A NOTE FROM PASTOR IVY

"Spring and Jesus are coming!"



Well hello there!

Here we are - the beginning of Lent. I am really looking forward to being part of doing Lent BIG at Calvary. Our theme is "Searching". We are searching for things like peace, time, identity, healing, unity, and spirit. Lent is a time of reflection and wondering and hoping and we will do all of these things around each of those themes. Each week as we gather, we will search for the topics together and ask for each other's help. For now, however, I'm searching for people to join us in searching. I'm wondering if you could help me?

I also feel as though I need to name that this has been a long, hard season of winter for many reasons and they're more than just the weather. From many funerals to many winter storms, from cloudy days to cold, frigid sunshiny days, we have had to be hearty, resourceful and strong. It can get tiring. Seasonal Affective Disorder (SAD), and just plain old frustration with the weather have been the topic of many discussions that I have had recently. And this is where the pastor in me wishes to remind us that we, dear friends, are people of the resurrection! We know that after death comes life; after cold comes warmth; after clouds comes sunshine. It is beautiful to me that this year Jesus will rise in a season that (usually) feels like actual spring in North Dakota and Minnesota. It is beautiful to me that this year, Easter will be full of colorful, green landscape and less of what has us buried - literally and figuratively. It is beautiful to me that no matter what winter or darkness we experience in our lives that Jesus has conquered it all. Yes, we are moving into Lent and Jesus has not risen 'yet'. But we know that it is coming and so the cold, loneliness, and cabin fever will no longer have power over us because Jesus is coming and when he does we will proclaim "Hallelujah! Christ is risen! He is risen indeed!"

Calvary, spring is coming. We have much to hope for. And yet, warmer weather is the least of what we have to celebrate. We will search and then discover what is in the tomb - or rather, what is not!

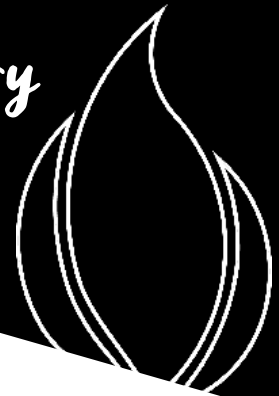
Grace and peace to you from our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Amen.

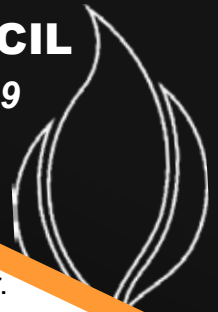

Highlights of the CHURCH COUNCIL

February 2019



Treasurer's Report - January Overview

Income in January was 20% or \$12,300 lower when comparing with the prior year. The temperature in the second half of January 2019 was quite cold and may have had an effect on the attendance and in turn the gifts received each Sunday. While our goal each month is to receive receipts at the same level or higher than prior years, at the first month of the year, it is hard to predict the receipts for the remainder of the year.

January's noisy offering was collected for the Great Plains Food Bank in the amount of \$1,316. The new year started off with a busy Calvary schedule. Calvary members were invited to a sledding event at the beginning of January, confirmation students had the opportunity to join other churches for a city-wide event, new members were welcomed at the end of January and the community was invited to the Honduras Rummage Sale.

Year-to-date expenses were \$5,000 lower than the prior year, but \$11,500 higher than the five-year average. In 2017, Calvary began paying property insurance in January which skews the five year average. While January's income and expenses are not unusual, there is still the desire for financials to improve each year. Our prayers as a team are for the congregation to continue to support Calvary through their time, talents, and gifts.

Council Business

This was the first meeting of the new council members. A council retreat is planned for Feb. 16 to get to know each other and dream for Calvary's future. Plans are being made for Lenten services which begin with Ash Wednesday on March 6.

Officers and Ministry Teams

There were many opportunities for Calvary members to join in fellowship and service. There was an afternoon of sledding, over 25 new members joined our church, confirmation students met for a city wide event, and the Honduras rummage sale was a huge success. There were several funerals in January with many volunteers working to serve these.

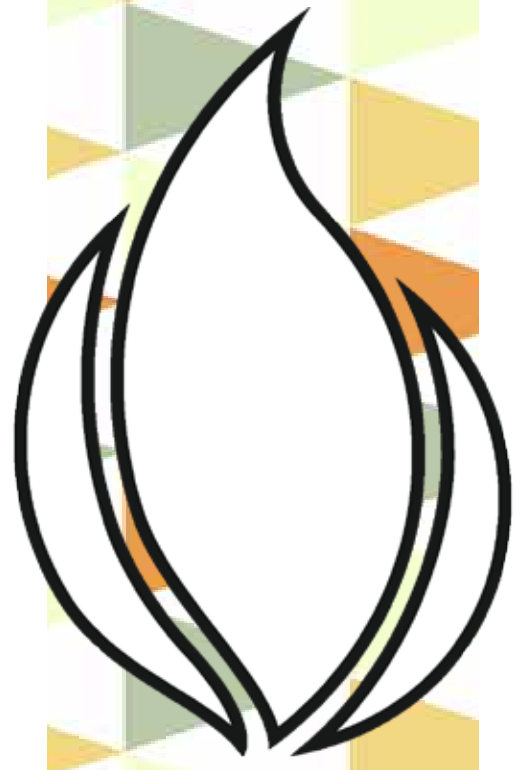
