#### Notes for Catharina Dorothea Bender:

Mr. Catherine D. Bauerle, 92, a resident of Lansing for over half a century, died at 6:30 o'clock Thursday morning Dec. 31, 1936 at the home, 221 West Grand River Avenue. Although far advanced in years Mrs. Bauerle had enjoyed good health up to a short time before her death and had retained all her faculties. Mrs. Bauerle was born March 21, 1844, in Philadelphia. Her parents were German immigrants who had come to this country to improve their condition. When Mrs. Bauerle was 11 years old the parents moved to Michigan, settling in Ann Arbor.

In 1866 Mrs. Bauerle was married to George Vetter, a veteran of the Civil war which had just closed. Mr. Vetter's health had been impaired by rigorous treatment accorded prisoners of the Union army in Andersonville prison. He was taken prisoner at the battle of the Wilderness. Sickness contracted in prison caused his death but a short time after his marriage. Two sons, George and William Vetter, now dead, were born to Mr. and Mrs. Vetter. The latter son was postmaster at north Lansing for a number of years and the two brothers for years were engaged in business in that part the city under the firm name of Vetter Brothers.

In 1882 Mrs. Vetter came to Lansing. Here she married Frederick Bauerle and the family occupied a house on Grand River Avenue then known as Franklin Avenue. Mrs. Bauerle had always lived in this block during her residence in Lansing. She was a member of the Trinity Lutheran church, Saginaw and Chestnut Streets.

Mrs. Bauerle is survived by a grandson, Charles Vetter, Detroit, who was in Lansing when the grandmother death occurred, two step-sons, and a great-grandchild and one nephew.

Funeral service will be held Saturday morning at 10 o'clock at the Brinkerhoff & McMahon funeral home, formerly Joy's, on South Washington Avenue. The body will be taken to Ann Arbor for interment in Forest Hill cemetery, in the same lot where her son, William Vetter, and the father are buried.

Charles W. Bauerly. Among the highly-respected and thriving German-American farmers who have made their home in DeWitt Township, Clinton County, we are pleased to present at the head of this sketch the name of a man of more than ordinary intelligence and geniality of temper and manner. To have the respect and thorough liking of his neighbors, as Mr. Bauerly has, is something in which to feel a just pride.

Mr. Bauerly was born at Wurtemberg, Germany, November 15, 1837. His father, John M., who was born in 1804, was a wagon-maker and gunsmith by trade, and came to America in 1837, thirteen years before he brought over his family. He settled first in Saline, Washtenaw County, and engaged in wagon-making. Subsequently he removed to Jonesville, Hillsdale County, where he worked at his trade until his death in 1881. Many of his wagons have done good service all through Michigan, and some have crossed the plains to California, as there was a great demand for his thorough work during the gold excitement of 184950. He was a Lutheran in religion, and a Democrat in politics.

Caroline Deyle, the mother of our subject, became the wife of John M. Bauerly, in 1832. She reared three children—Fred, Gottlieb and Charles W. Like her husband, she has been an earnest and conscientious member of the Lutheran Church, and is still Jiving in Washtenaw County. Our subject was thirteen years and eight months old when he came to America with his mother and older brothers, and he well remembers the journey, which was a great undertaking, as they were forty-three days on the ocean, and eighteen days journeying from New York City to Jonesville, Mich., by way of the lake. He had attended school in Germany both in the common schools and also in a Latin school, where he took a five years' course, and where the requirements were exceedingly strict. After reaching this country he was in school at Jonesville for four months, and in Washtenaw County for three months.

When our subject started out for himself he worked for ten years for John Schneeburger, and in 1862 came to DeWitt Township, Clinton County, and bought eighty-six acres of land. Upon July 15, 1852, he took a step which has been greatly blessed to him and to all with whom he is concerned. It was his marriage with Catherine Hepfer, who is an excellent housekeeper and a delightful, motherly woman. She, like himself, is a native of Wurtemberg, Germany, and was born July 24, 1842. Her parents, Jacob and Mary (Walter) Hepfer, came to America in 1847, and settled in Washtenaw County, Mich. Mr. Hepfer was a poor man, but had the carpenters' trade and a resolution and ability to work hard. He rented land for four years and then bought a small tract, and coming to Clinton County in 1866, settled in DeWitt Township. Both he and his good wife were Lutherans and people of earnest Christian character. She was taken from him by death in 1873, and he was called away upon Christmas Day, 1875. They were the parents of five children— Jacob, Conrad, George, Mary and Catherine.

Nine children have cheered the home of Mr. and Mrs. Bauerly, seven of whom are now living, and all are at home except two. Lydia is the wife of Valentine Neller, a farmer and carpenter in Olive Township, Clinton County. The remaining children are William, Edward; Carrie, who married Jacob Schlenker, a butcher of Lansing; Mary, Charles and Henry. The parents of these children have been members of the Lutheran Church from childhood.

Although our subject began life with nothing but his pluck, perseverance and industry, he now owns one hundred and forty-six acres of as fine land as there is in the county, and has a pleasant large frame residence, the main part of which he built in 1867, and to which he made additions in 1882. On another page appears a view of this residence, which stands back from the road about seventy-five yards and is pleasantly situated. He built his large red frame barn in 1878 and his granary in 1880. His home is an exceptionally happy one, and his children are deservedly the joy and pride of their parents, as they are more than ordinarily bright and intelligent, and make home bappy for one another.

Along with the prosperity and happiness which has been his, Mr. Bauerly has had some bitter with the sweet. In 1867 he had his leg crushed by a falling timber while raising a building, and lay in bed for sixteen weeks, while his doctor bill grew rapidly to the proportions of \$195. Our subject was elected on the Democratic ticket as Supervisor of DeWitt in 1880, and served for six years as Township Treasurer and was appointed for one year to fill an unexpired term. He served for two years as Highway Commissioner, and is now and has been for eight years on the Board of Review.

Lansing - Charles W. Bauerly, a pioneer of DeWitt, died Monday evening April 2, 1917 at his home, 418 West Maple St., after a long illness. Mr. Bauerly was born in Wuerttenburg, Germany, Nov. 15, 1837. At the age of 14 he came to this country with his mother and two sisters settling at Freedom, Washtenaw County. In 1862 he came to Lansing and from here bought a farm in DeWitt Township, he was united in marriage with Mary Heuffer, July 15, 1862. He lived on this farm for 42 years, moving to Lansing in 1903.

Besides his widow, Mrs. Mary Bauerly, he is survived by four sons, William, Edward, Charles and Henry, and three daughters, Mrs. Lydia Neller, Mrs. Carrie Schlenker and Mrs. Mary Friegel all of this city.

Funeral services will be held Thursday at 1:30 p. m. at the residence. Rev. F. M. Krauss of the Lutheran Emmanuel church will officiate. Interment will be made in Hurd's cemetery.

He began growing vegetables and berries on his property, and it wasn't long before he switched his activities to flowers. The Bauerle's owned the first florist delivery truck in Lansing. Smith and Bissinger have been in the commercial florist business longer than the Bauerles, but the management of these shops has passed to succeeding generations. Mr. Bauerle was the first president of the Central Michigan Floral club, and the first vice-president of this organization. He was a member of the Society of American Florists before - becoming affiliated with the Florists Telegraph Delivery association.

Mrs. Bauerle, 74. who has worked steadily with her husband, reveals that they have not taken a real vacation since they entered the florist business. They plan to leave for Florida shortly after the first of the year.

Lansing - G. Frederick Bauerle, 82, life-long resident of Lansing and a florist here for 47 years, died Wednesday afternoon June 9, 1948 at a local hospital as the result of a stroke a week ago. Bauerle, who lived at 2000 North East Street, was the oldest living member of the Emanuel First Evangelical Lutheran church, a charter member of the North Side Commercial club, past president of the Central Michigan Florist association and a member of the state organization. The Bauerle greenhouse and flower store are at 2000 North East Street.

He is survived by the widow, Wilhelmine; a son, Paul G. Bauerle, who also is a florist in Lansing; two daughters, Mrs. Harry Winfield, Lansing, and Mrs. Paul Niehaus; Chelsea; four grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; three brothers, William Bauerle, Chelsea; Daniel Bauerle, Chicago, and Robert Bauerle. Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and a sister, Mrs. Charles Hoeger, San Diego, California.

Mr. Bauerle's body was removed to the Estes-Leadley funeral home, where it will remain until time for funeral services at 2:30 o'clock Saturday afternoon. Last rites will be held from the First Emanuel Lutheran church, with Rev. Karl Krauss officiating. Burial will be in Mt. Hope cemetery.

Other publications in which Ruth's scholarship and essays appeared include The James Joyce Quarterly, A Wake Newslitter (sic), The Columbus Dispatch, The Plain Dealer, The Thurber House Organ, Irish Heritage, The Journal of Modern Literature, and The Historian, among others.
