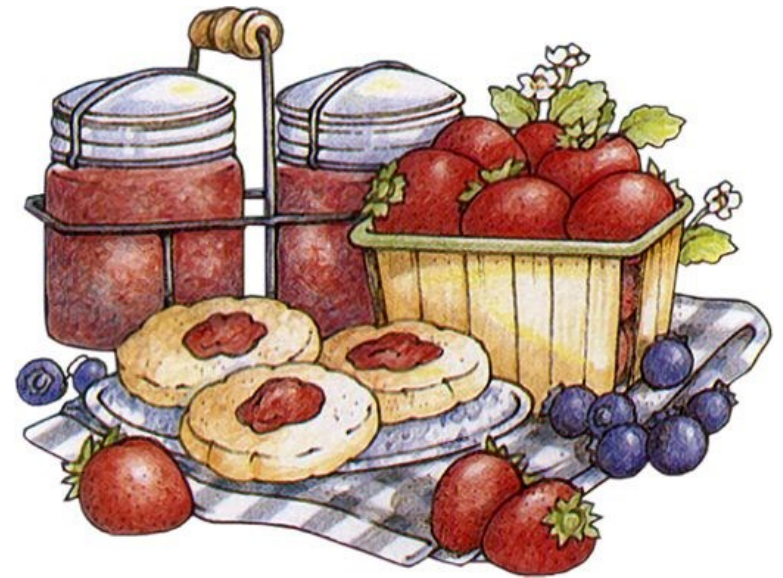

HOME ARTS EXHIBITS General Rules and Regulations

- A. *One entry per class.***
- B. Entry form can be mailed in by June 28th, 2024:
Cumberland County Fair Association
P.O. Box 1423 ~ Millville, NJ 08332
Entries will be accepted on the day of drop off with a completed entry form.
- C. All classes are open to non-professional men and women.
- D. Youth Division - all categories open to youth 18 years of age and under.
- E. No entry fees will be charged.
- F. Every reasonable precaution is taken to protect entries while at the Fairgrounds, but all entries are at the risk of the exhibitor.
- G. Each exhibit must be in the quantity and number as required.
- H. Judges' decisions are final. Each entry is judged on its own merit.
- I. One Grand Champion for Adults (\$5) and One for Youth (\$5), One Best of Show (\$4), First Premium (\$3), Second Premium (\$2), and Third Premium (\$1) will be awarded for each division. All others will receive a Participant ribbon. Premiums will be awarded for each division.
- J. Bring exhibits to the Home Arts Building on **Sunday, July 7th**, between 1:00 and 3:00 PM. Exception: All food must be dropped off on Tuesday, July 9th between 9:00 and 11:00 AM. Any items that are dropped off after 11:00 on Tuesday will not be judged and get a Participant ribbon only. Judging will be Tuesday, July 9th after 11:00 AM.
- K. All entries must be the result of this past year's work.
- L. Each item entered must have an exhibitors tag (available at Home Arts Bldg).
- M. All exhibits must be picked up at the fairgrounds between 8 pm and 10 pm, Saturday, July 13th or 10 am and 1 pm, Sunday, July 14th. To pick up any items not picked up by Sunday, please call the Fair Office at 825-3820 and leave a message with your name and phone number. Someone will get back to you to set up a time to meet.

- Vegetables will be judged on quality and appearance.

***Baked Goods Rules***

- A. All foods must be wrapped, cool before wrapping. Baked goods may be on paper plates. Be sure to put your name on bottom of pie tin or cake plate.
- B. Recipe should be included with all exhibits.
- C. Cakes for the decorated classes are to be entered on cardboard.
- D. To cut down on waste, we will display only a portion of the item. The rest may be picked up by the entrant after judging at 5 PM on Tuesday. The only exception will be decorated cakes.
- E. No mixes may be used.

- B. Pictures must be framed or mounted and wired for hanging. Hooks must be securely attached (NO masking tape).
- C. Size limit 30” x 50”.

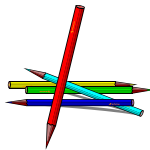

- B. Must be mounted in a cut-out mat.
- C. Plastic covering required to protect artwork or glass frame.
