One of the whistleblower directly talks about reversed engineered UFO's and biological material (ie alien bodies). Here are other thoughts about whistleblower testimony:

Other than direct physical contact and examination of alien and man made craft, and alien bodies the best evidence will be obtained from credible whistleblowers and other witnesses who corroborate in multiple ways the key facts.

Any individual whistleblower can be totally wrong either on purpose, misunderstanding what they saw/heard, or because they are mentally ill or delusional. That is why we will need to see many credible witnesses that are essentially saying the same thing.

So far I have linked you to two armed forces whistleblowers who could both be suffering from PTSD and delusional thoughts. You could easily reach the conclusion that both of these men are in that category. However parts of their testimony are very compelling. I won't say they are telling the truth until I hear more from other witnesses, but it is tantalizing.
