Entries for all other breeds will be put on a wait list in the order in which they were received. After 6:00 pm on 4/22, all other entries will be added to the trial until the limits are reached, and the rest will be placed on a wait list.

You must waive the signature requirement for delivery services, if applicable.

- ✓ Hand deliveries cannot be accepted in the first 24 hours.
- ✓ A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. Please use care in clearly indicating which days, classes, courses (A or B) and stock you wish to enter for each dog.
- ✓ Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope, regardless of the number of classes entered. Envelopes containing entries for more than ten dogs will be treated as invalid entries and returned.
- ✓ Entries must be signed and include the full AGREEMENT. Unsigned, incomplete, or illegible entries will not be accepted.
- ✓ Entries submitted without correct entry fees will not be accepted.
- ✓ Confirmation of entry will be sent via email if an email address is included on the entry form.

Notice to Exhibitors

--The Trial Secretary is not responsible for emails not received. If you have not received a response to an email after 24 hours, please call the Trial Secretary by telephone.

--The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport.

--Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the veterinarian, judge, or Trial Committee.

--Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, an act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

-- Entries must be made on Official AKC Entry Forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must complete the back of the entry form. Please include only AKC titles on your entries.

--No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without entry fees, or signatures.

--Post Dated and Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.

--Bitches in season will be permitted to run but will be placed at the end of the running order in Tests and in catalog order for Trial classes.

-- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

--Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs at show site and all hotel, motel, and campgrounds where they are staying while competing in these trials.

--Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. GSLSSC has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

--All dogs must be on lead or crated at all times except when in the arena.

Dogs must wear a simple well-fitting buckle, snap lock, or slip collar (no tags) or may work without a collar at Trial levels.

-- Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

-- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

--Greater St. Louis Shetland Sheepdog Club, their Board, Members, RottiEwe Farm and employees will not be liable for any loss of property or injury which may be sustained through disappearance, loss, theft, communicable disease, parasites, injury and/or death of dogs entered in this event.

--GSLSSC does not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for this event.

Trial site will be available from 7:00 am to one hour after the conclusion of the trial. Bring your own chairs and water for your dog.

NO unentered dogs are allowed on the trial grounds.

D Course

Ten to fifteen sheep will be used per run. In addition to the seven required elements, the following extra elements may be used in any combination — Sort/Gate Work, Stock Trailer, Chute and/or Freestanding Pen. Courses and maps will be posted one hour prior to the start of judging. A walk through with the judge will be conducted prior to the start of each class.

Move-ups

Dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for herding title, provided that the request is made to the Event Secretary no later than one-half hour before the start of the trial and that there are open runs available in the class. Email notice is acceptable.
