






# Quest to 60% Vaccination Rate Grand Forks County Vaccination Dashboard Data as of April 11, 2021\*








# Quest to 60% Vaccination Rate Grand Forks County Vaccine Coverage Data as of April 11, 2021\*



7 Day Average of New COVID-19 Cases per Day per 100,000 Grand Forks County




Day Sum of COVID-19 Tests per 100,000 population Grand Forks County

#### 7 Day Average of Percent of All Tests Administered that are Positive for COVID-19 Grand Forks County




#### Percent Change Between 7 Day Case Totals (14 Days Total) Grand Forks County







New Case Rate Comparison per 100,000 – Other North Dakota Counties


