# Home Arts Exhibits GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- One entry per class.
- Entry form should be mailed or emailed in by June 30th, 2025: Rutgers Cooperative Extension 291 Morton Ave, Millville, NJ 08332 heatherco@cumberlandcountyni.gov
- Entries will be accepted on the day of drop off with a completed entry form.
- Bring exhibits to the 4-H Building (Red Barn) on Monday, July 7th, between 4:00 and 7:00 PM. Exception: All food must be dropped off on Tuesday, July 8th between 9:00 and 11:00 AM. Any items that are dropped off after 11:00 AM on Tuesday will not be judged and get a participant ribbon only. Judging will be Tuesday, July 8th after 11:00 AM. Please call Heather at 856-451-2800 press 1 with any drop off questions.
- All classes are open to non-professional men and women.
- Age categories: Youth 8 and under, 9 13, 14 18, Adult 19+
- No entry fees will be charged.
- All entries must be the result of this past year's work.
- Each item entered must have an exhibitors tag
- Every reasonable precaution is taken to protect entries while at the fairgrounds, but all entries are at the risk of the exhibitor.
- Each exhibit must be in the quantity and number as required.
- Judges' decisions are final. Each entry is judged on its own merit.
- One Grand Champion for adult and youth, One Best of Show for adult and youth, First Premium for adult and youth. Premiums will be awarded for each division.
- All exhibits must be picked up at the fairgrounds between 8:00 PM and 10:00 PM, Saturday, July 12th or 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM, Sunday, July 13th. To pick up any items not picked up by Sunday, please call 856-451-2800 press 1.





- All foods must be wrapped, cool before wrapping. Baked goods may be on paper plates. Be sure to put your name on bottom of pie tin or cake plate.
- Recipe should be included with all exhibits.
- Cakes for the decorated classes are to be entered on cardboard.
- To cut down on waste, we will display only a portion of the item.
- The rest may be picked up by the entrant after judging at 5 PM on Tuesday. The only exception will be decorated cakes.
- No mixes may be used.
