

2019 Badgerland General Information

LLAMA AGE CATAGORIES: Halter Classes: **Age as of the first day of the show, animal moves up on birthday.**

Juvenile – 5 months through 12 months

Yearling – 13 months through 24 months

Two Year Old – Adult combined. – 25 months and over

AGE LIMITS AND GUIDELINES: Sub Junior – open class; **ILR** Youth age: Junior 7-11, Intermediates 12-15, Senior 16-18.

ALSA Youth age: Youth Junior – 8 thru 11 years; Youth Intermediate – 12 thru 14 years; Youth Senior – 15 thru 18. (Youth division age is determined by the youth's age on **January 1, 2019**, or on the date a youth becomes (7) or 8 years of age.) Youth under age 8 may not show an intact male. It is recommended that youth from 8-12 do not show intact males over 24 mos. of age. No llamas less than 5 months of age may be entered in any class. **All** youth showing in ALSA Youth classes **MUST** have a youth ALSA number! **No numbers** are required if **showing in the ILR-SD** unless you want your placing recorded. **Non- member** Adult ALSA fee is now \$50.00, Youth non- member ALSA fee - \$15.00 Contact the ALSA office for membership numbers **281-516-1442 or llamas@alsashow.net**.

PERFORMANCE ALSA RULE: A llama or alpaca can show in only one class for each performance course!

All entries including juveniles, **MUST** have an ILR certificate, except llamas shown in performance only or Non Breeder halter. If non breeders do not have ILR certificate, they must have veterinarian proof of castration. **Include copies of registration papers, and ALSA membership card with all entries.**

Classes may be combined if there are fewer than three entries per class. No llama under 5 months of age may be shown.

ALSA & ILR-SD Guidelines will apply to all classes. The show will run according to rules/guidelines in the ALSA 21st edition Handbook. Not all rules/guidelines are listed on this form. Be sure to read the ALSA handbook. Updates are on line at the **ALSA** website. Follow ALSA guidelines for **Wool Categories**. Llamas will be asked to move into appropriate wool class by judge if not properly entered.

Llovely Llama 4-H Halter show will start on Sat. June 9 at 8:30 am. Badgerland show will begin performance classes immediately following 4-H halter. ALSA & ILR-SD SHOW AWARDS: ALSA & ILR- SD Halter show will be judged in one class in the ring at the same time, two separate judges. Ribbons to 6th place will be awarded in each class. Trophies will be awarded to Grand and Reserve Champions in halter classes. Grand & Reserve youth & open Performance trophies will be awarded. **ILR-SD** places in the Grand /Reserve class will be placed to 5th place. ALSA and ILR halter classes will be announced separately.

ENTRIES: Deadline is June 3rd, 2019. Stall fee \$40 per stall. Stalls are horse stalls set on concrete floor. A Maximum of 2 adult or 3 juvenile animals per stall. \$25 per space if exhibitors bring panels. Entry fee \$25.00 per animal in ILR and ALSA halter class, \$15.00 per entry in open performance classes. \$10.00 entry fee for Group Classes, entries **MUST** have entered their appropriate halter class to participate and names must be given to the superintendent before classes begin. **Youth classes:** \$10.00 each class. **Parking and entrance: FREE. Late fee of \$25.00 per farm after June 3rd. ALL Entries close June 5. No refunds** will be given after Deadline date!

HOUSING: The floor is cement. You are responsible for your own bedding or rugs. Exhibitors must clean your stall area upon departure. All participating farms are requested to rent at least one stall space. Display stalls are not available. Signs and banners, small table and chairs are allowed at individual stalls. Common tack areas will be provided. Stall assignments are on first come basis. Stalling locations will be pre assigned. Electricity is available for fans if needed. Barns are not heated, dress accordingly.

ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE: Arrival is open on Friday, June 7 after 4 p.m. If arriving Saturday, llamas and alpacas must be in place at least ½ hour prior to show. Llamas are allowed to depart at any time, however all animals must be removed by Sunday evening, all stalls Must be cleaned prior to exhibitor departure.

ON SITE CAMPING & RV PARKING: Security will be provided by Jefferson County Fair. Camping on grounds is available at \$25.00 per unit per night. Electrical hooks up available. Questions contact Jefferson County Fair Office @ 920-674-7148. Camping/RV payment on Tally form.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: No specific health papers are required from llamas within Wisconsin. All out of state llamas must have a health certificate dated no further out then 30 days prior to show day. ALL animals must be free of infectious diseases and its signs. Show management has the right to ask any animal showing signs of ill health or behavioral problems, to leave the premises. Llama Veterinarian will be on call if needed.
