Festival organizers would like to inform anyone that is going to camp at this year's festival that all camping will be at the Wyandot County Fairgrounds. All sites are mowed grass. Campers, motor homes and tents are all welcome.

Emergency Services including the Sherriff Axillary will be on site or dial 911

- NO GLASS CONTAINERS
- Registration at the campgrounds
- Campers enter in the South entrance off of St. Rt. 53
- No food or beverages outside your campsite area
- No generators after 1:00 am
- No swimming in ponds or river.
- Stay out of planted alfalfa fields.
- Observe posted speed limits.
- All campers must depart the campgrounds by 1:00pm Sunday, July 6th, 2025.
- No individual ground campfires.
- Each individual site, portable camping unit or recreational vehicle in a temporary park-camp that has a connection to a potable water supply shall be equipped with an ASSE number 1024 dual check valve backflow prevention device or equivalent device at the source and at the points of connection.
- All water hoses used for human consumption in a temporary park-camp must be rated for potable water use only.
- When solid wastes are stored at the site or at a central point within the park or camp, they shall be stored in durable, watertight, non-absorbent and easily cleanable containers with tight fitting covers. Containers and covers shall be maintained in a clean condition and in good repair. Solid waste containers shall be sufficient in number and size to accommodate all solid wastes between collections. Containers must be easily accessible and emptied at least weekly unless otherwise authorized by the licensor.
