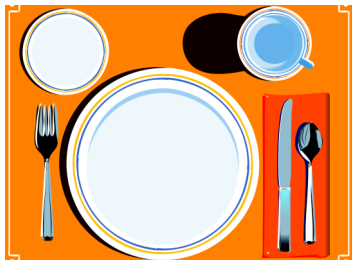

# WHO, WHAT, WHEN, WHERE AND HOW...



## THE BASICS...

4-H members prepare their favorite food at *home* and bring it to the 4-H Center along with their centerpiece, table setting, recipe and menu. Tables will be provided. Be sure to enter...it's loads of fun and tasty!



## ALL ABOUT YOUR ENTRY...

Your food must be **completely** baked or cooked ahead of time. When selecting a food, keep in mind the age of the 4-Her so that they are the chef (with a little bit of help from an adult if needed). Select an attractive table setting to compliment your favorite food. Suggested items— table cloth, placemat, vase with flowers, hand made table decorations and the appropriate serving dish, cup/glass and utensils. You will also need to have a recipe card for your favorite food and a menu that includes your favorite food.

## SAMPLING EVENT...

This portion of the event is optional and does not effect the judging process. Your family members, friends and fellow 4-Hers will be able to sample your favorite food. Please, bring with you **15-20 "bite-sized"** samples of your favorite food. When you check in on the day of the event, your samples will be collected and placed on the Sampling Table. Please **do not** let anyone other than your judge touch and taste your favorite food on your display.

## HINTS, TIPS AND RULES...

- \*ALL entries must be homemade. Packaged mixes can be used as an ingredient in a recipe.
- \*Choose a "theme" for your table setting and be creative.
- \*Bring supplies for one complete table setting.
- \*Include a serving utensil (fork, spoon, cake server) in your place setting for your judge to take a sample. Leave your food **whole** on its plate/bowl.



## JUDGING & PRIZES...

Please stay with your favorite food display until your judge has completed your score sheet. Cloverbud members (grades K-3) will only receive comments, not a numerical score. A 4-H award will be presented to the highest scoring Junior (grades 4-7) and Senior (grades 8-13) participants. ALL participants will receive a ribbon.
