John Gute founded the Owosso Brewery in 1855 on Corunna Ave; Owosso, Michigan.

The Owosso Sanitarium - "Magnetic Mineral Springs and Water Cure"

According to county records, land transfers show ownership through the years to John Bliss - 1844, W.H. Kyte, M.W. Quackenbush, Charles Howard, A.L. Wills and A.L. Williams before John Gute became the owner of Gute Hill. In 1871, Gute developed the property into a mineral bath company, because the water was to have 'curative powers'. Publicity by Gute at the time made great claims for the "health-giving waters." Instead of storing their beer in the cold caverns they heated the mineral springs within and used the baths for a health spa.

People began to visit the spring to bathe in its waters in hopes of curing rheumatism, arthritis and even tuberculosis. One woman, reportedly came from Toronto, Canada, convinced she could be cured by bathing in the spring in Owosso.

In the 1900 Census, it lists George, Herman and Katherine Gute as the proprietors of the Owosso Sanitarium, and that Dr. Frederick W. Noble as the Physician. The site was on the hill (bluff), 1/2 mile south of downtown Owosso, today known as Gute Hill.

That spring, or flowing well, however, had become nearly dry by 1910 and it is interesting to note that it was across the street from the Oak Hill Cemetery, through which, at least some of that 'great tasting spring water' would have been filtered.

In 1909, the German Arbeiter Society let the property go back to the Gute Family, because of financial problems. It was later sold to Bible Holiness Seminary and Holiness Church changed the school's role from a seminary and Bible college to that of a four year Christian liberal arts college.

In June of 1970, the Owosso College cut all ties with the church sponsored affiliation. And in 1972, renamed it, John Wesley College of Owosso.

Joseph H. Thorpe. Although born and reared to the age of twelve years in England, the late Joseph

H. Thorpe was a resident of Pontiac for twenty-eight years, and during that period fully demonstrated his interest in the city and its residents, and is well and favorably remembered by them as a good man, enterprising and progressive in his business and elevated and serviceable in his citizenship. He was as warmly and sincerely devoted to this country as he ever could have been to that of his birth, and his loyalty to Pontiac, Oakland County and the state of Michigan was very decided and cordial.

Mr. Thorpe's life began on December 2, 1840, in Lincolnshire, England, where his parents, Joseph and Sarah (Lake) Thorpe, were also born. The family came to the United States in 1852 and at once located in Pontiac. Here the father was a dealer in livestock and a butcher. He bought ninety acres of land within what are now the city limits, and located in the northwestern part of the municipal domain. On this land he erected a residence and occupied it with the members of his household until March, 1872, when the son Joseph, purchased the place and in the same year also purchased another place. The death of the father occurred on July 29, 1873, The mother died on December 2, of the same year. They had eleven children, of whom only one, their son Charles, the last born of the family, is living. The ten who died were: Mary Ann, William, George, Thomas, Benjamin, John, Eliza, Joseph H., Sarah and Jeremiah. The widow of Joseph now owns and lives in the old family home.

At an early age Joseph 11. Thorpe engaged in the butchering business in Detroit, but after carrying it on for a few years he returned to Pontiac and became the buyer for the shop. He bought cattle steadily and also fed great numbers on the home farm for the custom at the Pontiac market kept first by his father and afterward by himself. In this way he made the business very active and at the same time more profitable than if he had been obliged to depend on outside sources for this stock. While he conducted the meat market it was the leading one in the city and the most popular and best patronized, for the goods were always first class and the prices always just what they ought to be.

On March 6, 1872, Mr. Thorpe was married to Miss Matilda Schaeffer, a daughter of John and Barbara (Gauss) Schaeffer, natives of Germany. Mrs. Thorpe was born in Wurtemberg in the Fatherland, October 14, 1850, and was brought to the United States by her parents in the spring of 1852. The family came over in a sailing vessel which was fifty-two days on the voyage, and as this was so extended the supply of provisions ran low and all the passengers were put on short rations. On their arrival in this country the parents located at Ann Arbor in this state. The father was a weaver by trade, but here he was in the employ of the Michigan Central Railroad for twenty-five years. Two children were born in the family: Mrs. Thorpe and her brother Henry, who is now a resident of Denver, Colorado. Mr. Schaeffer was the mother's second husband. She was first married to John P. Frank, and by that marriage she became -the mother of one child, her son Phillip. Her second husband gave him the name of Phillip Frank Schaeffer, and under that name he is now living and in business in Buffalo, New York.

Joseph H. Thorpe and his wife had three children. Elizabeth was born on March 26, 1873, and is still living with her mother. She is a teacher of music and has studied in Detroit, Ann Arbor, Pontiac and three years in Europe. Fred was born on March 8, 1875, and is a machinist. Joseph H., whose life began on June 24, 1877, is engaged in the sporting goods business in Pontiac. In their several localities and occupations the children all emulate the enterprise and progressiveness of their father in business and the high character and stern sense of duty of both their parents, giving their several communities excellent examples of the best American citizenship. The father was a Democrat in political faith and allegiance and one of the most effective workers for his party in this county. His religious affiliation was with the Presbyterian Church, of which Mrs. Thorpe is a member. At his death on the 12th of December, 1880, the people of Oakland County mourned the loss of one of their best citizens, and now they revere his memory according to the same estimate.

WILLARD J. TURNER. Among the notable Michigan families none have been more conspicuous in public and professional life nor borne the responsibilities of citizenship with greater dignity and social service than have the Turners during the three generations of their residence; in this state. The law in which many of them gained distinction furnished a fine field in which they were able to contribute their talents and energies to the service of their respective communities and the entire state. Men of the name have been prominent in politics from the territorial era, have served on the bench, both in the Circuit and Supreme Court, and as lawyers have always held a front rank. Willard J. Turner, above named, has been an active member of the bar of Michigan for the past thirty years and for twenty years has been a resident of Muskegon.

Willard J. Turner was born at Corunna, Shiawassee County, Michigan, July 30, 1861, a son of Jerome W. and Martha F. Gregory Turner. The paternal grandparents were Josiah and Eveline (Ellsworth) Turner, the former a native of Vermont and the latter of Connecticut. - They came to Michigan

during the territorial period and Josiah Turner took up land in Washtenaw County. He was a lawyer by profession, was elected county judge, probate judge, and for twenty-six years held the office of circuit judge. He was also one of the early members of the Supreme Court of Michigan. He studied law under Bates Turner, his uncle, who was one of the justices of the Supreme Court of Vermont. Josiah Turner was among the original organizers of the Republican Party in Michigan, and was a delegate to the constitutional convention of 1850. The maternal grandfather of the Muskegon lawyer was Edward E. Gregory, who was himself a man of remarkable talent and intellectual attainments. A graduate of Princeton University, he was for many years a minister of the Presbyterian Church. Judge Campbell of the Michigan Supreme court studied Latin under Mr. Gregory. He was a splendid linguist and had a reputation throughout the state as a scholar. Many years of his life were spent as an invalid, but he lived to the venerable age of eighty-four. Jerome W. Turner, father of Willard J., was born at St. Albans, Vermont, in 1836, and died in September, 1907. His wife was born at Saline, in Washtenaw County, Michigan, in 1837, and died in September, 1910. They were married in 1857. Jerome W. Turner was liberally educated, and some years after he had begun his profess1onal career, while a member of the state senate, he made a speech in favor of a bill appropriating money for the State University, and saved the measure from defeat. On this account the university granted him the honorary degree of Master of Arts. He studied law under Judge Fred Whittle, one of the eminent attorneys of the state and an associate of Jacob Howard, at one time attorney general of Michigan. Mr. Turner was admitted to the bar in 1857, and became one of the ablest lawyers in his generation. He made a large fortune and his achievements as a lawyer have a secure place in the history of the state bar. He was very broadly read and possessed considerable genius in literature. He corresponded for a number of papers in the east, and at one time composed a poem under the title of "The Thrasher's Nest," which came under the observation of Oliver Wendell Holmes and received some very favorable comments from that noted critic and author. Jerome W. Turner and wife became the parents of ten children, seven of whom are now living, namely: Jerome E.; Willard J.; Charles G., an attorney and one of the leaders of the bar at Grand Rapids; Eveline, who married a Mr. Decker, a Michigan farmer; Edward E., an attorney, who died in 1901; Horace B., who is in real estate business in the west; and E. P. and Milo, both living in the west. The parents were active members of the Congregational church. Jerome W. Turner went to the war in a Michigan regiment, and at the end of his service held the rank of major. Later he had an active part in Grand Army circles. In politics his support was given to the Republican cause until the Greeley movement in 1872, after which he was a Democrat up to 1890. From that time he supported William McKinley and the Republican principles.

Willard J. Turner is a graduate of the Owosso high school. In 1880 he took up the study of law in his father's office and recited his lessons to his grandfather. On September 11, 1882, he was admitted to the bar and at once started to practice in Owosso. That city remained his home until the spring of 1890, since which time he has lived and been closely identified with the bar of Muskegon, with the exception of two years spent in Detroit. Three months after his removal to Muskegon came his nomination to the office of prosecuting attorney on the Democratic ticket. His opponent was J. C. McLaughlin, now congressman from that district. The county had a normal Republican majority of twenty-five hundred, but Mr. Turner succeeded in overturning that majority and was elected. He had served one term in the same office while living in Owosso. Sometime later the governor offered him the appointment of Deputy Warden 'at the penitentiary, but that honor was declined. He served two years as circuit court commissioner. His practice has always been large and has identified him with many of the most important cases tried in the western courts of Michigan. Mr. J. H. Moore a few years ago appointed him to the office of city attorney. At the first convention of the Progressive party he was nominated for justice of the supreme court, and was defeated by only thirty-five hundred votes, running away ahead of the rest of the ticket.

In 1885 Mr. Turner married Louise Gute, a daughter of John Gute, at one time mayor of the city of Owosso. Three children have been born to their marriage. Willard G., now city editor of the Muskegon Chronicle, graduated from the Muskegon high school and spent one year in Ann Arbor at the State University; Margaret, who has made a fine record as a student, graduated from the high school and later from the teachers' department of Columbia University at New York City, has taught kindergarten in the Muskegon city schools, is an accomplished musician and at the present writing is resuming her studies in music. John G., the youngest, is a member of the class of 1914 in the Muskegon high school. The family worship in the Congregational church and Mr. Turner is active in the fraternity of the Odd Fellows, having made addresses on several occasions for the lodge. His politics is of the Progressive Republican brand.
