KC, a golden retriever, greets me at the door. Amy ushers me in, telling me how KC is just too friendly. Kara comes and shakes my hand. Then Connor comes from the other room. Justin walks down the steps and then Austin bounces down last. I later meet Hunter, another sibling and their dad, Bill. So many people have greeted me. They're all so friendly. And more than half of them share the same birthday.

Kara, Connor, Justin and Austin are quadruplets who have just recently graduated high school from Brentwood Academy. Most families, especially large ones, have some element of loudness and sibling camaraderie, or rather, bickering. Sitting down with the quads I can't help but laugh and smile, because the amount of back and forth, asides, embarrassment and annoyance all combines into this chatter that is so happy. I guess that's what happens when you've been around the same people since you were in the womb.

Connor and Austin look alike. They get mistaken for each other a lot. Justin relaxes and talks occasionally, but never looks annoyed. Kara is the mom of the group. She answers for everyone, even when they assure her they can answer for themselves. She shows her love for them by how attentive she is to each of their personalities. Austin brings the party. He says he can cheer everyone up pretty easily. I'm hanging out with them to find out how they feel about going off to college. All of them are going to different schools and doing different things.

Kara is attending the University of Virginia and majoring in foreign affairs. She was the Class of 2013 valedictorian at BA. She played soccer and softball and was a part of many clubs. The boys joke that she got all the smarts in the family. Bill interjects and reminds them that she just got the work ethic. Kara wants to be a part of the CIA one day. She recently started learning martial arts and she plans to learn Persian to aid in this dream.

Connor is going to Baylor University for biology. Justin is attending Texas Christian University. He plans to try out as a walk on for their football team and he either wants to go into business or journalism. Austin is attending Samford for business. The boys have had the same friends for most of their lives, especially in high school. For so long they've been identified as the quads, as a unit. They're not all completely sure how it will go being separated, but they all feel bittersweet excitement. "I said I'm not gonna miss them now, but I will," Austin said. Kara said they'll probably have a group message for all of them to keep in touch. Amy gets a little teary eyed looking back on how close the kids are, much to the embarrassment of the quads. She said sometimes they'll come home from hanging out with friends and she'll catch them all just sitting at the kitchen table talking about their days.
