Kusterer's legs were pinned against the back of the seat by the bodies of the two dead men and there he was held until liberated this morning. He knew, during all that time, while conscious, that his friends were dead, yet he

was helpless to extricate himself from the position. The thoughts which besieged him during the seven hours of gruesome confinement nearly unnerved him and when the machine was finally raised it was with great difficulty that he staggered to his feet.

At his home, after he had told the story of the night several times, he requested his friends to ask no questions which would serve to keep the memory of the horrors fresh in his mind. Dr. T. R. O'Keefe of the Reed's Lake sanitarium was called by Mrs. Blacklock and went to the scene of the accident in his automobile. He assisted Kusterer at once and took him to his home, 440 Livingston Avenue N.E. It was found that he had suffered several broken ribs and internal injuries, but was in no serious condition. The shock of his long exposure to the cold, cramped under the overturned machine, was severe, but it will have no ill effect.

The bodies of Brandt and Veit were taken from under the machine by Mr. Robinson and Mr. Laidlaw and were later removed to Metcalf's morgue, 916 Cherry Street S.E. Coroner J.B. Hilliker was called and he made a thorough investigation of the wreck. Then, after examining the bodies, he decided that an inquest, in all probability, would be unnecessary. No arrangements for the funerals of the accident victims have been made. Pending the arrival of Mrs. Brandt and her daughter from Chicago the remains of Mr. Brandt will be held at the Metcalf morgue. The remains of Mr. Veit were taken to the Alt morgue, 343 Bridge Street N.W.

Mr. Brandt and Mr. Veit and Mr. Kusterer were numbered among about twenty guests of Herman Martini at the hasenpfeffer supper. After the meal all sat down to cards and played until nearly 10:30. Then Mr. Veit announced that it was time for his party to leave and he ordered his automobile. At 10:50 they departed. "I think Mr. Veit must have taken the wrong road," said Mr. Martini this morning. "He always took the cut-off road to Robinson road when he went back to the city and I think he made a mistake last night. Then too, all three were riding in the one seat of the roadster and it was very crowded."

A pathetic feature of the accident is the fact that Mrs. Brandt and her daughter, Elizabeth, will not know of the death of husband and father until noon today. They have been visiting relatives for several days in Chicago and will receive word of the death there. It is expected that they will return to Grand Rapids tonight.

The car which was responsible for the accident was a big Kissel six roadster, weighing fully a ton. Tracks in the roadway show that Mr. Veit drove the machine very close to the edge for some distance and it is thought that he misjudged the breadth of the top of the embankment. At a point about a quarter of a mile from the main boulevard which branches off the Robinson Road at the Blacklock home, the accident occurred. The car evidently skidded off and turned once in the fall down the embankment. The weight crumpled the windshield and the steering wheel and the upper parts of the car instantly and crushed out the lives of Brandt and Veit. According to Dr. O'Keefe, who was one of the first persons on the scene, the conditions of the bodies indicated that death was instantaneous. This theory is also borne out by Mr. Kusterer's statement that neither man uttered a cry after the crash came and the car had settled.

William Groskopf, 433 Livingston Avenue N.E., was invited by Mr. Veit to enter the ill-fated automobile as the party left Martini's last night and had he accepted, three deaths might have been the toll of the accident. Mr. Groskopf refused to take a seat when he found three persons in the car, declaring that he would rather ride home in a street car, than crowd the machine over capacity. He refused to ride even after Mr. Kusterer had offered him his place in the car.

George W. Brandt, president of the Grand Rapids Brewing Company, was born in Grand Rapids and early became associated with his father in the old Brandt Brewing Company on Division Avenue. In 1892 the amalgamation of the various breweries in Grand Rapids under the name of the Grand Rapids Brewing Company, was effected and Mr. Brandt became a director. In 1912 he was elected president succeeding Jacob Veit, who died.

Notes for Henry Bremer Herpolsheimer:

Henry B. Herpolsheimer was born in Michigan City, Indiana, November 8, 1868, and was about two years old at the time of the family removal to Grand Rapids, where his early educational advantages were those of the public schools. When fifteen years of age he became a clerk in his father's store, and through natural aptitude and the able preceptorship of his father he developed admirable business and executive acumen. His advancement was rapid, and he early began to take upon himself much of the responsibility of the business, he having been made general manager of the establishment in the early nineties and having been largely influential in developing the same into the leading store of its kind in Grand Rapids. Though Mr. Herpolsheimer ever counted the mercantile business as one of paramount interest, he did not confine his activities to this alone. He became a director of the Wolverine Brass Works, the Globe Knitting Works, the Kent State Bank and the Grand Rapids Savings Bank. He was a man of highest civic loyalty and liberality, and was a sincere worker for the good of his home city and state, the while he was never deflected from his high standard of honor and business integrity. Like his father, Mr. Herpolsheimer was a staunch advocate and supporter of the principles of the Republican Party, and an earnest communicant of Immanuel Lutheran church, as is also his widow. Mr. Herpolsheimer survived his honored father by less than four months, and his death, on June 5, 1920, took from Grand Rapids one of its leading business men and most influential and highly esteemed citizens.

On August 23, 1888, was solemnized the marriage of Mr. Herpolsheimer to Miss Caroline K. Brandt, daughter of George J. Brandt, of Grand Rapids, who survives him, as do also their three children – Henry W. G., Arthur B. and Caroline B. Upon the death of her husband Mrs. Herpolsheimer became president of the Herpolsheimer Company, and her son, Arthur B. left his studies at the University of Michigan to take an active interest in the business. December 27, 1923, the Herpolsheimer Company was incorporated under the laws of Michigan, Arthur B., of the third generation of the family being made president of the company, with which he is well upholding the honors of the family name, and his mother, Caroline K. Herpolsheimer, becoming the vice president of the company. He is also a director of the Grand Rapids National Bank.
