

WCYP Meeting Minutes
Thursday, April 25, 2024 – 6:30pm

President Zach Morral called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m.

Treasurer's Report – Zach announced there was a balance of \$52,491.31 in the checking account.

- Budgeted expenses include \$2,500 for Village of Carey Playground Equipment and \$8,000 for 2024 scholarships.

Committee Updates:

- Scholarships
 - Reviews were completed of the scholarship applications were completed at the March meeting. 4 winners were chosen: 2 USHS and 2 WHS.
 - Graham & Lesley may be presenting at the ceremonies, and Greg will get certificates and checks written.

Old Business

- Potential Elks Partnership
 - The Elks had reached out regarding the discontinued backpack program with the local food pantries due to complications/restrictions for their funds. They now have \$2,000-\$4000 available annually to possibly partner with WCYP for a different beneficial cause.
 - Follow-up had still not been done with the Elks.
 - Wyneygate was suggested as an annual event that is a partnership between Elks & WCYP, which these funds could be used to contribute to the proceeds of.
- United Way Volunteer Request
 - Zach thanked those WCYP members who volunteered for the Purse Bingo event on April 19th including: Millie, Ben, Hannah, Jess, and Greg.
 - The event raised close to \$18,000.

New Business

- Donation Requests
 - KidzWorld Daycare Center
 - Operated by Apostolic Gospel Church on 5th Street.
 - Looking for donations of any amount to reach a \$156,000 goal as they are expanding.
 - The WCYP donated \$1,500 to the daycare in Oct. 2021.
 - Jessica made a motion to donate \$1,500 to KidzWorld Daycare Center and Dan seconded the motion. The motion was then passed unanimously by way of voice vote.
 - Voice of Hope

- The WCYP received another donation request, and VoH seems to send donation requests often.
- The WCYP last donated \$100 to the organization in Jan. 2024, and \$100 in Jan. 2023 before that.
- It was decided not to make additional annual donations at this time.
- Upper Pedal Company
 - The Pedal Bike annual sponsorship is due at an amount of \$250.
 - WCYP has done the annual, smaller sign, sponsorship on the pedal bike since it started.
 - Tom made a motion to donate \$250 to the Upper Pedal Company and Lesley seconded the motion. The motion was then passed unanimously by way of voice vote.
- Wyanstock To-Do's
 - The annual To-Do List and “Week Of” duties list was shared with everyone for a reminder of all the items to take care of over the coming months.
 - General dialogue took place regarding items on the list.
