William Beuerle, Freedom Twp., section 22, was born in Wurtemberg, Germany, A. D. 1839, where he was educated, and lived until 1854, when he came to America. He remained in New York a short time and then came West by the way of Buffalo and Canada. He went to Lansing, thence to Wisconsin, and later into the Southwestern States. In 1861 he returned to the north and purchased land where he now lives. He built a log house and opened a saloon, which he has carried on to the present, at the same time doing much work as a carpenter. In 1865 he built his present commodious quarters. In politics Mr. Beuerle is a Democrat. He has held the office of Constable six years, and during that time was Deputy Sheriff; Township Treasurer, two terms; Justice of the Peace over 10 years, and still holding it. He is a member of the Arbeiter-verein of Manchester. In 1863 he was married to Caroline Artz, of Lansing, a native of Wurtemberg. To them have been born 6 sons and 2 daughters.

Maxfield Doyle Crook was born November 2, 1936 in Lincoln, Nebraska. He moved as a child to Ann Arbor, Michigan. He first learned to play the accordion, before taking up the piano, and by the time he was 14 he had already built his own studio. In 1957, after studying at the University of New Mexico, he enrolled at Western Michigan in Kalamazoo where he formed a rock and roll group called The White Bucks, who released a single, "Get That Fly", on Dot Records in 1959.

In the that same year he built a hybrid single-note playing synthesizer, which he called the Musitron, out of a clavichord enhanced with additional resistors, television tubes, and parts from household appliances, old amplifiers and reel-to-reel tape machines. He was unable to patent the Musitron because most of its components were already patented products. He first used it for recording at a session at Berry Gordy's studio in Detroit, on an unreleased version of "Bumble Boogie". The sound of the Musitron was influential on other musicians and producers, including Gordy, Joe Meek, Ennio Morricone, John Barry and Roy Wood.

Later in 1959, he met Charles Westover, yet to take the stage name Del Shannon, who asked him to join his band, "Charlie Johnson and the Big Little Show Band", as keyboard player. They signed a recording contract in 1960, and Crook began playing the Musitron on stage for the first time soon afterwards. During a live set one night, Crook hit an unusual chord change going from A-minor to G, and he and Del Shannon developed the lick into a song, which became "Runaway". In January 1961, Shannon and Crook recorded "runaway", which soon became an international hit. He is an American

musician, a pioneer of electronic music in pop. He also recorded as Maximilian.

In the late 1960's he moved to California and worked as a burglar alarm installer and firefighter, before returning to recording with Del Shannon and Brian Hyland. Hyland's version of Curtis Mayfield's "Gypsy Woman", featuring Crook's keyboards, became a hit in 1970. He also wrote the score for James Sturgen's movie "Time and Beyond". In the 1980's he began performing gospel and spiritual music, recording an album "Good News!". He now lives in Deming, New Mexico.

On July 1, 2020, Maxfield Doyle Crook, loving husband and father, passed away at the age of 83. Maxfield (Max) was born on November 2, 1936, in Lincoln, Nebraska to Clarence and Helen (Mullikin) Crook. He was a graduate of Ann Arbor High School in Ann Arbor, Michigan and later received his degree in business from Western Michigan University. On 1958, Max married high school classmate, Joann Louise Stollsteimer and they raised a daughter, Susan Ann, and son, David Lee, in Michigan and subsequently in California. Max was an innovator and a pioneer in many facets during his life that touched millions of people. His career milestones included the co-writing of a 1961 hit called, "Runaway" which was given the BMI "Million-Air" award for over two million radio broadcast performances and later inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1999. Max's musical talents found him performing on The Midnight Special, ABC's In Concert, and the Hollywood Bowl while collaborating with many artists such as Del Shannon, Liberace, Robert Moog, Tom Petty, and more. Max's invention of the Clavioline instrument called the "Musitron", as heard in the hit song, "Runaway", has been judged by music historians as one of the early forerunners for modern synthesizers.

While in California, Max was a training captain with the Ventura County Fire Department and helped pioneer what is now known as the FIRESCOPE CA Task Force. FIRESCOPE helped shape all coordination for interdepartmental, multiagency emergency disaster, natural disaster and multiple fire alarm response that California and other states use today. Beyond his professional accomplishments, Max was known for his love of music. It was said that there was not an instrument he could not play thanks to his amazing ability to hear music. Max and his first wife, Joann, lived on a ranch in the Mojave Desert that was a delightful place for ministry, music, and fellowship. Max and his second wife, Glenda, enjoyed a Christian worship music ministry for many years. Additionally, he had a music ministry in both churches and public presentations such as retirement homes, RV parks, campgrounds, and National Day of Prayer celebrations. Max will be best remembered by all as a kind, empathetic, and wise person who would do anything for the other person without thinking about himself. From being a varsity diver in college; lifeguard and orderly soon after high school; and piano practicing teen after school for the junior high school janitors, Max was always pursuing excellence in every area of life. Max was unassumingly a gifted giver. Nothing can fill the void left behind by his departure and he will be deeply missed by family, friends, for his faith, and by millions touched by his music here on Earth. Max was preceded in death by his father, Clarence, his mother, Helen, and his beloved wife of 56 years, Joann.

He is survived by his loving wife, Glenda, of Deming, his two children, Susan Crook of Deming, David and his wife, Patricia Crook of Logan, and his grandson, Isaac Crook of Logan, New Mexico. He is also survived by his sister, Donna, and her husband, Dr. Ronald Snyder, of Petoskey, Michigan, and three nephews, five grandnephews and three grandnieces.
