He received his boot training at San Diego, California, following which he went to radio school until September, 1948, when he was sent to Camp Pendleton. ON October 26, 1948, he went to Camp Elliott and thence overseas. The body of Pfc. Myrl Heusel, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Heusel of 1040 W. Liberty St., will be returned to Ann Arbor Saturday, just four days after the anniversary of his death in action Nov. 26, 1944, in Germany. Pfc. Heusel's remains are the first of Ann Arbor's hero war dead to be returned to the city, and the third of approximately 70 which will be transferred from military burial places abroad to cemeteries in Washtenaw County. A joint guard of honor of men from the American Legion and the Veterans of Foreign Wars will meet the casket, which will be accompanied by a one-soldier escort. The War Department has notified the family that the body is to arrive on the 9:52 train Saturday morning at the Michigan Central station.

The Legion and the VFW. will join in a military burial at Bethlehem Cemetery for Pfc Heusel following funeral services planned for 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon at the Muehlig Chapel.

Pfc. Heusel was born Jan. 10, 1924, in Ann Arbor. He attended public schools here and was graduated in 1942 from Ann Arbor High School, where he was a member of the Washington Club, the Hi-Y Club and was a member of the football team for three years.

Inducted into the Army Feb. 20, 1943, Pfc. Heusel trained in Camp McCain, Miss., and was sent into France on D-Day in June, 1944. Shortly before his death he had been awarded the Combat and Expert Infantryman's Badges.

Rev. Robert A. Jongeward of the First Methodist Church will officiate at the funeral services at the Muehlig Chapel, while the VFW will officiate at the graveside ritual. Members of both the Legion and the VFW will comprise the color guard. Legionnaires will make up the firing squad which will give the final honorary volley before taps are played.

Representatives of both veterans' organizations will serve as the honor guard when the body lies in state at the Muehlig Chapel from 6 to 9 o'clock Saturday night, and from 11 o'clock Sunday morning until 2 o'clock Sunday afternoon. The family has requested that no flowers be sent in as much as a memorial service was held previously.
