Edgar Louis Moegle (July 11, 1896 – June 4, 1983) was an American football player. After serving in World War I, he played halfback for the University of Detroit in 1919 and for the Detroit Heralds and Detroit Tigers during the first and second regular seasons of the National Football League (NFL). He scored the first touchdown in the Heralds' first game of the first NFL season.

Moegle was born in Ann Arbor, Michigan, in 1896. During World War I, he served two years in the U.S. Army, enlisting in April 1917 and serving until May 1919.

Moegle played college football at halfback position for the University of Detroit during the 1919 college football season. He scored the game-winning touchdown in Detroit's 16-13 victory over Georgetown on October 26, 1919. In 1920, he played professional football for the Detroit Heralds during the first NFL regular season. The Heralds opened their season with a game against the Cleveland Panthers, played at Navin Field on October 10, 1920. The Heralds won by a 40-14 score, and Moegle, the Heralds' starting right halfback, scored the team's first touchdown.

Later in the 1920 season, Moegle became the head coach, and left halfback, of the Detroit Maroons, a competing professional football team in Detroit. On December 5, 1920, the Maroons and Heralds played for the city championship. With Moegle playing at the left halfback position, the teams played to a 7-7 tie. During the 1921 NFL season, Moegle played for the Detroit Tigers.

At the time of the 1920 U.S. Census in January 1920, Moegle was living in Detroit with his mother, Elizabeth, and was employed as a clerk in the post office. After retiring from football, Moegle worked as a bank clerk and lived in Royal Oak, Michigan. In his later years, he lived in Armada, Michigan, though he died at Bruce, Michigan, in 1983. He was buried at the Romeo Cemetery in Romeo, Michigan.

Notes for David Frank Moegle:

Aug 31, 2011 - In any sport or hobby, rising to the top almost three decades after starting may seem to be an impossible feat for some. However, for 45-year-old Armada native David Moegle it was a year-long journey that brought him back to the top of the motocross world. Moegle won his first national motocross title in 1984 at the age of 18 after he began riding around his family's farm, next to Blake's Cider Mill on Armada Center Road, as a child. "Me and my friends would just get together and ride around all over the property," Moegle said. "My brother Jim and I would just ride for fun."

Moegle admitted that even after winning at an early age he was never consumed by the dangerous sport, especially because of the physical dangers. After Moegle broke his jaw in 1987 he stopped riding, for what he thought might be forever. Throughout his career he also endured injuries such as a broken femur, broken ribs, internal lacerations and innumerable trips to the hospital. "It was just time to stop after that," he said of the broken jaw. It would only be 12 years though before he would climb back on the bike and compete again. In 1999 he began riding again, but eleven months ago Moegle got serious about competing and placed his eye on the annual Red Bull AMA Amateur Motocross Championships in Hurricane Mills, Tennessee.

He knew that even though he would be competing in what may be construed as the tame Over 40 unlimited class, he would have to be in top physical condition to compete at the highest level.

"You have to be in incredible shape to go out there and compete with guys like that," Moegle explained. "It may sound like a weekend warrior type of division, but there are former pros out there that still have a huge desire to win." Moegle lost 62 pounds and got himself prepared through area and regional qualifying races along with over 20,000 other riders. As he advanced, his family - which is comprised of his wife Gina, sons Ryan and Riley and mother Jerry - was with him every step of the way. "My family and friends are the reason I still do this," Moegle said. "My kids are getting into it and I still love doing it." Moegle won several state championships throughout his career, but he was looking for a national championship when he headed south in the first week of August.

"The Amateur Nationals is the event every motocross racer in the country wants to compete in," said Event Director Tim Cotter in a statement. "A win at the Amateur Nationals gives a rider national notoriety and can serve as a springboard to a lucrative professional motocross career." Moegle admitted that he was not looking for a springboard of any kind when the week began. "Really all I wanted was to finish in the top three," he said. "There is some pretty stiff competition out there these days, so I would have been extremely happy with a top three finish." All the weekend traveling he had done while working as a technical service manager paid off with a first-place trophy and a feeling of pride. "It is really rewarding to pull of something like this," Moegle said of the win. "It is great for all the people who helped you along the way and your family for supporting you." "It is never worth all the work you put in because you can never get that back, but it feels pretty darn good."

He takes more satisfaction in holding bragging rights over rival biker groups in California than hoisting the trophy, but it has not galvanized his desire to pursue a "lucrative professional motocross career." "I never thought I would be able to do this when I got back into this 12 years ago," said Moegle. "Right now I have no plans for the future, but I am looking at some offers and we will see what happens, but nothing is set right now." He said he has been in some "serious wrecks" lately and knows the kind of condition he must be in to compete, but added he knows there is always fun to be had in the sport. "I have always been the guy out there joking and having fun and it has been great no matter where I was or what happened to me," Moegle said.
