Jacob F. Graff.—There is no one nation that has contributed to the complex composition of our American social fabric an element of more sterling worth or of greater value in fostering and supporting our national institutions that has Germany. Of this fine class of adopted citizenship it would be difficult to discover an individual more representative from every viewpoint than Jacob F. Graff, one of the largest property holders and most prominent men in all Jasper County. He is the owner of four hundred and forty acres of the finest and most advantageously situated agricultural property, and in addition owns two residence properties in LaRussell. He is, in fact, an able exponent of the progressive spirit and strong initiative ability which have caused this section to forge so rapidly forward, and he enjoys the high regard of a wide circle of people.

Jacob F. Graff was born February 22, 1846, in Leinfelden, Oberamt Stuttgart, Wurtemberg, Germany, and is the son of John George and Kathrena (Elsazer) Graff, farmers in the Fatherland. The grandfather, Rev. John George Graff, was a Lutheran minister, a composer of songs and the author of a prayer book. When a young man but nineteen years of age Jacob Graff came to America to seek out the fine opportunities of which he had heard so much. He came only a short time after the close of the Civil War, the date of his arrival in New York being July 17, 1865. Having an offer of employment in Michigan in the capacity of a farmer, he journeyed there and remained in the service of his first employer for a period of six years and eight months. In the meantime he learned the language and adapted himself to new conditions. In 1872, in the spring of the year, he made a momentous change by removing to Missouri, going first to Boone County, where he worked throughout the season on the farm and plantation of William Bass where he was foreman on the ranch of 2,000 acres of land. In the fall of the year he went to Lawrence County, where he arrived on the 8th of November. With his savings he bought a farm in the vicinity of Pierce City and he remained upon the same until 1890, steadily advancing in prosperity and experience. In the year mentioned he sold his Lawrence county holdings and removed to Jasper County, and on August 12, 1890, he purchased two hundred and eighty acres of fine bottom land on Spring River. Here he has prospered exceedingly and is one of the most substantial and highly regarded agriculturists of the state. His property includes a number of beautiful acres, and in 1897, in one of the most beautiful locations in Jasper County, he erected a handsome farm residence. He has since added one hundred and sixty acres to his holdings, making four hundred and forty in all. In addition to his other distinctions Mr. Graff has achieved local fame as a remarkably shrewd and accurate weather observer and prognosticator, having studied weather and atmospheric conditions for a life time. She has been twice married, wedding first Henry Oltmann, who was killed by lightning, and at his death he left two children, Herman T. and Harold C. She is now the wife of Lucian C. Stemmons, and they live in Newton County, Missouri. Albert W. Graff is a successful farmer and stock raiser in Sarcoxie Township, Jasper County. He married Katie Evarts, and they have four children: Earl, Altha, Freda and Dorothy. Carl Graff is a farmer and an extensive dealer and shipper of cattle and hogs. He graduated from the Great Western Business College, Webb City, Missouri, where he completed the course in five months. He married Helen Moody, of Jericho, Cedar County, Missouri.

Ann Arbor News, September 28, 1928:

An Ann Arbor man met death and a Scio Township resident was seriously injured in two automobile accidents Thursday afternoon.

Lloyd F. Ernst, 27, of 1223 Lutz Ave., died Thursday afternoon in University Hospital where he was taken following an accident on the Saline Road about one mile north of that village. Death was due, it is believed, to a fractured skull.

Julius Reuter, 57, Liberty Road, is in University Hospital with serious injuries sustained earlier in the day in a crash west of Ann Arbor on Liberty Road, and accident which, coincidentally, was witnessed by Mr. Ernst. Mr. Reuter's condition was reported much improved today.

As there were no witnesses to the accident in which Mr. Ernst sustained fatal injuries, authorities today conducted an investigation to determine the manner in which the crash happened. Undersheriff Jacob B. Andres and Coroner E. C. Ganzhorn, after interviewing several persons, were able to piece together the story of the tragedy.

Mr. Ernst left home, at 1:30 Thursday afternoon for the Ernst Bros. Electric shop which he and a brother, Carl, had conducted for seven and one-half years. While taking material to men working at the Belt Line Highway and Liberty Road. Mr. Ernst witnessed the crash in which Mr. Reuter was injured. He went to Saline and after completing business there started for home between 3 o'clock and 3:15. It is believed that on the way home, his car, a light truck, got off the shoulder of the road and when he attempted to get it back into the highway, it turned over.

William Longfellow, Saline, drove by shortly afterward and seeing that an accident and happened, asked a farm resident nearby to telephone to Saline for a wrecking car and medical aid while he went on to Ann Arbor to notify Ernst's brother and get an ambulance. John Lamb and Leo Westphal, employees of a garage, answered the call and believing Ernst to be seriously hurt, rushed him to University Hospital. He died shortly after being admitted. The top of the truck, the windshield and the sides were damaged, and the wheels and fenders bent, indicating that the vehicle had turned over.

Lloyd Ernst was born Dec. 19, 1900, in Blissfield, the son of John and Sarah Beck Ernst. The family moved to Ann Arbor 22 years ago and he attended public schools and learned the electrical trade here. With his brother, Carl, he established the Ernst Bros. Electric shop several years ago. He was married July 6, 1920, to Edith Hertler of Saline.

He is survived by the widow, three children, Frederick, Edward and Phyllis; his mother, Mrs. Sarah Ernst, Ann Arbor; two brother, Carl and Walter of this city, and a sister, Mrs. Frank Lang, also of Ann Arbor.

Funeral services, which will be private, will be held at 1:30 Sunday afternoon at the residence. Rev. C. H. Wittbracht of Saline will officiate. Burial will be in Bethlehem Cemetery. Friends may call at the residence until Sunday noon.

La Russell School was originally known as "Swindle" school. The La Russell School was originally organized as the Swindle School District about 1870. It was located southwest of La Russell on the old Jacob Graff farm at the crossroads of Highway F and Second Road. It was used as a church and a school. Some years later a nice frame house was built on the Lewis Meador farm about 200 yards west of the present Meador home, but it was still called Swindle school.

In 1904 when the Missouri Pacific Railroad went through, La Russell was established and a 2 room, red brick building was built on a hill west of La Russell where the school now stands. A new modern room was added in 1962. The La Russell School consolidated with Sarcoxie School in 1966. Teachers:

Notes for Joseph John Fischer:

Joseph J. Fischer, 55 years old, 715 W. Jefferson Street, a well-known electrician employed by the Detroit Edison Co. for 20 years, was electrocuted about 3 o'clock Saturday afternoon when he came in contact with a live wire carrying 24.000 volts at the company's Argo sub-station, 987 Broadway. Mr. Fischer received the terrific electrical shock when he started to paint a rusty bolt to which the wire was connected, according to William Folske, 206 Montgomery Ave., the foreman in charge of the maintenance crew which had been inspecting, repairing and repainting the wires and connections in the sub-station's bank of transformers.

Mr. Folske said Mr. Fischer's fingers apparently were touching the metal strip on the brush which held the bristles in place, the current passing through the paint and the metal to his body. Half the circuit at the sub-station had been shut off during the repair work, but Mr. Folske said a minute before the accident he had warned Mr. Fischer that the particular wire was "hot." The shock threw Mr. Fischer to the ground 15 feet below where he had been working, his head striking a cement mat. Mr. Folske and Mr. Fischer's brother, Wiliam F. Fischer, of Barton Drive, applied artificial respiration immediately. Two minutes later Mr. Fischer partly revived, mumbling the word, "sit," but he collapsed again a moment later and could not be revived despite continued artificial respiration and heart stimulants.

A lifelong resident of Ann Arbor Mr. Fischer was born, here Nov. 3, 1883, a son of the late Matthias and Christiana Waltz Fischer. He was a member of Zion Lutheran Church, Golden Rule lodge, No. 159, F.&A.M., Zal Gaz Grotto, No. 34, M.O.V.P.E.R., Elks Lodge, No. 325, of Ann Arbor, and the Schwaben
