# RULES

## Show Committee has the right to combine and/or cancel any Class.

- 1. This show is run in accordance with the State 4-H Horse Show Rules.
- 2. Proper tack and attire shall be enforced in all classes. Boots are required for **all** classes and Properly fitted SASTM/SEI approved safety helmets with chin straps secured must be worn by all riders in Classes 7-30.
- 3. Numbers to be worn on the rider's back or saddle pad and the same number will be used in all three shows. Each horse and rider combination must have a number. Riders must enter the ring with the correct number, if rider does not have the correct number or does not have the number given by the show committee the rider will be disqualified.
- 4. There will be a 2-minute time limit for entering the ring after the Class has been called. Exception: tack change, announcer must be informed. After the gate is closed, no rider shall be permitted into the ring.
- 5. Decision of the judge shall be final!
- 6. Each horse can only be used once in each division for any event.
- 7. Horse and rider shall be one combination for all 3 shows of the circuit.
- 8. Current negative coggins test is required as well as proof of a current rabies shot.
- 9. The Show Committee has the right to ask any disorderly horse or rider to leave the grounds.
- 10. No alcoholic beverages permitted on the show grounds.
- 11. The County of Cumberland, Cumberland County 4-H and the 4-H Show Committee are not responsible for loss, damage or injury to equipment, horse, rider or spectators.
- 12. No excessive use of force in any Classes.
- 13. Points for each horse and rider combination shall count toward year-end awards in each class and each division. However, <u>a horse and rider combination must show in at least 2</u> shows to be eligible for year-end awards and attend the Awards Banquet. Show management will not be responsible for any awards not picked up at banquet.
- 14. Choice of ribbon or fifty-cent for First-Six Place, Grand & Reserve in each Division, ribbons, and gifts. Riders must be present to receive gifts. **Prizes not picked up on the day of show will be forfeited.**
- 15. No horses allowed in food booth area, beyond horse barn area or in bleachers area.
- 16. Stalls are available for \$10/day due at registration. Stalls must be cleaned before you leave.
- 17. A 15-minute lunch break will be taken.
- 18. NO DOGS ALLOWED ON SHOW GROUNDS!
- 19. Walk-Trot riders may ride in Walk-Trot Classes only and may not enter another horse in Walk-Trot-Lope classes. Walk-Trot classes - riders must not currently be showing in Walk,Trot,Lope classes at any other show circuit or breed show. Entries into this division must remain in the same division to qualify for year-end prizes.
