

Youth Judging

The Youth Judging event is designed to give youth experience in evaluating lama conformation, showmanship, and obstacle performance. Oral Reasons presentations encourage youth to organize thoughts and practice speaking skills while critiquing a halter class. Junior Questions segment will test general lama knowledge.

Read carefully all of the criteria for this competition, which are found in the ALSA Handbook.

Each participant **must be an ALSA Youth Member or ILR-SD member to have their points recorded.** A Youth Judging Manual may be downloaded from the ALSA website: www.alsasshow.org you may also find youth judging materials on the ILR-SD site.

There are three age categories: (based on the age of the youth as of Jan 1, 2018)

ALSA

Junior – 8 through 11 years

Intermediate – 12 through 14 years

Senior – 15 through 18 years

ILR

Junior – 7-11 years

Intermediate – 12-15 years

Senior- 16-18 years

The Youth Judging will be held following the performance classes on Saturday June 9, 2018. All youth participating in a Judging Contest during the year will be qualified for the ALSA Regional and National show. 2018 Youth judging results will be recorded with ALSA & ILR if youth have provided their member numbers for each association.
