# RULES

## Show Committee has the right to combine and/or cancel any Class.

- 1. This show is run in accordance with State 4-H Horse Show Rules.
- 2. Proper tack and attire shall be enforced in all classes. Boots are required for **all** classes and Properly fitted SASTM/SEI approved safety helmets with chin straps secured must be worn by all riders in Classes 9-67 (excluding Class 11, 12 & 13).
- 3. Numbers to be worn on rider's back or saddle pad and the same number will be used in all five shows. Each horse and rider combination must have a number.
- There will be a 2-minute time limit for entering the ring after the Class has been called. Exception: tack change, announcer must be informed. After the gate is closed, no rider shall be permitted into the ring.
  Decision of the judge shall be final!
- 5. Decision of the judge shall be final!
- 6. Each horse can only be used once in each division of any event. In the case of classes open to all ages (i.e. Hunter Hack, Western Riding, etc.) the horse may only be entered once.
- 7. Horse and rider shall be one combination for all 5 shows of the circuit.
- 8. Current negative coggins test is required as well as proof of a current rabies shot.
- 9. Show Committee has the right to ask any disorderly horse or rider to leave the grounds.
- 10. No alcoholic beverages permitted on the show grounds.
- 11. The Cumberland County Fair Association and the 4-H Show Committee are not responsible for loss, damage or injury to equipment, horse, rider or spectators.
- 12. No excessive use of force in Classes 50-61.
- 13. Points for each horse and rider combination shall count toward year-end awards in each class and each division. However, <u>a horse and rider combination **must** show in at least 3 shows to be eligible</u> for year-end awards and attend the Awards Banquet. **Show management will not be responsible for any awards not picked up at banquet.**
- 14. Choice of ribbon or fifty-cent piece for First-Six Place, Grand & Reserve in each Division; ribbons and gifts. Riders must be present to receive gifts. **Prizes not picked up on day of show will be forfeited.**
- 15. Lead Line not eligible for any other class.
- 16. Walk/Trot riders must walk-trot poles and barrels only (<u>will be disqualified for loping more than two</u> <u>steps</u>).
- 17. Walk-Trot riders may ride in Walk-Trot Classes only and may not enter another horse in Walk-Trot-Lope classes. Walk-Trot riders are 5<sup>th</sup> Grade and Under and riders in Cloverbud, Grades K-3 are in the Exhibition Division and receive participation awards only.
- 18. In Hunter Hack, riders will be disqualified after two refusals. Classes may be cancelled if less than four entries are registered one hour before class.
- 19. Trail Class will run on outside course, between 1PM and 3 PM.
- 20. No horses allowed in food booth area, beyond horse barn area or in bleachers area.
- Stalls are available for \$10/day due at registration. Stall must be cleaned before you leave.
  A 15-minute lunch break will be taken.
- 23. Riders in Cloverbud Grades K- 3 and under will not be judged; they receive **participation awards only**.
- 24. NO DOGS ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS!
- 25. Adult (Walk-Trot) classes. Ages 19 and over. Riders must not currently be showing in Walk,Trot,Lope classes at any other show circuit or breed show. Entries into this division must remain in same division in order to qualify for year-end prizes.
