## **RULES**

#### **GENERAL**

- WDF Rules will apply in WDF Ranked Events
- The organizers reserve the right to alter the schedule and playing format.
- Matches <u>will not</u> be announced via PA system. Players are expected to check the tournament bracket on DartConnect for their match and board location. Players will be provided 10 minutes to arrive at their board once their match has been called on DartConnect. Any player who does not arrive at their board within this allotted time may be disqualified and their entry fee will not be returned.
- Players who are suspended by any associated ranking organization cannot compete in any event.
- Youth players are welcome to play any event provided they are not playing in conflicting youth event.
- It is forbidden for any Youth (under 18) to drink any form of alcoholic beverages during a WDF sanctioned event. It is forbidden for any Under 23 players playing in an Under 23 ranked tournament to drink any form of alcoholic beverage during a WDF Sanctioned event until after they have finished competing in the Under 23 event. Random alcohol testing (Youth) and drug testing (adults) may occur at any time during a WDF Sanctioned Event

## **PLAYING AREA**

- No outside food or beverages (including alcohol) are permitted in the playing area.
- Strictly no peanuts allowed in the venue.
- Smoking and vaping allowed in designated outdoor areas only, and in accordance with Ontario and Canadian law.

## **REGISTRATION & REFUNDS**

- All events will be run using the DartConnect system. Each player will require their own email address to register for an event.
- It is the responsibility of every player to ensure that they are checked in and registered for each tournament that they have entered. Only players who have registered and checked-in to the tournament will be entered into the draw.
- Current PDC tour card holders are not permitted to play the WDF ranked Singles on Saturday and Sunday, but are permitted to play the other non-ranked events over the course of the weekend.
- A player may withdraw from an event at any time with notification to the tournament organizer.
- A player who withdraws from an event prior to the close of registration for that event will be eligible for a refund of their entry by request to the Tournament Organizers.

## **RULES**

#### **MARKING**

- All matches in WDF ranked tournaments shall be marked by an independent marker. Players cannot selfmark. It applies to ALL matches including round robin matches.
- Markers will be appointed for the first match in the Saturday and Sunday WDF ranked singles events. After the first knockout match on each board, the loser must mark the next match on the same board.
- Failing to stay and mark (or failing to find a person to mark in absentia) may result in disqualification from the 2027 Toronto Area Open. Players may also be reported to the NDFC.
- Should any player require an accommodation related to marking, they must notify the tournament director of their needs so they can be accommodated in accordance with the Ontario Human Rights Code.

## **DRESS CODE**

- Dress pants (of any colour) and collard shirt are <u>required</u> for the ranked NDFC/WDF ranked events on Saturday and Sunday.
- No open-toe shoes or headgear are allowed during any event.
- Professional dress is encouraged but not required for any other event.
- CDC event may require different dress code, please refer to www.champdarts.com for more information.

## **ORDER OF PLAY**

- A bull throw shall determine the order of play in each match (save and except the Friday Open Singles event).
   The throwing order for the Bull throw shall be determined by a coin toss. The Winner of the Bull throw shall throw first in the match and all subsequent "odd numbered legs" which will also include the "tie-break" leg if required.
- In throws for the Bull each player (or one member of a team) shall throw one dart for the Bull. The dart must remain in the dartboard in order to count and rethrows shall be made until a dart remains in the dartboard. If the dart enters the "25" or "Bull" sector it shall be removed before the opponent takes his/her throw. Re-throws shall be called if it cannot be determined which dart is nearer to the bull, or if both darts are in the "25" ring. A re-throw shall be in the reverse order of the previous throw. The player who throws nearer to the centre of the dartboard shall throw first in the match.
- For the Friday Open Singles (501/Cricket/301) Matches will require a bull throw for each leg played. Matches will begin with a coin toss to determine who has the option to throw first or second at the Bull. The player throwing closest to the Bull will throw first in the first Leg. The Loser of the first Leg has the option of throwing for the Bull first in the second Leg. If the third Leg is necessary, the Bull will again be thrown, with the loser of the original coin flip having the option of throwing first.
